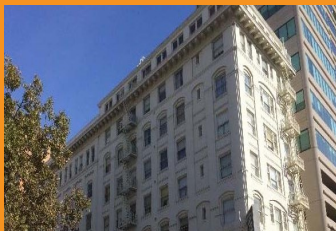
Housed

Building Condition



- Several showers are undergoing renovations in preparation of use.
- Southern elevator has been down for a week. Residents have been offered temporary relocation assistance.
- There have been intermittent interruptions in hot water (only) above the first floor. Solutions are underway.

Relocation of Residents



- 36 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 34 residents remain
