- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 1 guest moved into transitional housing

- Elevator was temporarily down on Tuesday, but was immediately repaired and placed back on-line

### Relocation of Residents



- 48 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 32
  - \* Yolo County: 12
  - \* Out of State: 1
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 21 residents remain
