Sacramento, California. The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) has created its first email-subscription based newsletter, "*Community Visions.*" The newsletter is being distributed to City and County officials, community groups, housing advocates, developers and other stakeholders involved in community revitalization and affordable housing.

Community Visions is a quarterly publication that features a variety of articles on Agency projects and activities that are proposed, underway or soon to be completed. Programs related to the Housing Authority, affordable housing opportunities and partnerships, and events sponsored or supported by SHRA will also be profiled in the newsletter.

SHRA (www.shra.org) is a Joint Powers Authority created by the City and County of Sacramento to represent both jurisdictions for affordable housing and community redevelopment needs. SHRA oversees residential and commercial revitalization activities in 13 redevelopment areas throughout the City and County. The Agency is the leading public developer of affordable housing. SHRA has a FY 2005 budget of \$222 million and approximately 325 employees. The Agency approximately 3,200 units of public housing and is one of the largest landlords in Sacramento. SHRA also administers about 11,000 rental assisted vouchers per month.
