Guests' Success

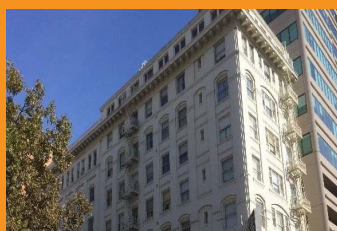
Housed

Building Condition



- Addressing intermittent issues with the small steam boiler affecting the hot water; waiting on parts for repair
- Local experts are currently testing the heating and cooling systems
- Several showers are undergoing significant repairs in preparation of use
- CP front door is under going repairs due to a malfunctioning latch
- Elevator 1 will be repaired soon
- New leaks were addressed as they emerged throughout the building

Relocation of Residents



- 25 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 8 moved out without assistance
- 2 evicted
- 45 residents remain
