Capacity for New Housing

What is included in the inventory


- Utilize vacant sites that were in previous inventory (program for by-right development on these sites)
- Appropriately zoned underutilized sites
- Commercial sites multi-family allowed by right
- Master Plan Communities recently adopted expected to develop in 2021-2029 cycle



Affirmatively Further Fair Housing

Assembly Bill 686

County must take action to ensure sites are not concentrated in areas of high segregation and poverty and to identify sites in high opportunity areas

Housing Element Goals

- 1. Providing an adequate supply of land for housing
- 2. Reducing constraints to housing production
- 3. Preserving existing housing and neighborhoods
- Improving housing opportunities and conditions for special needs groups
- 5. Providing and maintaining housing affordability
- 6. Promoting the efficient use of energy in residences
- Promoting and affirmatively furthering fair housing opportunities for Sacramento County residents



Goal 1: Adequate Land Supply

- Program A1. Countywide Rezone Program
 - Objective: Create opportunity for rental housing affordable to lower-income households.
 - Target Date: January 2022



Goal 5: Housing Affordability

- Program E3. Affordable Housing Ordinance Amendment
 - Objective: Consider amendments to increase productions of affordable housing.
 - Target Date: December 2023
- Housing Trust Fund Ordinance Amendment
