Guests' Success– YTD

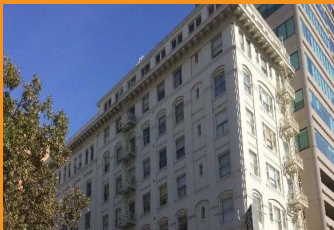
Housed

Building Condition



- Several showers are undergoing renovations in preparation of use
- Emergency water shutoff took place 12/9 from 11am-1pm to resolve a leak
- Elevator 1 went offline temporarily on 12/6 due to a blown fuse
- Addressed leaks caused by the rain as they emerged

Relocation of Residents



- 34 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 36 residents remain
