Guests' Success – PYTD

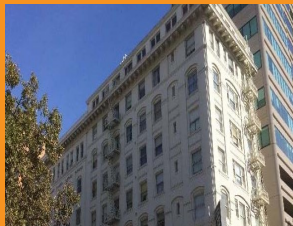
Housed

- 115 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.

Relocation of Residents



- 56 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 39
 - * Yolo County: 13
 - * Out of State: 1
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 13 residents remain
