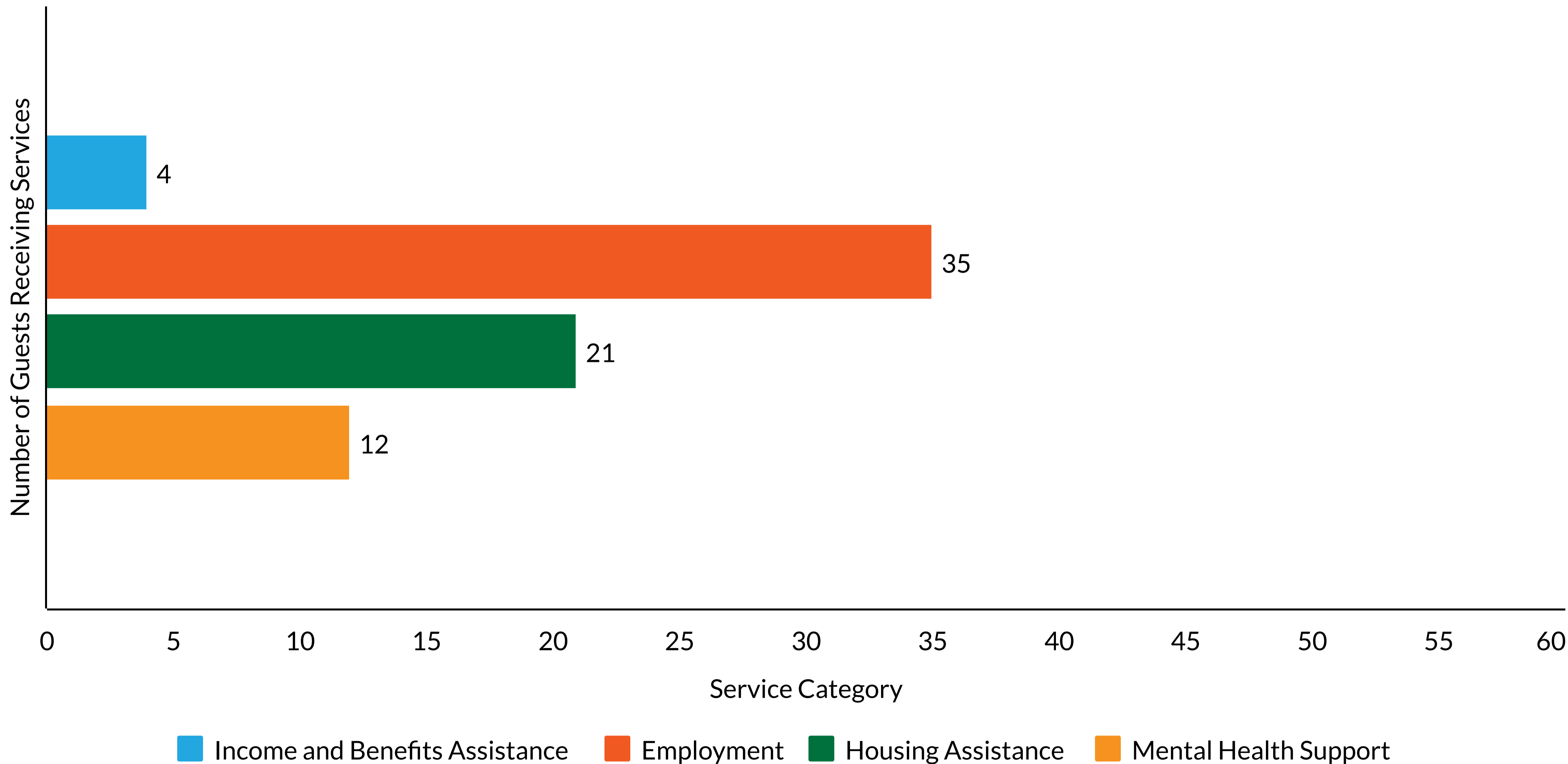
Chronic Homeless:

Meals and Bed Nights (PYTD):

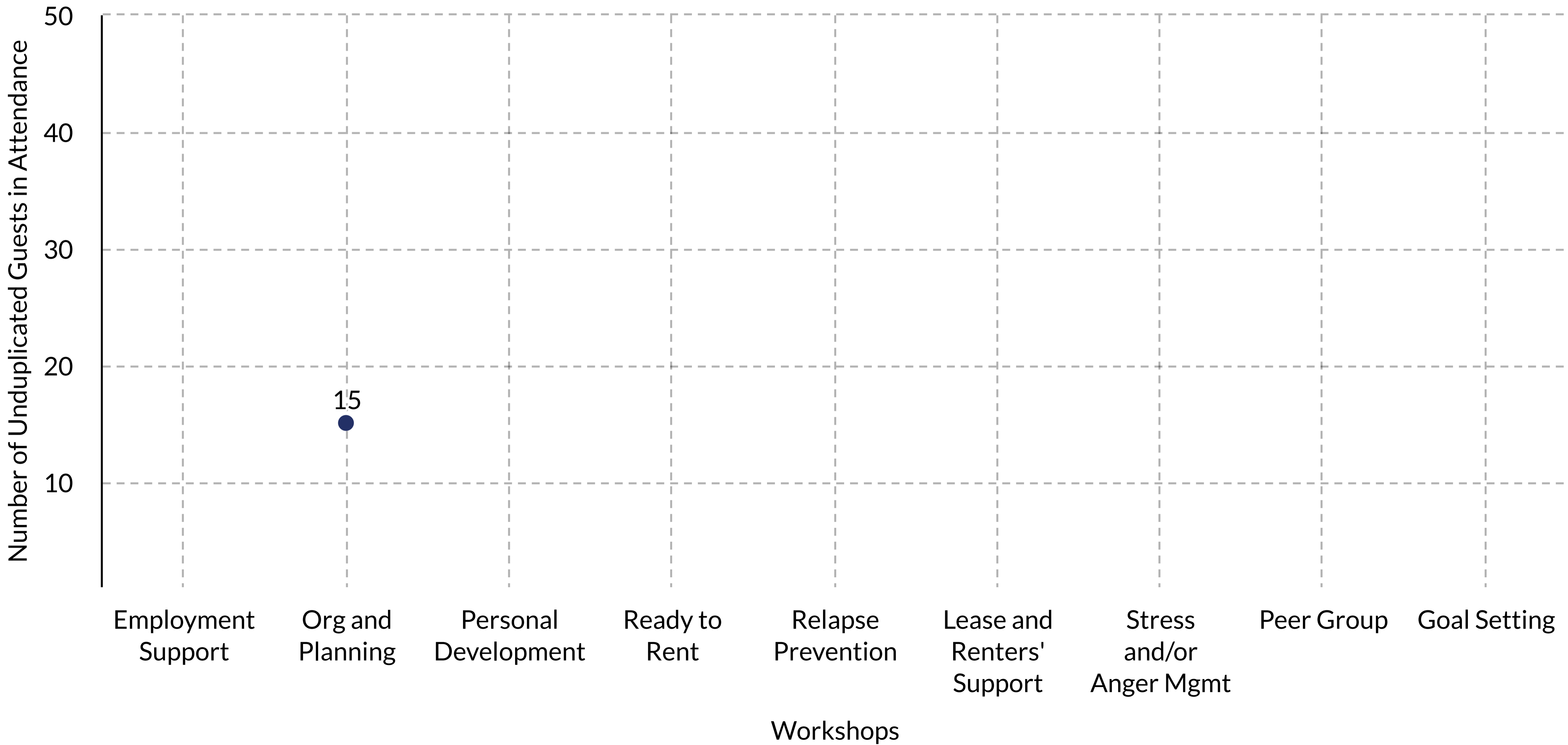
