- Guest showers are undergoing renovations to prevent leaks
- Residents and guests participated in a planned fire drill on 11/19
- Elevator 1 undergoing repairs
- Elevator 2 was temporarily down on the 18th and the 21st for a couple hours each day for repairs

# **Relocation of Residents**



- 33 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 37 residents remain
