#### Guests' Success— YTD

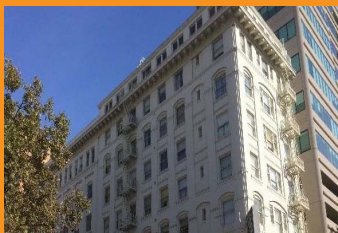
##### *Housed*

### Building Condition



- Additional showers were made available for guest use. Work continues on remaining showers. Bathroom sinks fixed. Leaks repaired.
- Hot water was shutoff for a short period of time and restored on Monday.
- Heating system was checked and thermostats adjusted.

### Relocation of Residents



- 37 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 31 residents remain
- 1 moved out and will receive relocation benefits
