Such catalyst projects both directly employ individuals and will lead to future employment as development continues and new businesses and residents move into the project areas.</p> <p>Homeless prevention activities meet the intent of the CDBG-R funds by utilizing the public service component to assist those most impacted by the recession. CDBG-R public service funds provide an additional opportunity for longer lasting system improvements, shifting from a system organized around shelter to one centered on prevention and housing stability.
