**Sacramento, Calif.** | The Sacramento Emergency Rental Assistance (SERA2) Program is now hiring for the position of Housing Program Technician. This a temporary position with Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA/[shra.org](http://shra.org)) which has partnered with the City and County of Sacramento to administer the SERA2 Program ([shra.org/sera](http://shra.org/sera)). The SERA2 Program offers emergency rent and utilities assistance for renters impacted by COVID-19.

The Housing Program Technician position involves calculating and determining initial eligibility for individuals to receive assistance under the SERA2 Program. **SHRA** ([www.shra.org](http://www.shra.org)) is a Joint Powers Authority created by the City and County of Sacramento to represent both jurisdictions for affordable housing and community redevelopment needs. SHRA has a FY 2021 budget of \$214 million and 250 employees. The Agency owns and/or manages approximately 3,200 units of affordable housing and is one of the largest landlords in Sacramento. SHRA also administers approximately 13,200 rent assistance vouchers per month.
