### Guests' Success— PYTD

#### *Housed*

- 126 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (*Primarily in Sacramento County*)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

#### *Gained Employment*

- 19 guests

### Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- The functioning air conditioning system underwent preventative maintenance, which included the routine air filter replacement.

### Relocation of Residents



- 60 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 43
  - \* Out of State: 1
  - \* Yolo County: 13
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 9 residents remain
