- 149 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (Primarily in Sacramento County)
- 8 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 8 guest moved into transitional housing

Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- The remaining elevator is no longer functional and is beyond repair.

Relocation of Residents

• 67 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:



- * Sacramento County: 48
- * Out of State: 2
- * Yolo County: 14
- * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 2 moved out to temporary housing in Sacramento County, pending placement in permanent housing
- 0 residents remain
