Guests' Success— PYTD

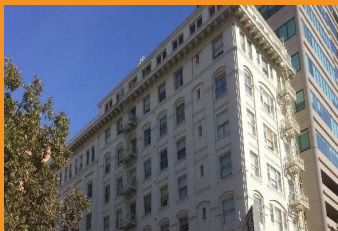
Housed

- Washers require maintenance and awaiting hose replacements.
- Elevator was repaired and the elevator door on the second floor was reinforced.

Relocation of Residents



- 51 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 35
 - * Out of State: 1
 - * Yolo County: 12
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 18 residents remain
