Guests' Success— PYTD

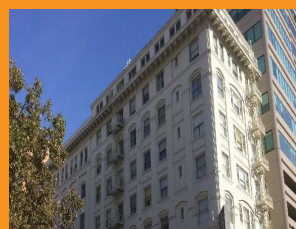
Housed

- 142 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (*Primarily in Sacramento County*)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.
- The remaining elevator is no longer functional and is beyond repair. All guests are now located on the 2nd and 3rd floors .

Relocation of Residents



- 64 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
 - * Sacramento County: 45
 - * Out of State: 2
 - * Yolo County: 14
 - * Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 5 residents remain
