- Two dryers that needed repairs received service and are back online.
- Last week the building remained temperate despite warmer weather.

Relocation of Residents



- 51 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 35
 - * Yolo County: 12
 - * Out of State: 1
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 18 residents remain
