
Housed

- Several showers are undergoing renovations in preparation of use
- Southern elevator is still undergoing repairs and residents have been offered temporary relocation assistance
- Problems with hot water and heat have been repaired
- Sewage leak was identified in the basement and repaired
- Notices were posted for scheduled water shutoffs that took place 1/16 from 10am-2pm and 1/17 11am-3pm

Relocation of Residents



- 36 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 33 residents remain
- 1 moved out and will receive relocation benefits
