

Chapter 5. Multifamily Rental Housing Resource Site and Agency Contacts

5.1 General Information of the site

The Multifamily Rental Housing Resource Site provides the community with a viable source of information to assist low-income families in obtaining affordable housing. The information on the website provides a detailed account of the Agency's assisted multifamily rental projects. The projects listed on the website are required to maintain a certain percentage of rental units at affordable rates for occupancy by low-income families.

The website is designed to be both educational and a housing resource that outlines how to assist low-income families seeking affordable housing. For the most part, the website will provide up-to-date information on the project addresses, contact numbers, number of Agency assisted units, bedroom sizes, vacancy rates, and affordability levels of the Agency assisted projects. Additionally, the website provides a list of the Agency assisted projects with site and area amenities, and a chart identifying the annual income and rent limits for very-low, low and moderate income families.
