- Elevator was temporarily offline Monday evening and restored Tuesday.
- Water in storage tank on roof was treated.
- Architects have completed review of café so it is being prepared for VOA's reuse.
- New leak in community room addressed.

Relocation of Residents



- 41 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 28
 - * Out of State: 1
 - * Yolo County: 9
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 10 moved out without assistance
- 29 residents remain
