Building Conditions



- Air conditioner repairs underway
- Plumbing repairs are continuing to be addressed; replacing drain pipes that have rusted
- Newly modified office space passed final inspection
- Security camera installation underway
- 1100+ fire sprinkler heads are currently being replaced
- New fire alarm pull boxes installed

Guest and Re-housing



- 3 meals are provided daily
- Guests services provided (case management, housing referrals, acquiring legal documentation, etc.)
- 4 guests have self-exited

Relocation of Residents



- 76 residents receiving relocation services
- 24 offered temporary accommodations during repairs of the building
- 3 moved out without relocation assistance
- 1 evicted
