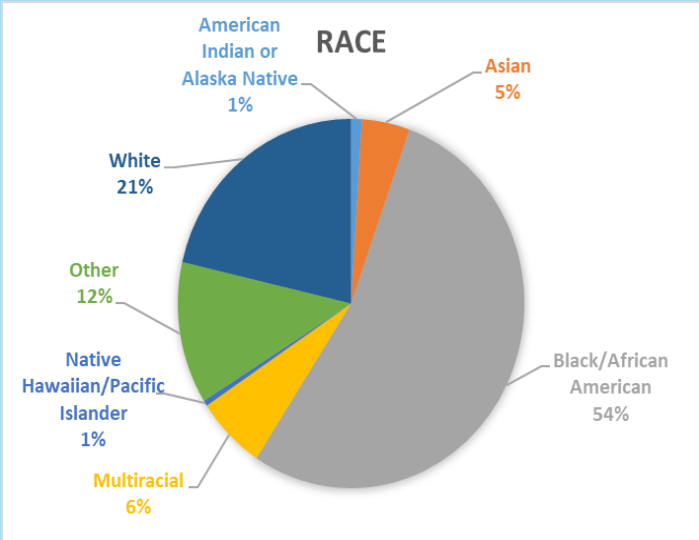

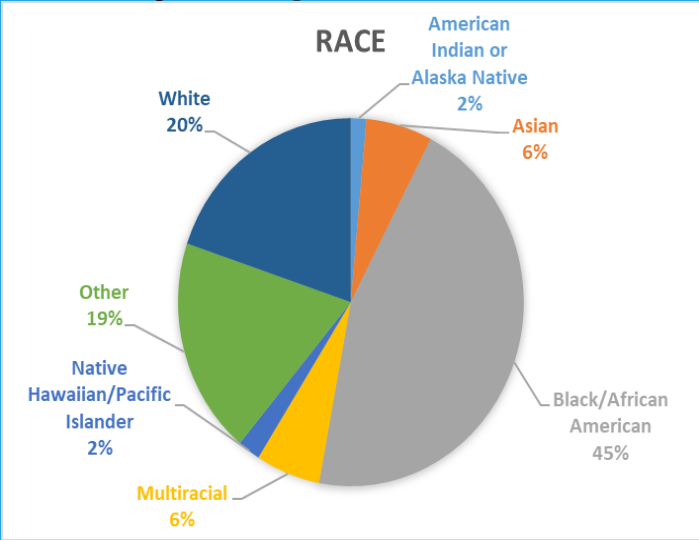
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

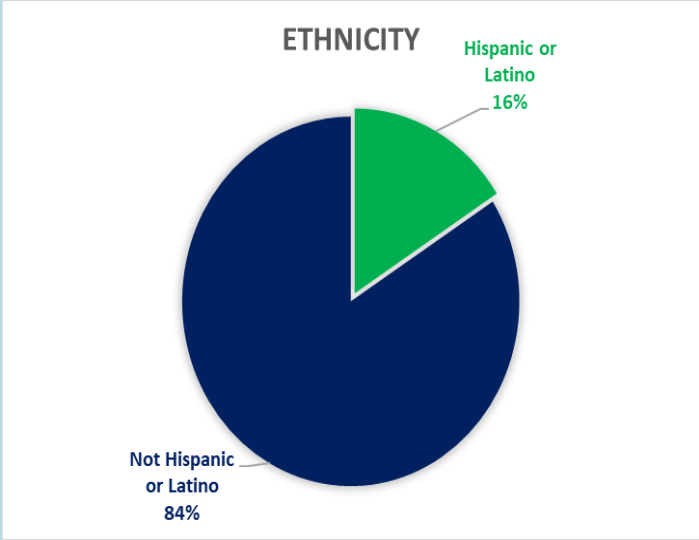

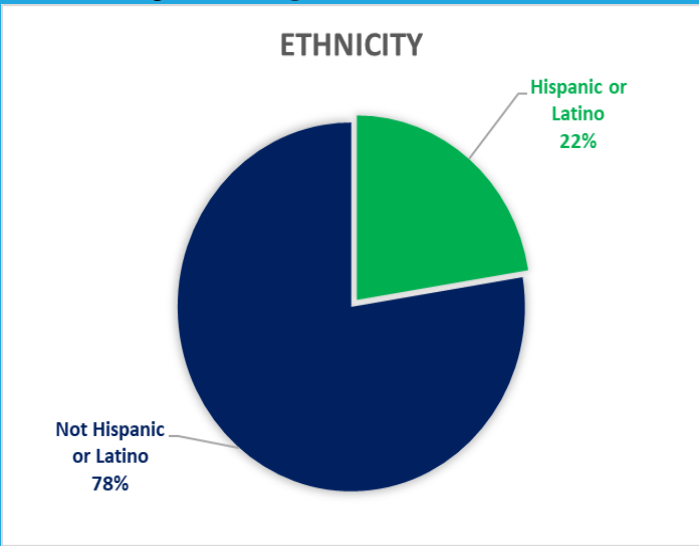

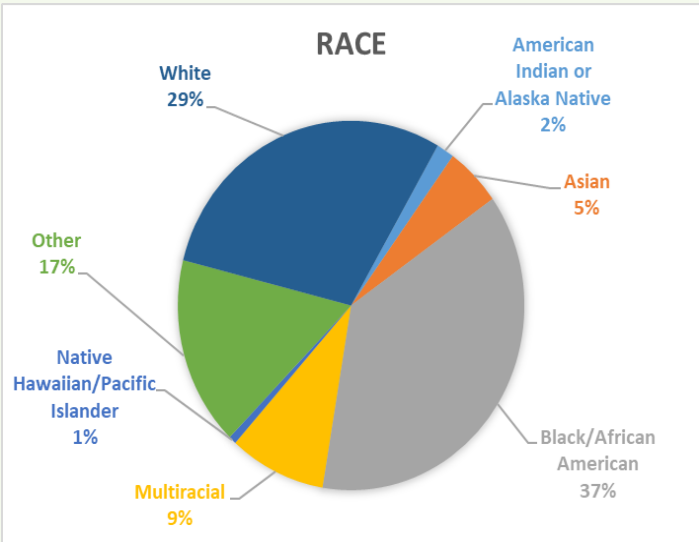

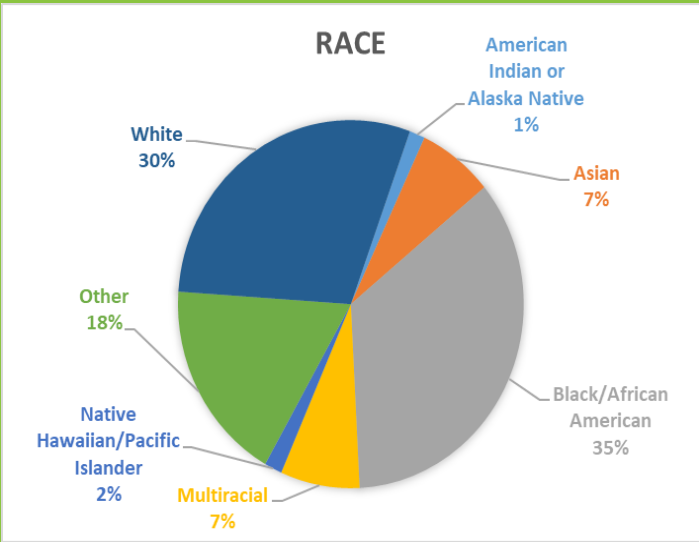


County February



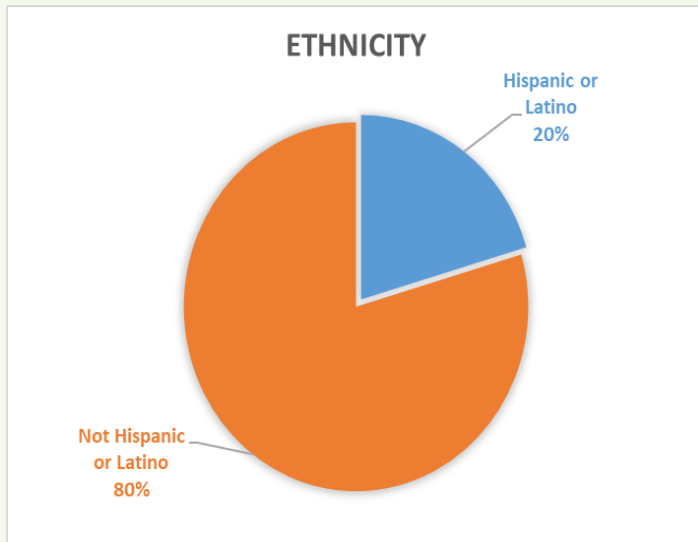

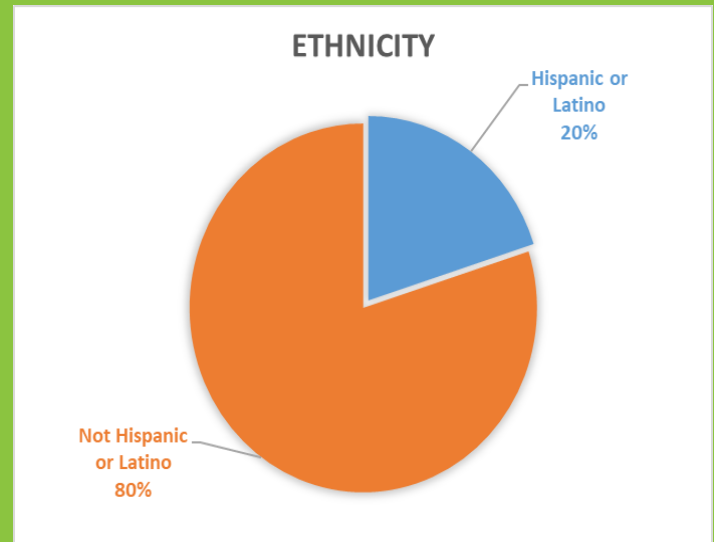

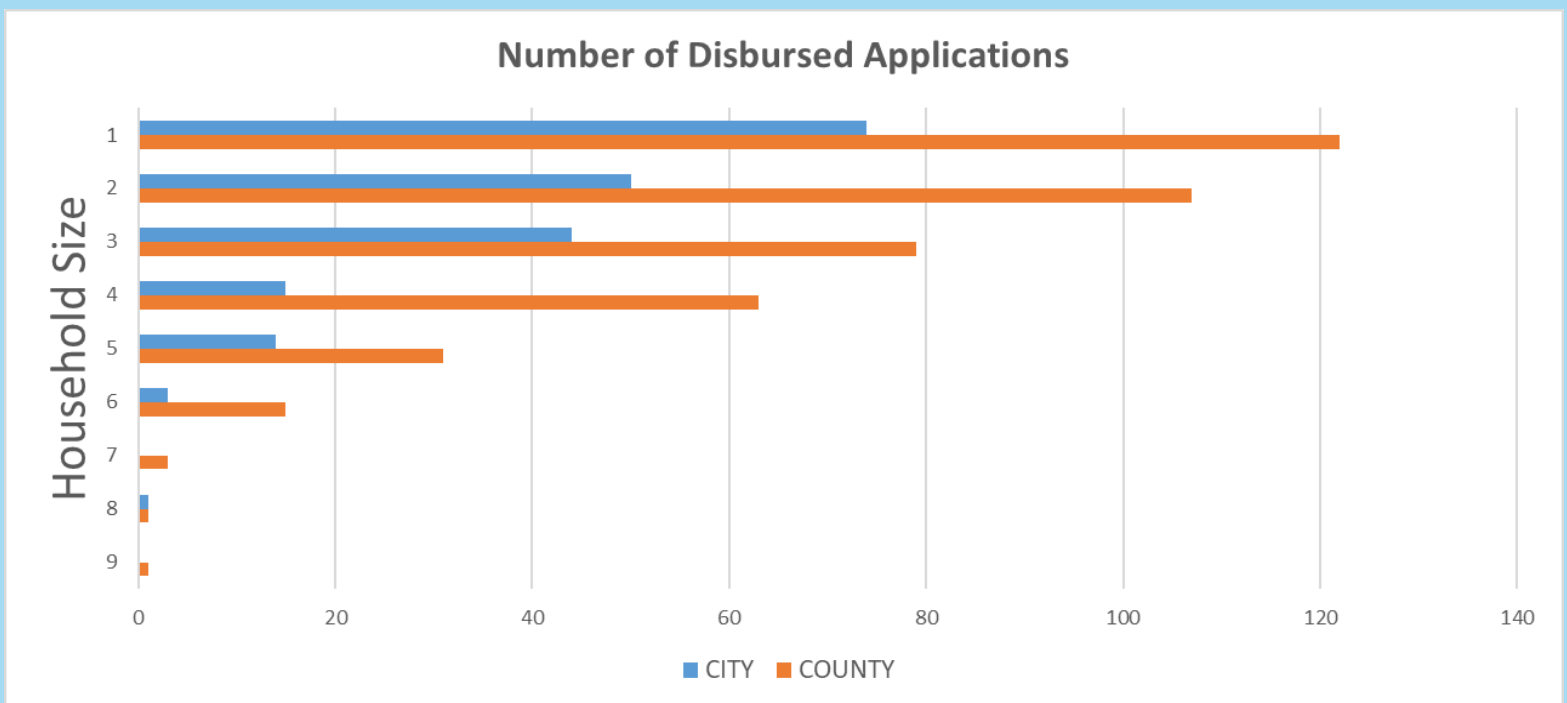

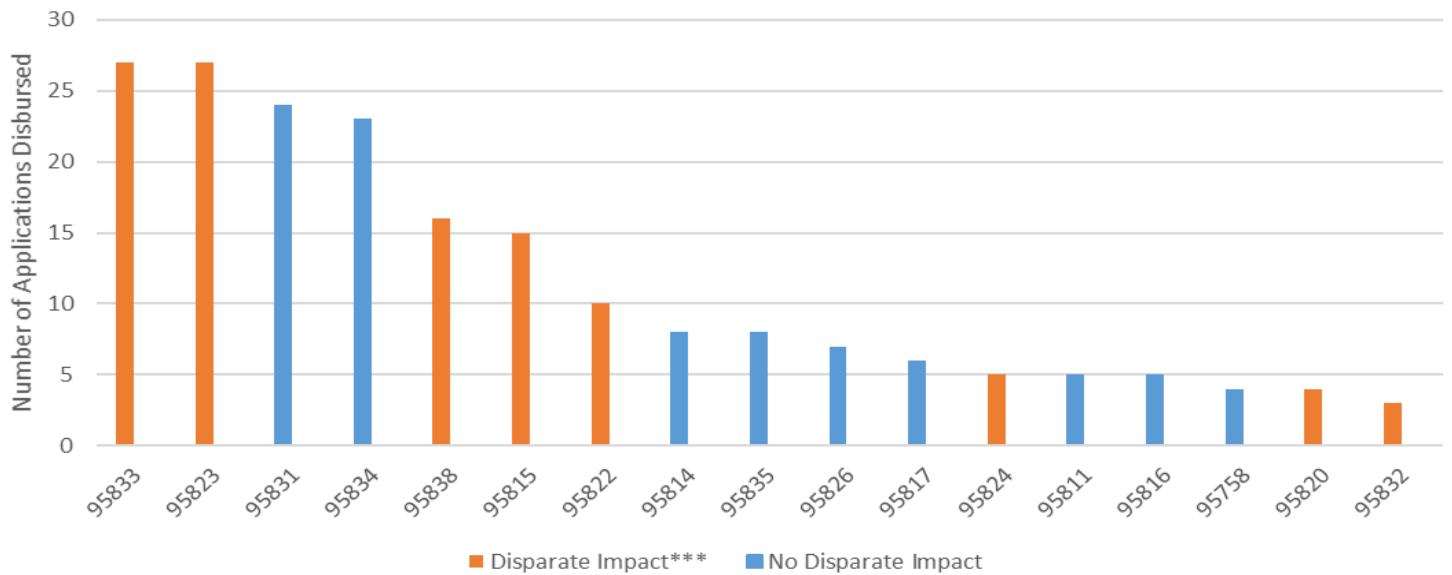
February Disbursements By Household Size

City/County

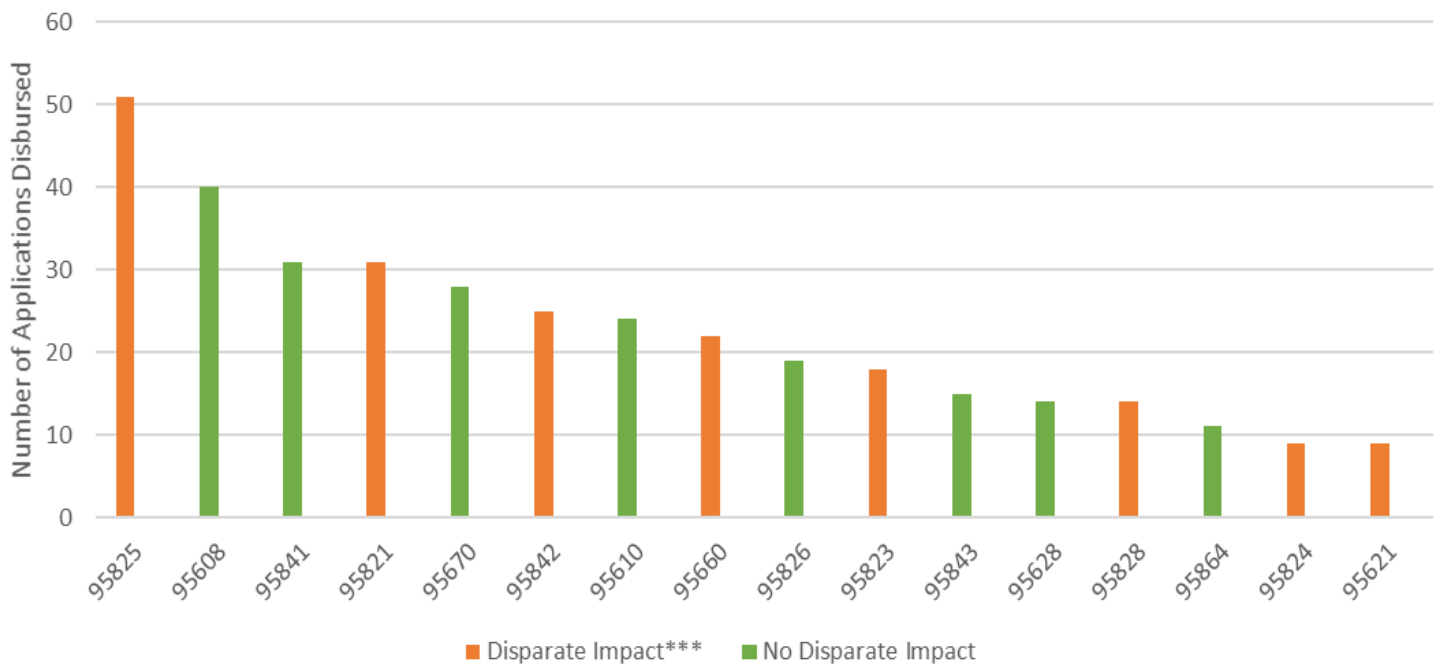


February Top Disbursement Zip Codes
