### Guests' Success – PYTD

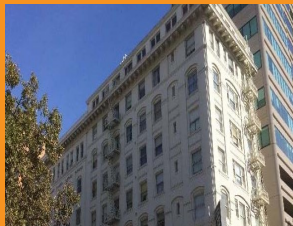
#### Housed

- 108 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 5 guest moved into transitional housing

## Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. There is a separate air condition system for the Community Room.

## Relocation of Residents



- 54 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 37
  - \* Yolo County: 13
  - \* Out of State: 1
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 15 residents remain
