Guest Services



- Veteran Affairs physician is providing medical services to veteran guests
- American River College and California State University of Sacramento are providing Alcohol and Other Drug Services
- Sacramento Self Help Housing is onsite to provide re-housing services
- Volunteers of America (VOA), the shelter operator, provides case management, meals, rehousing and service coordination
- Elica, a medical provider, has a rotating schedule onsite to administer full behavioral and medical service consultations
- Wellspace, a medical provider, has a rotating schedule onsite to provide nursing triage services
- Sacramento County mental health is onsite providing mental health services

Building Condition



- Community restrooms are designated on each floor
- Emergency water shutoff took place Wednesday to address a water tower leak on the roof
- Elevator is still on schedule for repairs to be completed by next week
- Pest control continued scheduled routine treatments on Thursday

Relocation of Residents



- 19 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 6 moved out without assistance
- 1 evicted
- 54 residents remain
