On-Site Providers

Elica Health Center provides primary medical care, dental care and COVID testing for guests on a weekly basis. Their mobile clinic comes to the Capitol Park Hotel to provide care.

Guests' Success— PYTD

Housed

- 106 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 5 guest moved into transitional housing

Gained Employment

- 11 guests

Building Condition

- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is beyond repair. There is a separate air conditioner serving the Community Room which continues to keep that area cool.
- The elevator was repaired on Monday.

Relocation of Residents

- 52 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 35
 - * Out of State: 1
 - * Yolo County: 13
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 17 residents remain
