SHRA Executive Director honored for excellence in leadership

Sacramento, Calif. | SHRA Executive Director La Shelle Dozier was honored with two prestigious awards for her outstanding leadership and her service to the community.

Ms. Dozier received the [Business Journal's 2022 Most Admired CEO](#) award on March 9 after being nominated by her peers. The Business Journal defines an outstanding CEO as “an innovator, standard-bearer, role model and exceptional leader,” whose contributions “impact the organization they head as well as the community in which they serve.” The nomination spotlights a “commitment to financial success, quality, workplace wellness, diversity and philanthropy.” Ms. Dozier recently reached a 20-year milestone at the Agency. In addition to other positions she has held at SHRA, she is the longest serving Executive Director, a position she has held since 2009.



Ms. Dozier is also one of three recipients of the City of Sacramento Women of the Year award which is given in recognition of Women's History Month in March. Vice Mayor Angelique Ashby, and Councilmembers Katie Valenzuela and Mai Vang presented the award during the council meeting on April 5 to acknowledge those who helped forged the path making way for them to have a seat at this table. Nilda Valmores and the late former Sacramento mayor Ann Rudin were also honored with the award.
