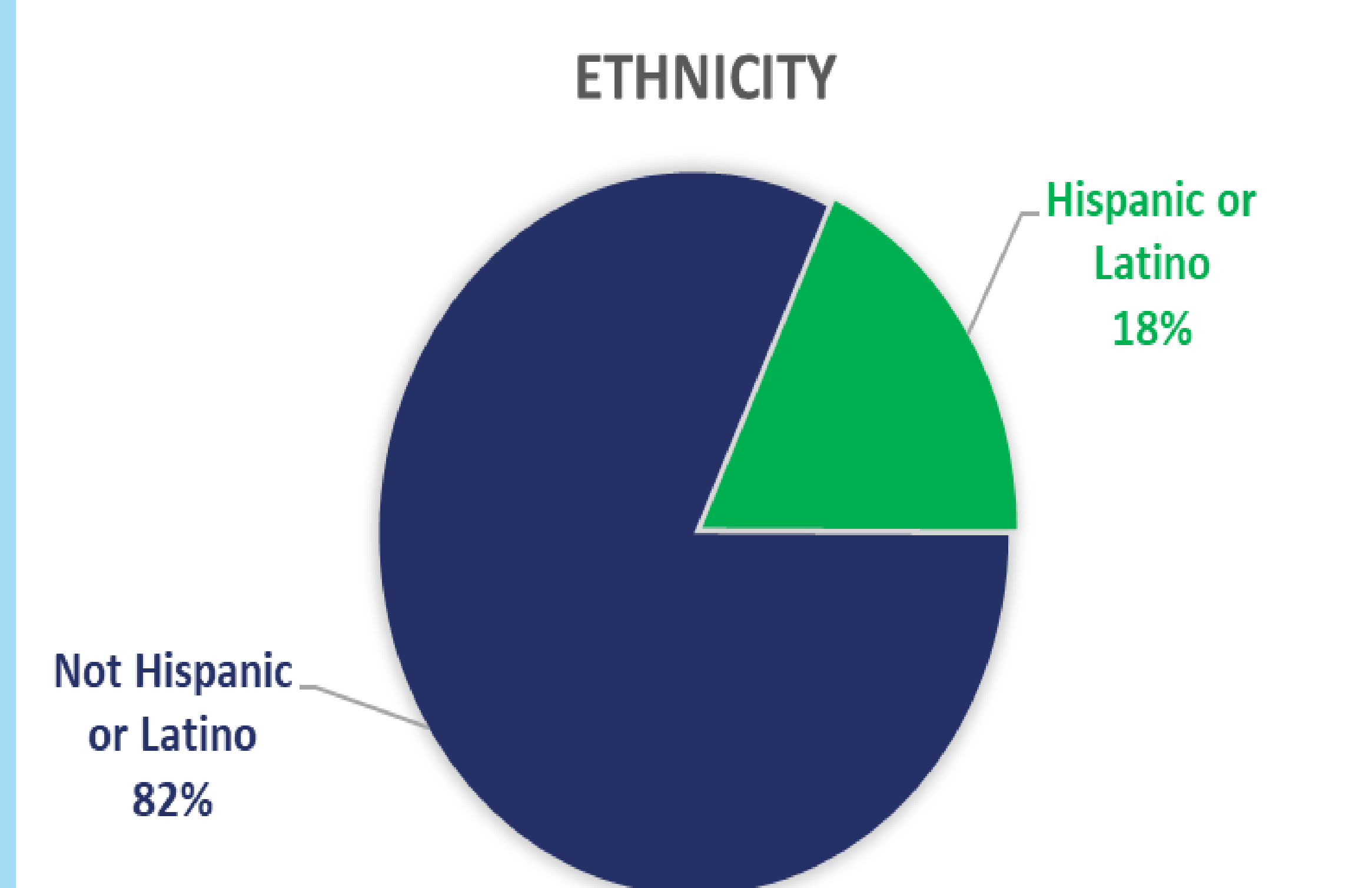
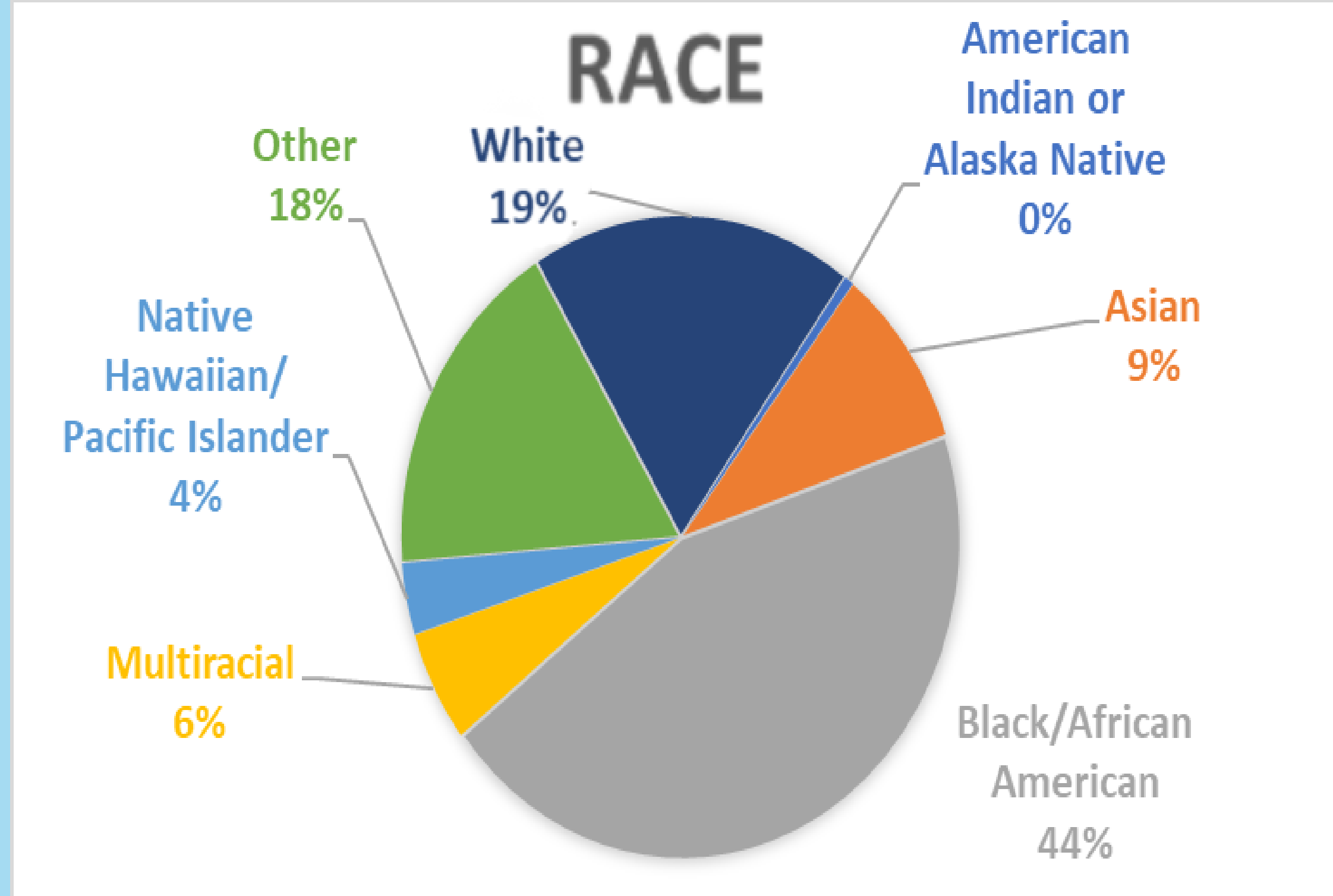

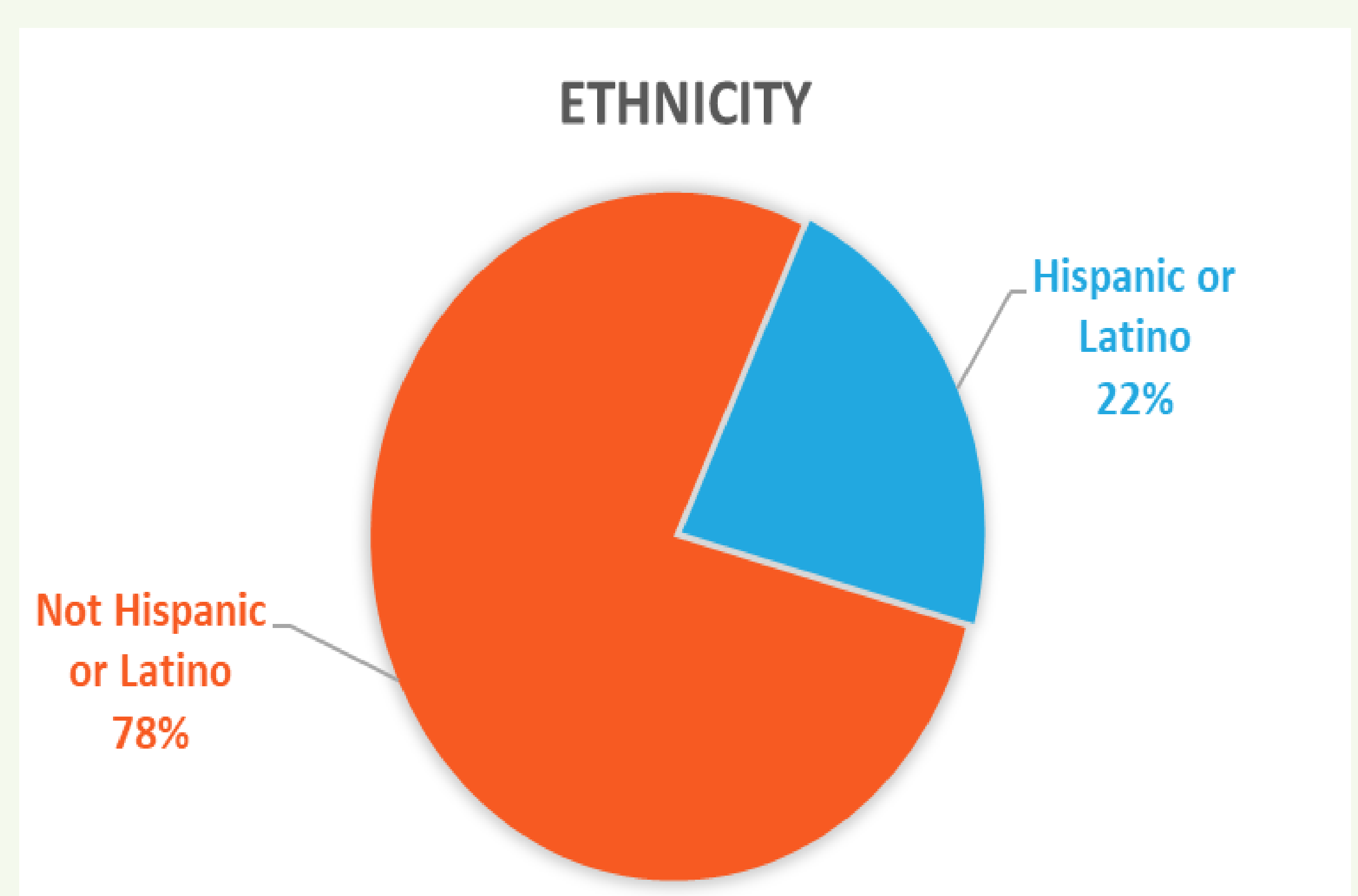
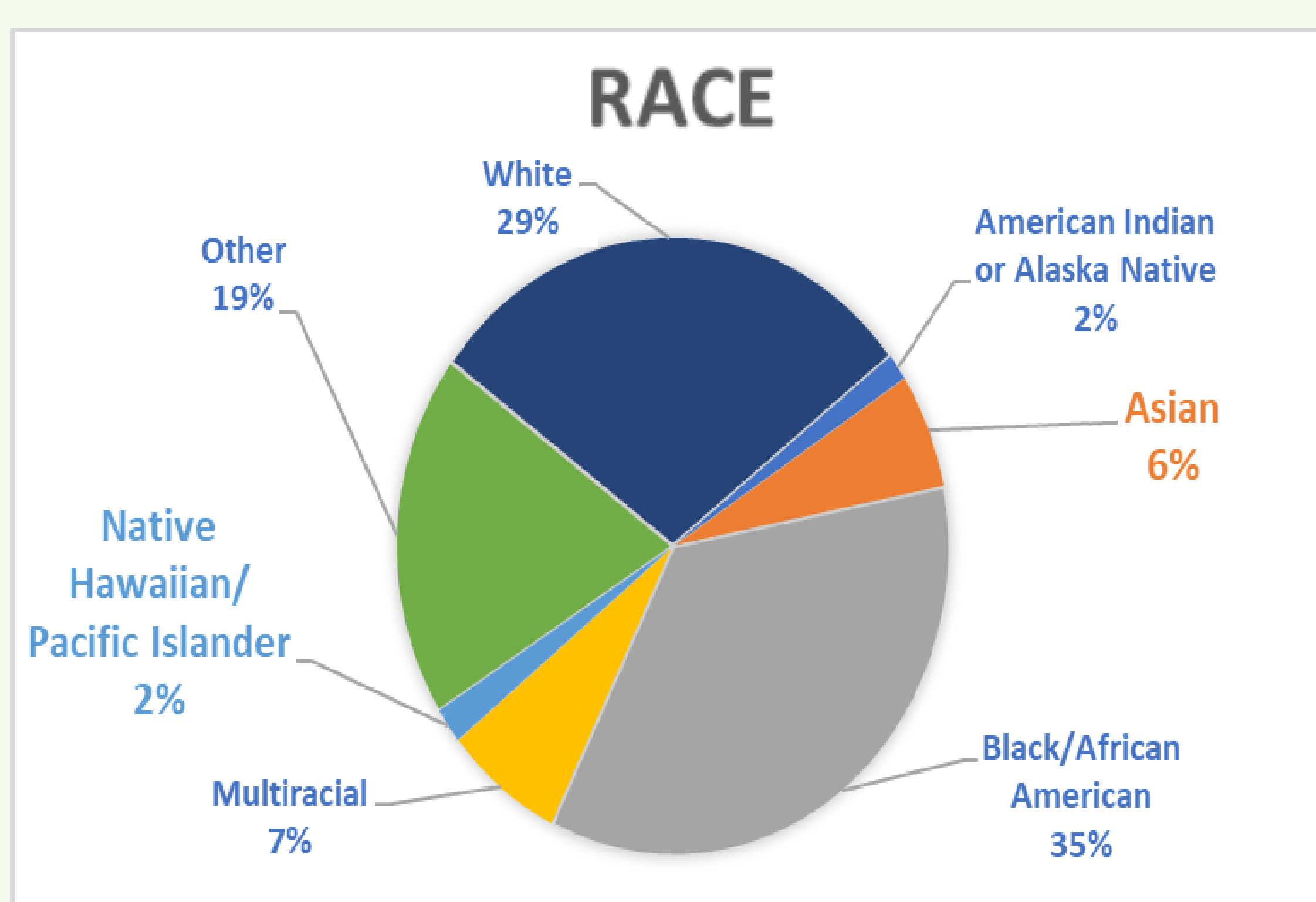
### April 2021 Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

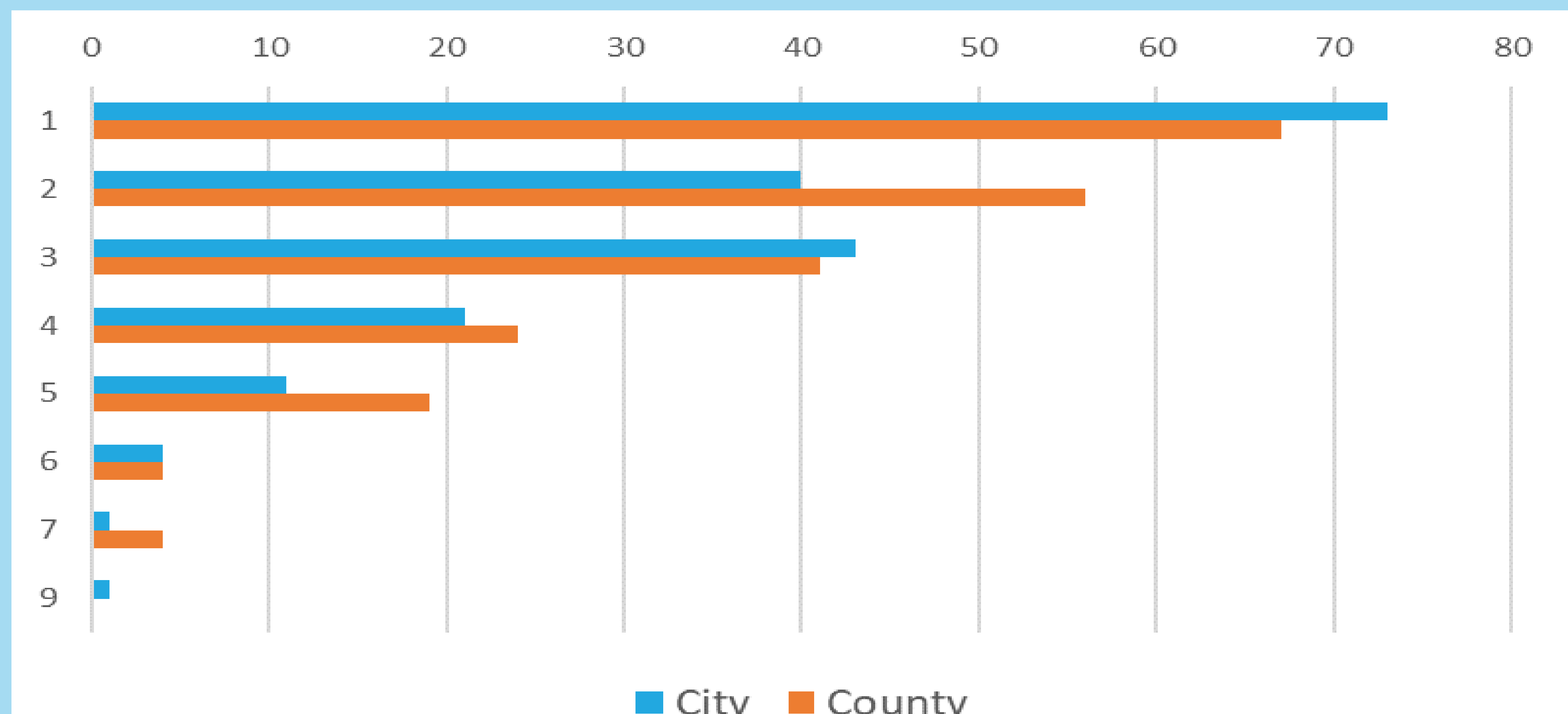
#### County-Head of Household

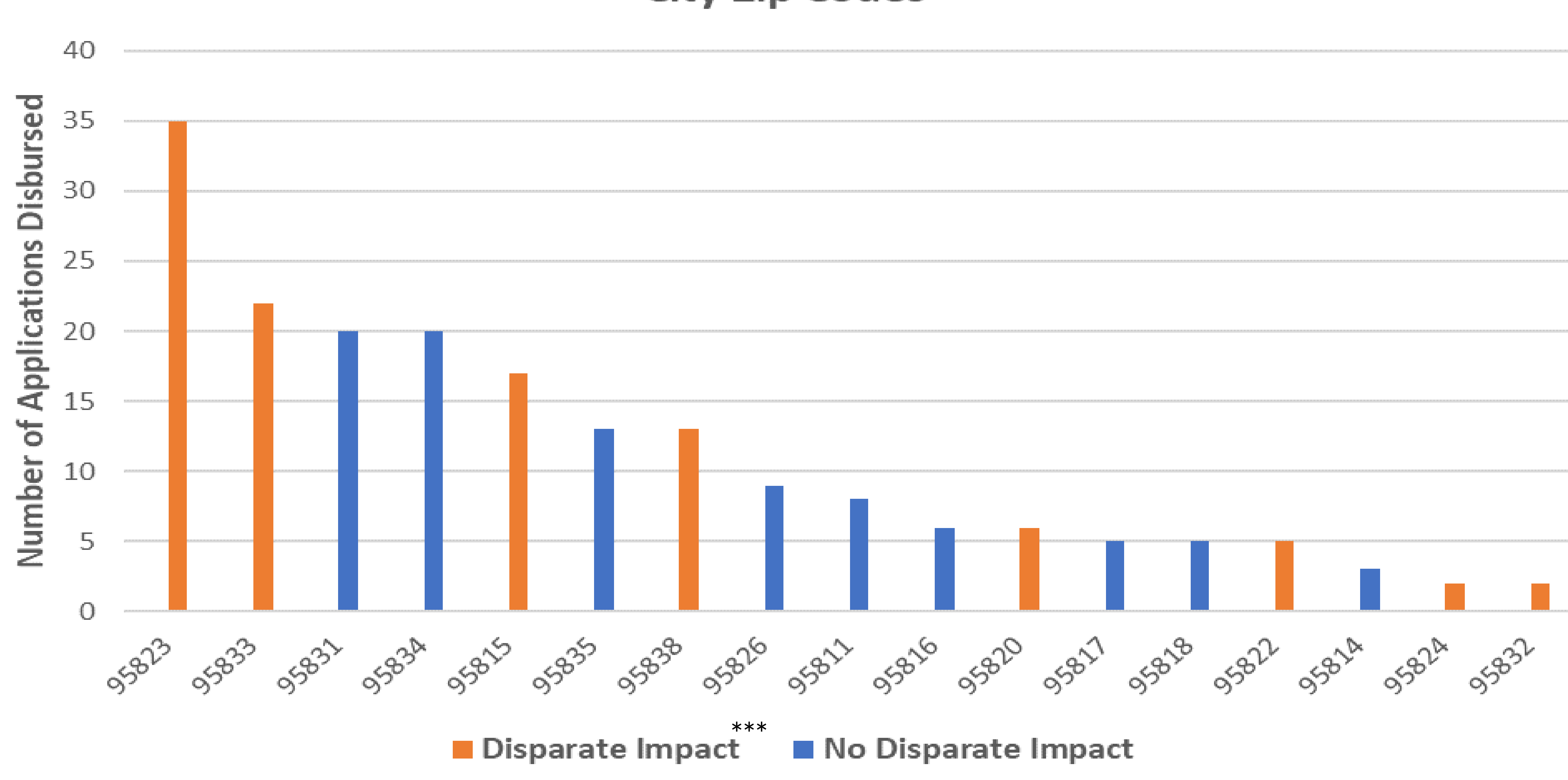
### Disbursements By Household Size

#### City/County

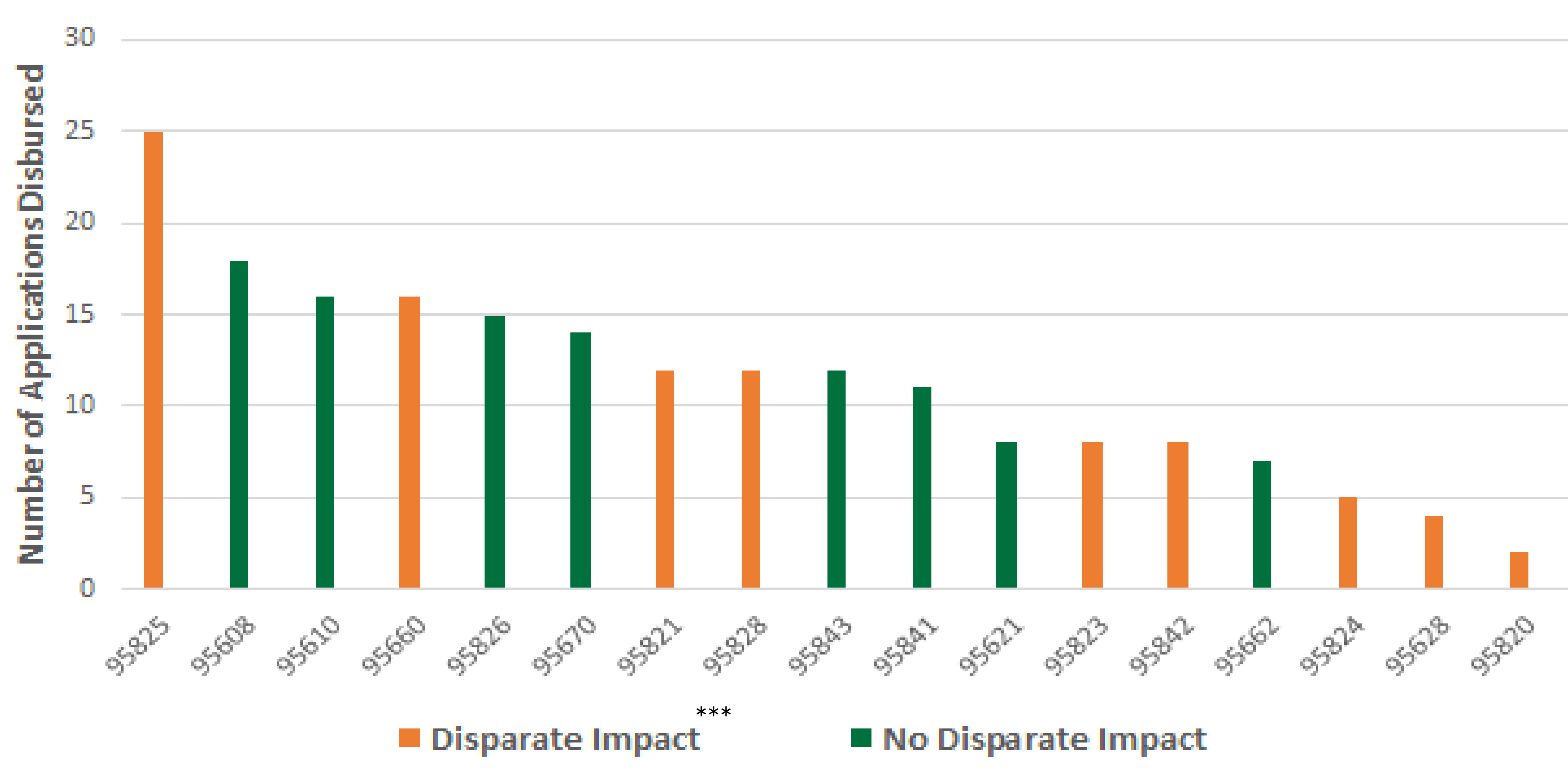


### Top Disbursement Zip Codes
