### Building Condition



- Additional cameras installed to expand staff's abilities to see in and around the hotel.
- One guest room was taken off line due to significant water damage. Guests relocated.
- Sink supports were added.
- New leak identified caused by the bathroom sinks not draining correctly.

### Relocation of Residents



- 38 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 31 residents remain
- 1 moved out and will receive relocation benefits
