- The remaining elevator is no longer functional and is beyond repair. All guests are now located on the 2nd and 3rd floors.

• 64 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:



- * Sacramento County: 45
- * Out of State: 2
- * Yolo County: 14
- * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 5 residents remain
