SHRA Rent and Income Limit Table:

The attached Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) Assisted Rental Housing <u>Income and Rent Limit Table</u> changes will be effective July 1, 2018.

Chart 1: BOND, HTF, Inclusionary, MHSA and Tax Increment Program Income Limits

a. Income limits have increased five percent (5%) or less

Chart 2: HOME Program and Rent Limits

- b. HOME Program Income Limits have increased seven percent (7%) or less
- c. High HOME Rents (HHR) Limits
 - Rents have increased four percent (4%) or less for studios, 1 and 2 bedroom units.
 - Rents remain the same for 3, 4 and 5 bedroom units.
- d. Low HOME Rents (LHR) Limits
 - Rents have increased five percent (5%) or less for all Low HOME bedroom sizes.

Utility Allowance (UA) Schedule:

The SHRA Utility Allowance Schedule changes will be effective July 1, 2018

The changes are as follows:

- 1) The schedules no longer distinguish between the City or County limits. The Tables apply to all regulated properties throughout Sacramento County
- 2) There are two (2) UA Schedules to choose from:

SCHEDULE A - Includes Owner provided Air Conditioning (A/C) allowance

- a) Chart 1- Unit Type-Apartment and Walk-Up (including Elevator)

And

SCHEDULE B – Excludes Owner provided Air Conditioning (A/C) allowance

- c) Chart 1- Unit Type-Apartment and Walk-Up (including Elevator)
- d) Chart 2 Unit Type-Row House, Town House, Semi-Detached and Duplex Link: http://www.shra.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/06/Schedule-B-No-AC.pdf
- 3) U/A allowances exclude: Water, Sewer, Trash, Range/Microwave and Refrigerator. Additional fees may not be charged for these services.
 - Owners/Management Agents must utilize the provided allowance by selecting an appropriate schedule and chart based on the Owner provided A/C and unit type.

2018 Unit Status Report (USR) Updated:

The USR changes will be effective immediately.

- 1) Utility Allowances selections have been updated to reflect the changes listed above.
- 2) All prior versions of the USR will no longer be accepted.
