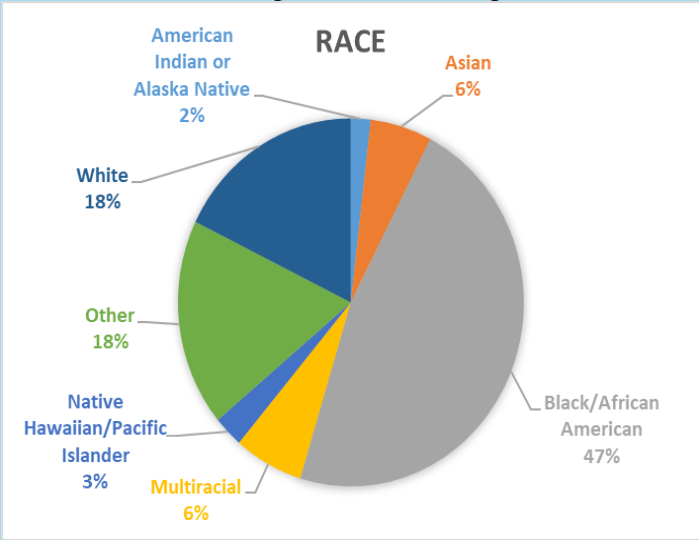

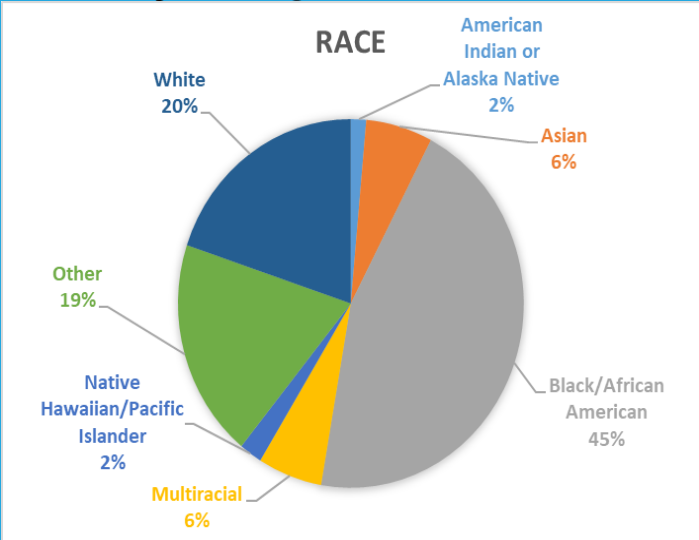
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

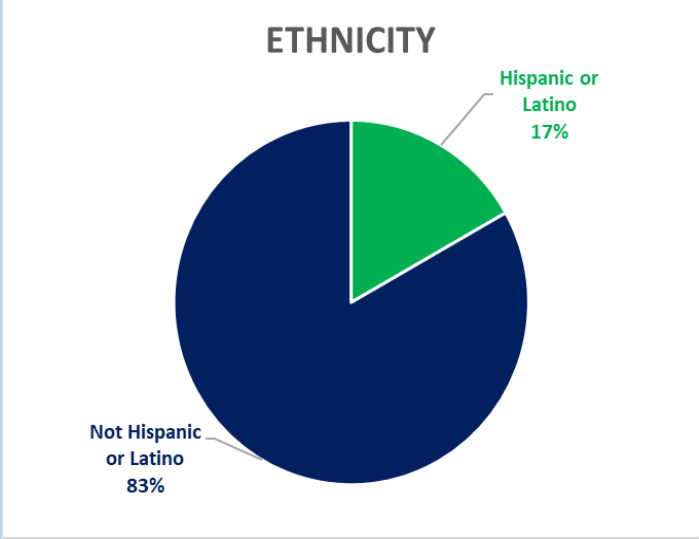

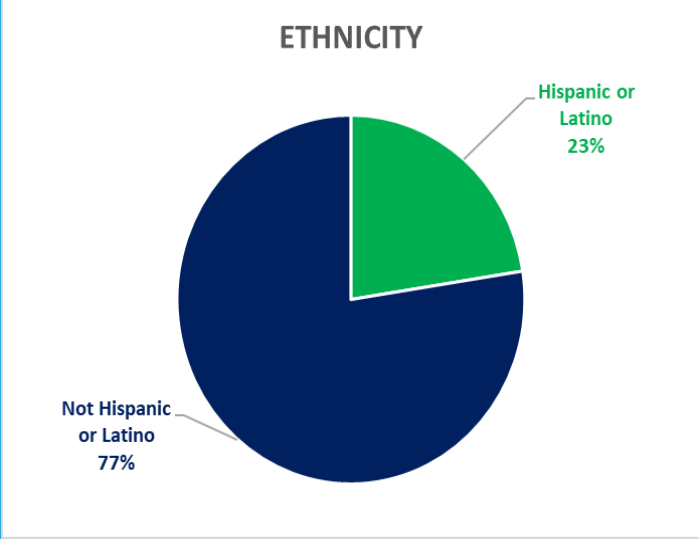

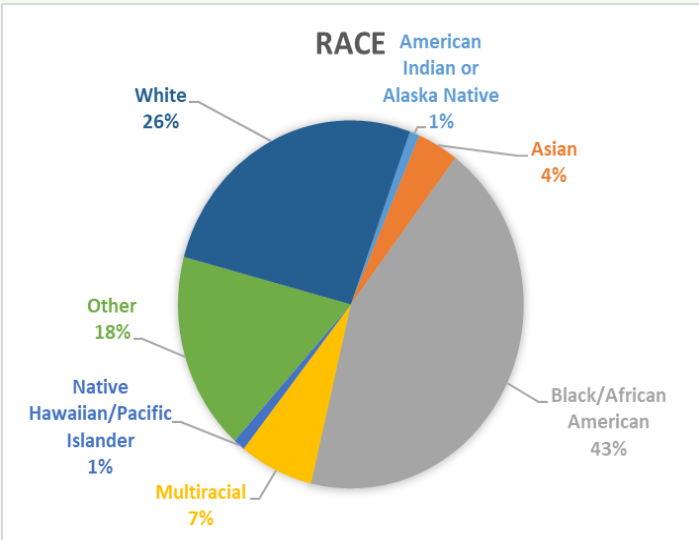

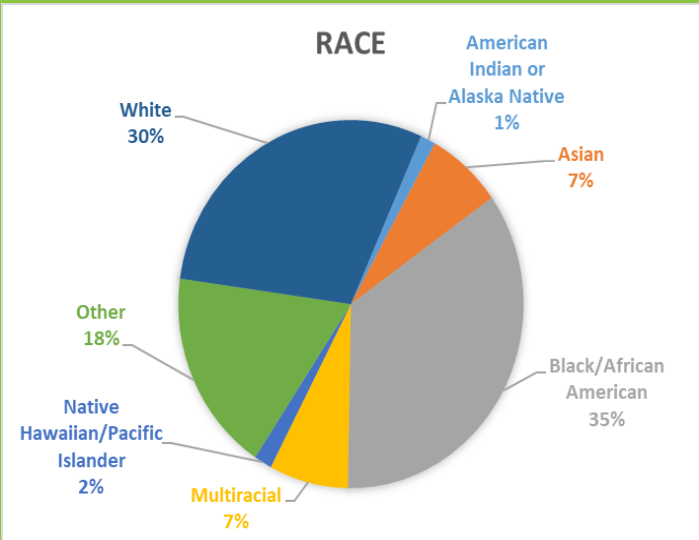


County January



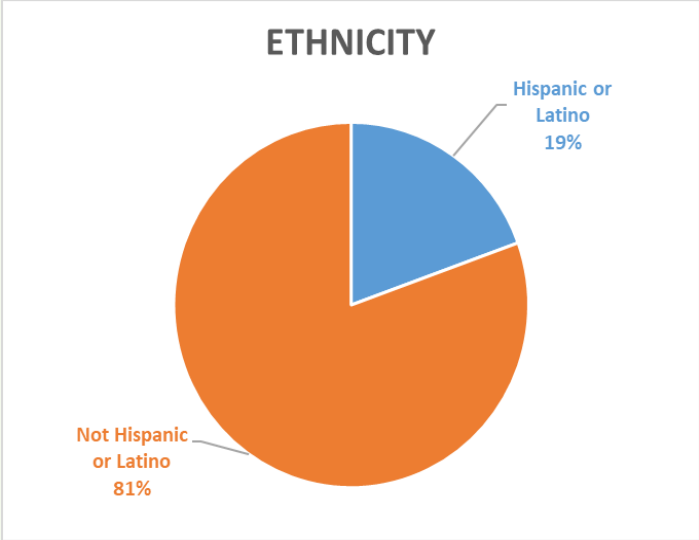

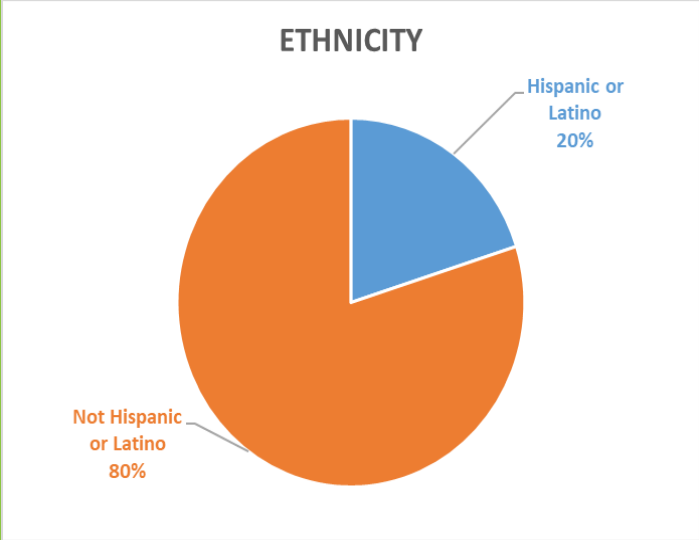

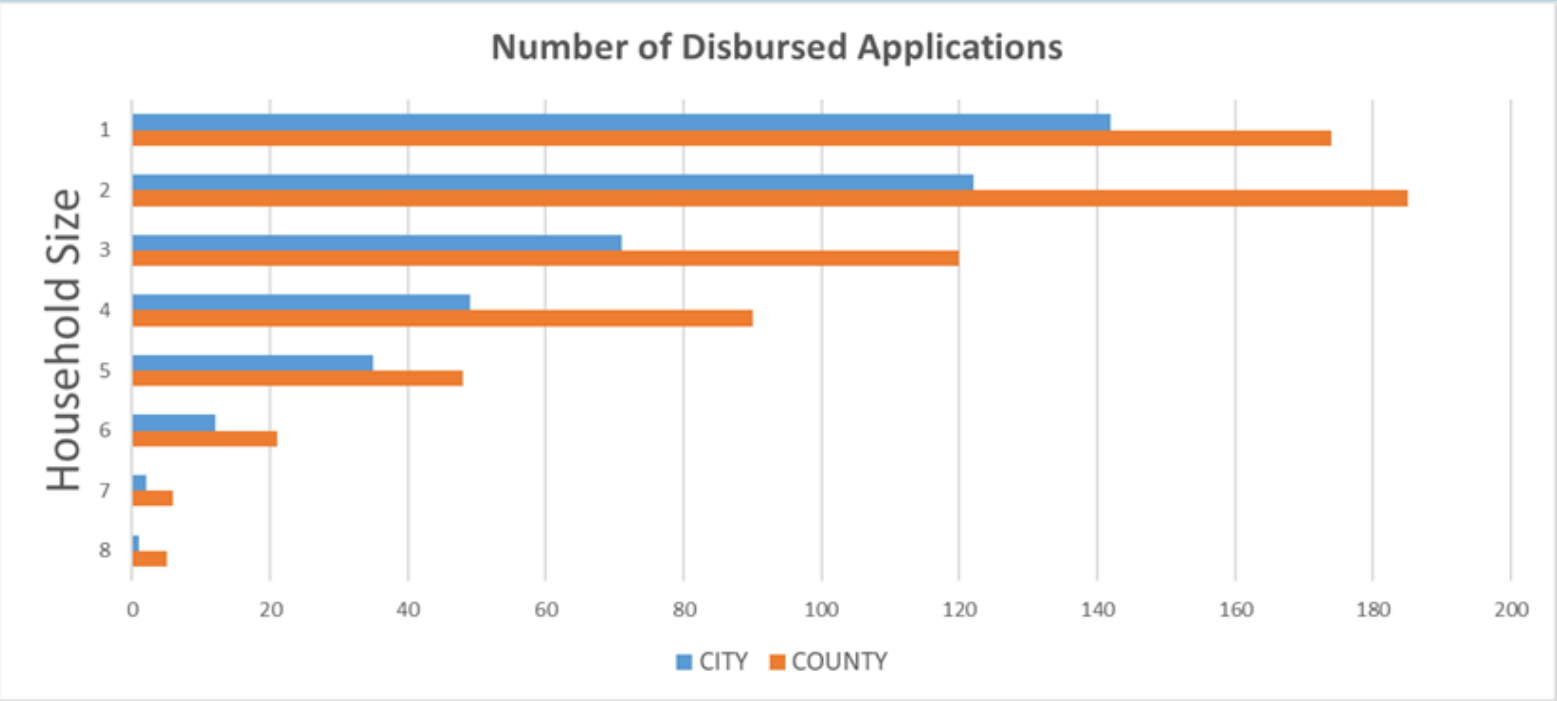

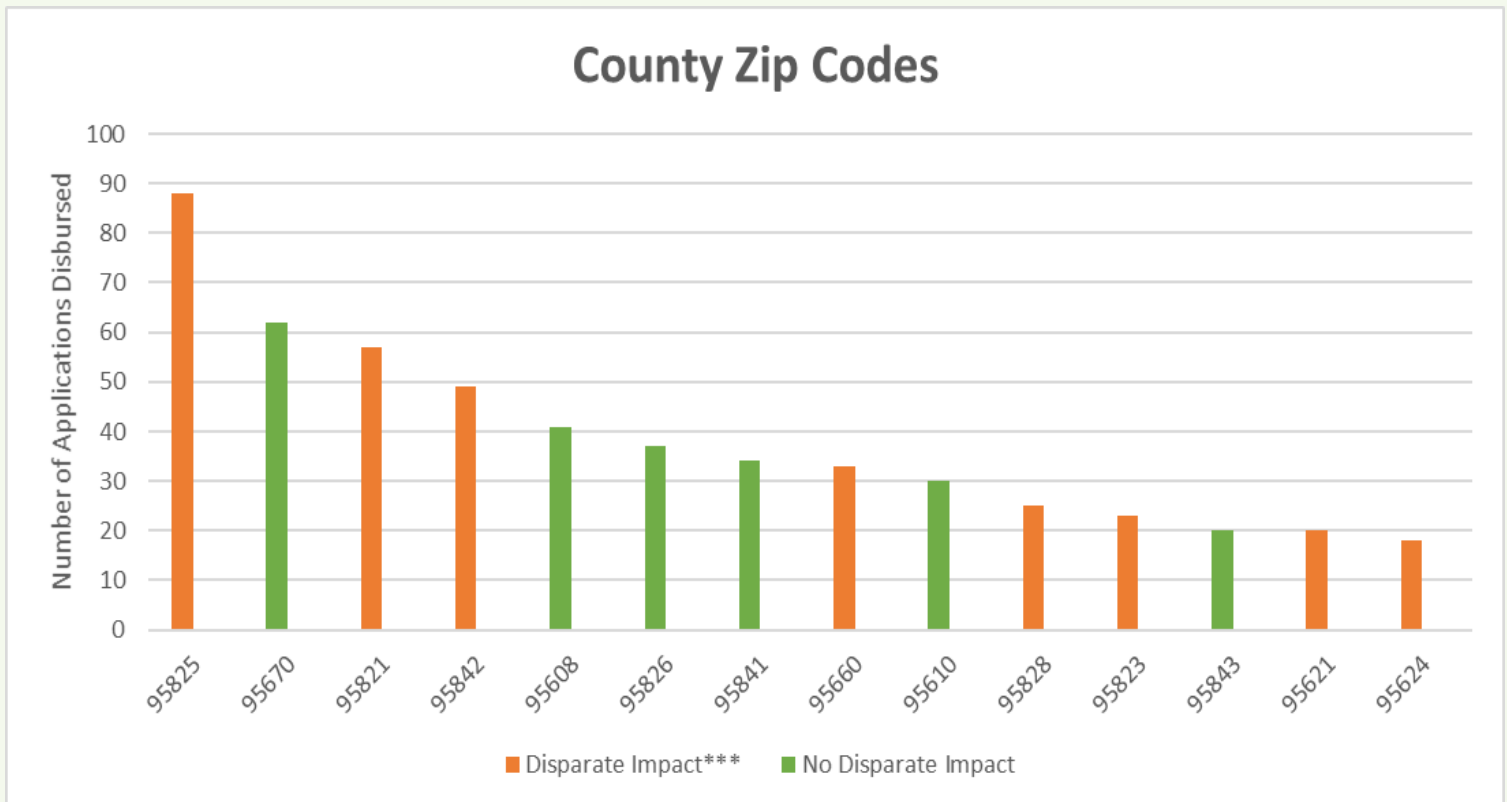
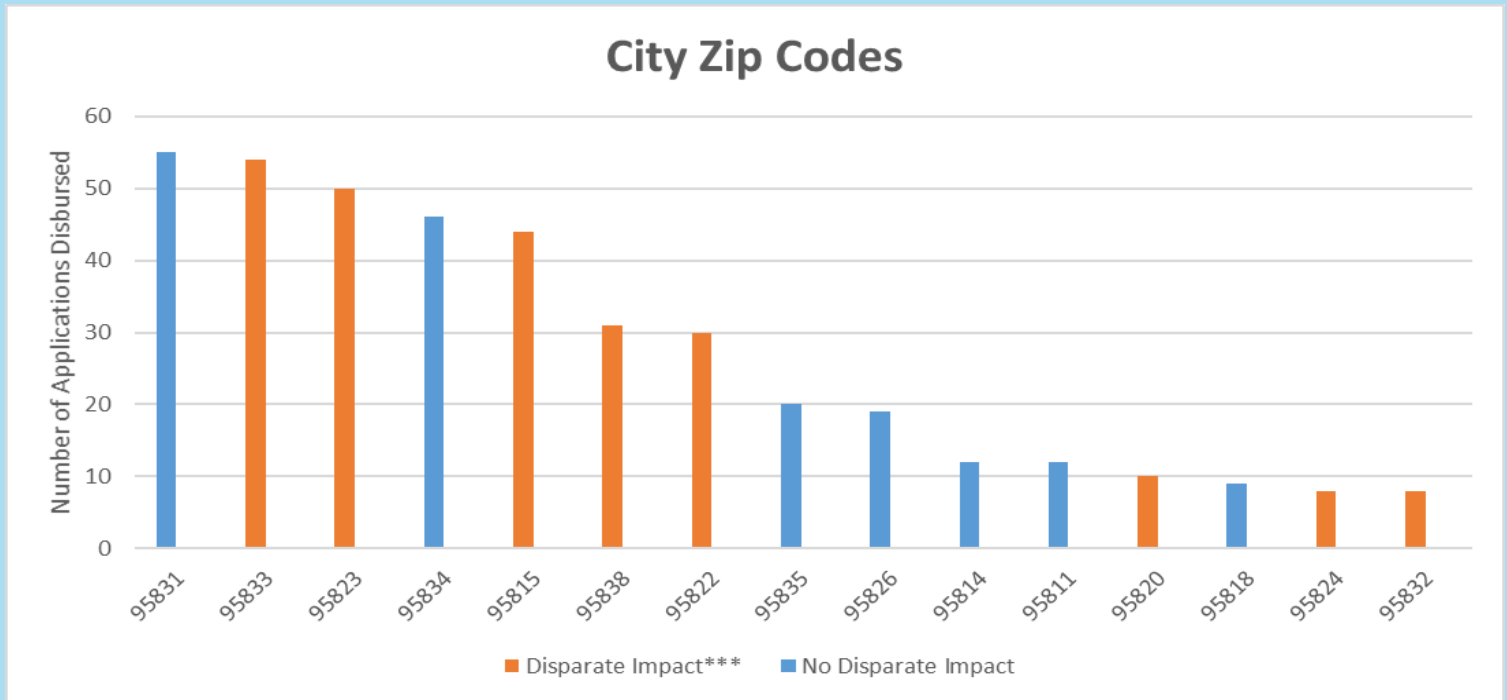


January Disbursements By Household Size
