# **Building Condition**



- Replaced air filters on each floor
- Several showers are undergoing tile replacement in preparation of use
- Residents were informed of a scheduled water shutoff from 10am to 3pm today
- Elevator 1 will be repaired soon and Elevator 2 was temporarily down from Tuesday night to midday Thursday
- New leaks were addressed as they emerged throughout the building

## **Relocation of Residents**



- 29 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 41 residents remain
