- **Guest Services**
- Veteran Affairs physician is providing medical services to veteran guests
- American River College and California State University of Sacramento are providing Alcohol and Other Drug Services
- Sacramento Self Help Housing is onsite to provide re-housing services
- Volunteers of America (VOA), the shelter operator, provides case management, meals, rehousing and service coordination
- Elica, a medical provider, has a rotating schedule onsite to administer full behavioral and medical service consultations
- Wellspace, a medical provider, has a rotating schedule onsite to provide nursing triage services
- Sacramento County mental health is onsite providing mental health services
- 3 guests have gained employment while at CP

## Building Condition

- Community restrooms are designated on each floor
- Showers were temporarily closed for emergency repairs for several days



- Elevator 1 will be repaired soon
- New leaks were addressed as they emerged throughout the building
- Pest control continues scheduled routine treatments on Thursday
- Scheduled water shutoff took place Thursday and residents were notified in advance

## **Relocation of Residents**



- 23 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 8 moved out without assistance
- 1 evicted
- 48 residents remain
