## Guests' Success— PYTD

### Housed

- 148 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

### Gained Employment

- 19 guests

## Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- The remaining elevator is no longer functional and is beyond repair.

## Relocation of Residents



- 66 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 47
  - \* Out of State: 2
  - \* Yolo County: 14
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 3 residents remain
