## **SACRAMENTO HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OFFICES CLOSED DUE TO COVID-19**

**Sacramento, Calif.** | In response to a stay-at-home directive issued today by the Sacramento County Public Health Department, all SHRA offices, including Housing Choice Voucher and Public Housing, are currently closed until further notice in response to a stay at home directive from Sacramento County Public Health due to COVID-19. Appointments with residents and clients will be rescheduled as needed. Essential services will continue to be provided as needed.

SHRA also administers approximately 13,200 rent assistance vouchers per month.
