### Guests' Success— PYTD

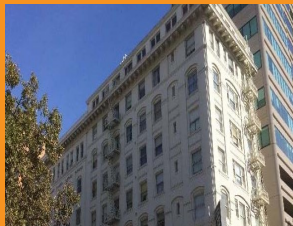
#### Housed

- 117 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (*Primarily in Sacramento County*)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

#### Gained Employment

- 18 guests

## Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- Plumbing leaks in two bathrooms are being addressed.
- Washing vendor was contacted to dispatch a technician to resolve the washing machine issues.

## Relocation of Residents



- 57 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 40
  - \* Out of State: 1
  - \* Yolo County: 13
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 12 residents remain
