





X Street Navigation Center Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the shelter open?

A: The shelter opened on September 21, 2021 and currently has the funding to remain open for two years.

Q: Who oversees the shelter?

A. The City of Sacramento asked the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) to oversee the operations of the X Street Navigation Center. SHRA contracts with Volunteers of America (VOA) to manage the day to day operations.

Q. What are the goals of the X Street Navigation Center?

A: To provide temporary shelter for unsheltered adults and to provide wrap-around services while they are transitioning to obtain permanent housing.

Q: Where are the funds coming from for the temporary shelter?

A: Funding for the X Street Navigation Center (X Street) is provided largely in part to a donation made by Kaiser Permanente and the City of Sacramento's Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention (HHAP) grant received from the State.

Q: Who is eligible to move into the shelter?

A: X Street is open to any unsheltered adult who can perform self-care.

Q: How does someone get into the shelter?

A: Outreach is being done by a variety of agencies in the immediate area surrounding the shelter. Agencies serving homeless individuals in Sacramento can make referrals to X Street Shelter through the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). These referrals are then sent to X Street Shelter as space becomes available.

Q: How long can individuals stay at the shelter?

A: The goal is to transition all X Street guests into permanent housing as soon as possible or within an average of 4-6 months. VOA provides on-site services 24 hours/day 7 days/week. VOA and other service providers connect guests with the services they need to become stably housed. Guests may stay at X Street until they are permanently housed.

Q: How many people will X Street house and for how long?

A: It will house up to 100 adults at full capacity. With the current funding, the shelter is anticipated to remain open until September, 2023.

Q: Are visitors allowed?

A: Visitors are not allowed on the property. X Street is focused on providing maximum support to their guests, involving a multitude of services and case management to meet the individual needs of the guests.

Q. How can we help?

A: Guests receive three meals a day and bedding and towels while staying at X Street. VOA can receive financial donations; however material donations cannot be accepted due to a lack of storage space.
