### Guests' Success— PYTD

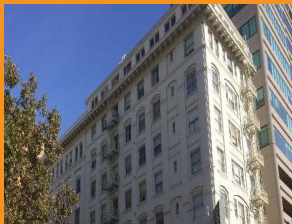
#### *Housed*

- 138 guests have moved into Permanent Housing (*Primarily in Sacramento County*)
- 3 guests staying with friends and family on a temporary basis
- 6 guest moved into transitional housing

- 19 guests

### Building Condition



- The air conditioning system serving the sleeping areas is no longer working and beyond repair. However there is a separate air conditioning system for the Community Room that is fully functional.

### Relocation of Residents



- 63 residents received relocation benefits and moved to their new homes:
  - \* Sacramento County: 45
  - \* Out of State: 2
  - \* Yolo County: 13
  - \* Other County in CA: 3
- 11 moved out without assistance
- 6 residents remain
