AMENDING CITY AND COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG), NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM (NSP), AND VARIOUS YEARS' ACTION PLANS

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2007, the City Council and Board of Supervisors approved their respective jurisdictions' 2008-2012 Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan identifies the City's housing and community development needs and describes a long-term strategy for meeting those needs. In addition, it specifically addresses federally funded housing and community development programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) annually serves as the designee for the City and County of Sacramento to administer community development grants originating from HUD to include CDBG, HOME, ESG and HOPWA; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2010, the City Council and Board of Supervisors approved their respective jurisdictions' 2010 One-Year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2011, the City Council and Board of Supervisors approved substantial amendment to the 2010 CDBG One Year Action plan for Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3); and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2011, President Obama signed the Fiscal Year 2011 (FY11) budget agreement covering spending for the remainder of the year with a revised allocation for HUD; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency Commission on June 1, 2011, the programs and projects proposed for funding under the amended Action Plans and the 2011 One-Year Action Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SACRAMENTO HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION:


Section 1. All evidence presented having been duly considered, the findings, including the environmental findings regarding this action, as stated in the staff report that accompanies this resolution, are approved.

Section 2. The Executive Director, or her designee, is authorized to revise the 2011 City and County One-Year Action Plan Activities and amend various years' Action Plans.

Section 3. The Executive Director, or her designee, is authorized to submit the amendments of the 2011 One-Year Action Plan and prior years' Action Plan to HUD.

Section 4. The Executive Director, or her designee, is authorized to execute the Action Plan grant agreements with HUD and the agreements and contracts with the appropriate entities to carry out the CDBG and NSP funded activities in the amended 2011 and prior years' Action Plan.

Section 5. The Executive Director, or her designee, is authorized to establish a revolving fund account for the third round of Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP3) funding to receive repayments of loans from the Vacant Property Program and Property Recycling Program to be used for future activities in each program respectively.
