#### Housed

- 142 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

## **Building Condition**



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- The remaining elevator is no longer functional and is beyond repair. All guests are now located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.

## **Relocation of Residents**

- 64 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
- \* Sacramento County: 45
- \* Out of State: 2
- \* Yolo County: 14
- \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 5 residents remain
