The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) is soliciting applications for eligible public facility improvement projects under the 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. SHRA is the Grantee of CDBG funds received annually from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and administers the funds on behalf of the City and County of Sacramento. The Sacramento City Council and the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors approved an allocation of up to \$150,000 in CDBG funds per jurisdiction for eligible public facility improvement projects. Requests must be valued between \$25,000 and \$150,000. Total project costs may exceed \$150,000, provided the applicant can demonstrate that additional funds are available to complete the project. SHRA may select between one and three projects in each jurisdiction.

Eligible applicants include non-profit organizations (including faith-based organizations) and government entities or public agencies that are not local units of government. The cities of Elk Grove, Citrus Heights, and Rancho Cordova receive their own CDBG entitlement and are ineligible to apply, as is any non-profit, government entity, or public agency with a proposed project with a service area determined to be a majority served within those jurisdiction boundaries.
