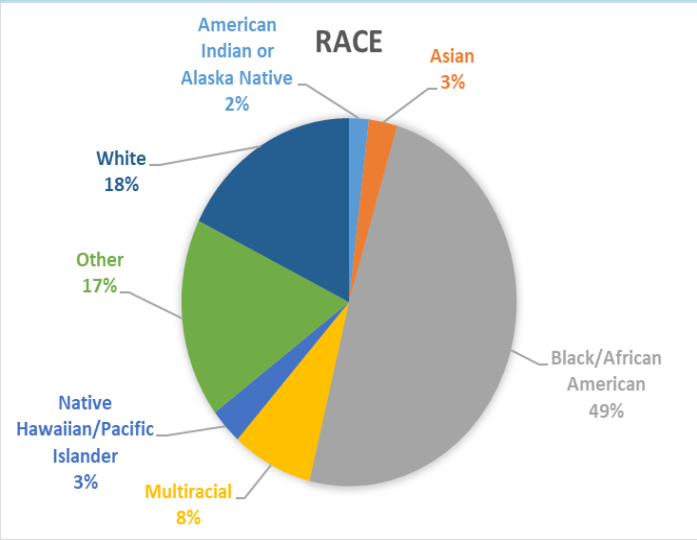

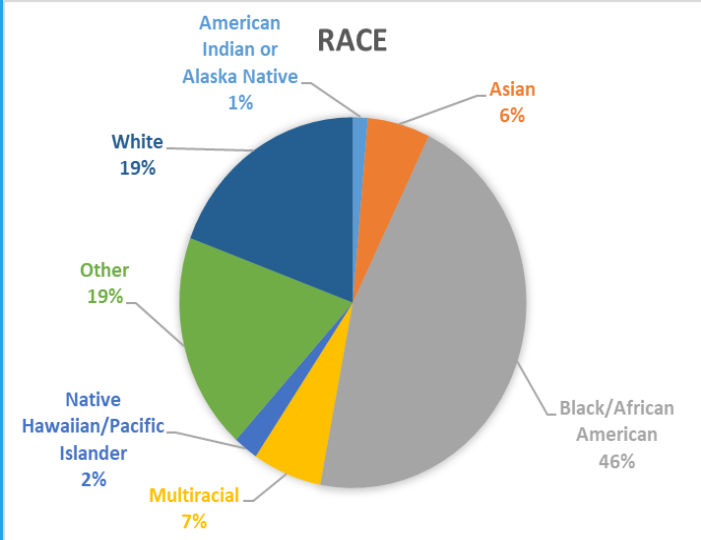
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

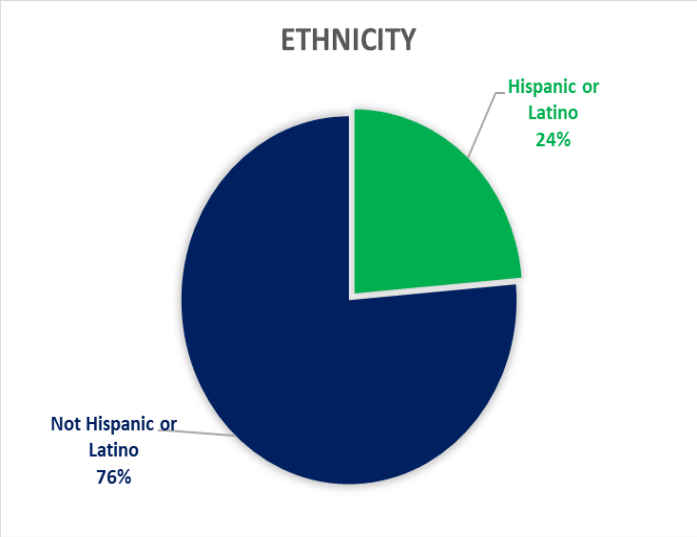

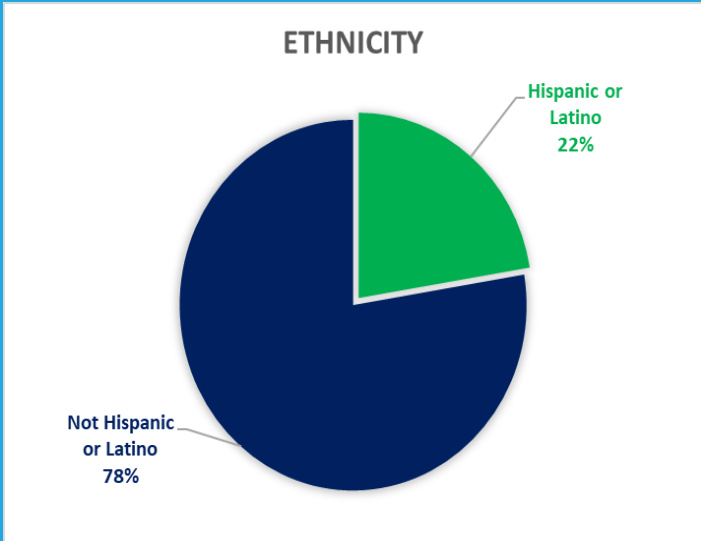

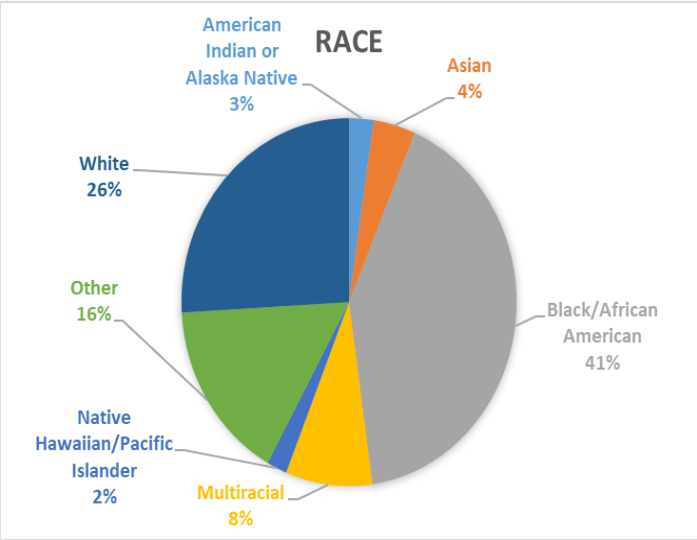

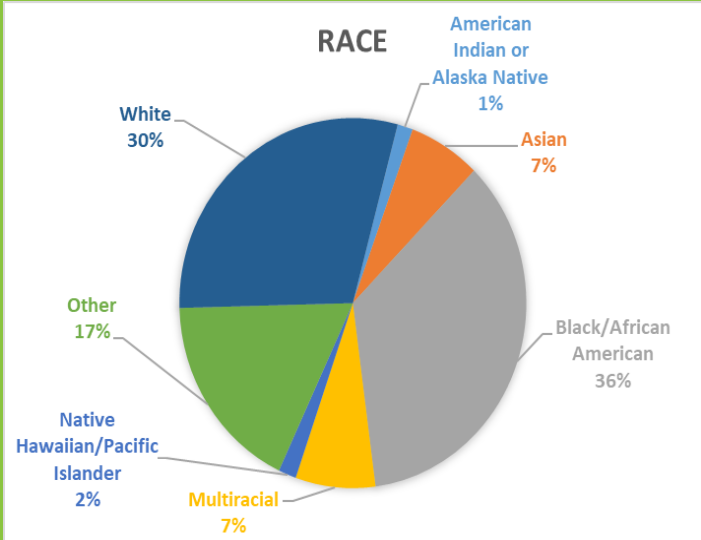


County April



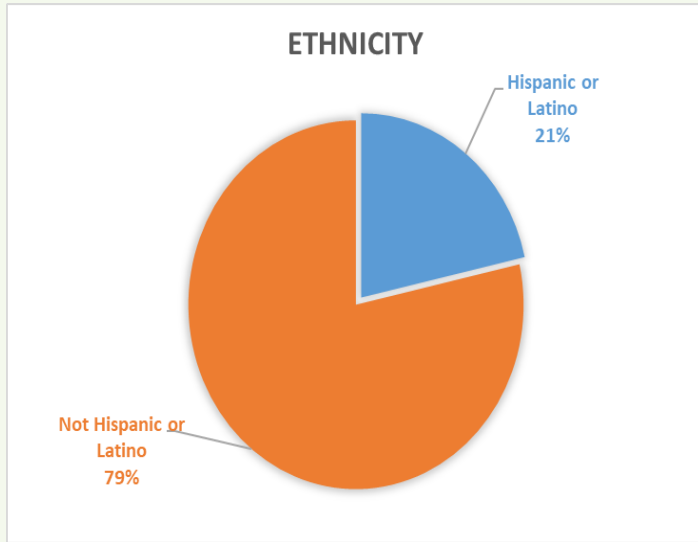

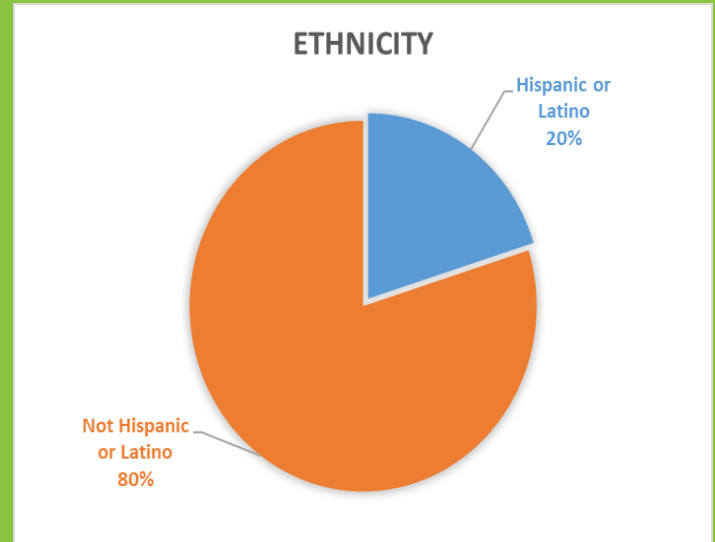

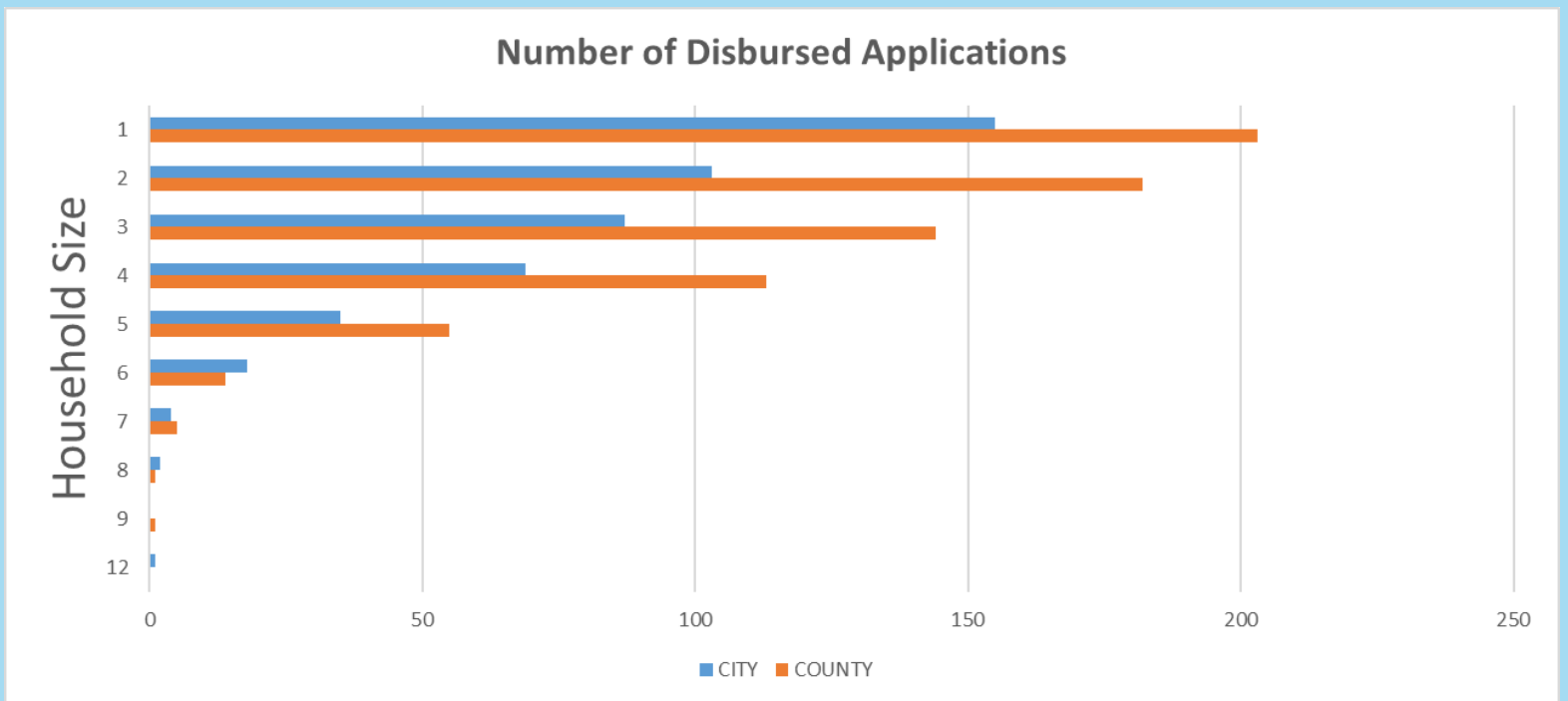

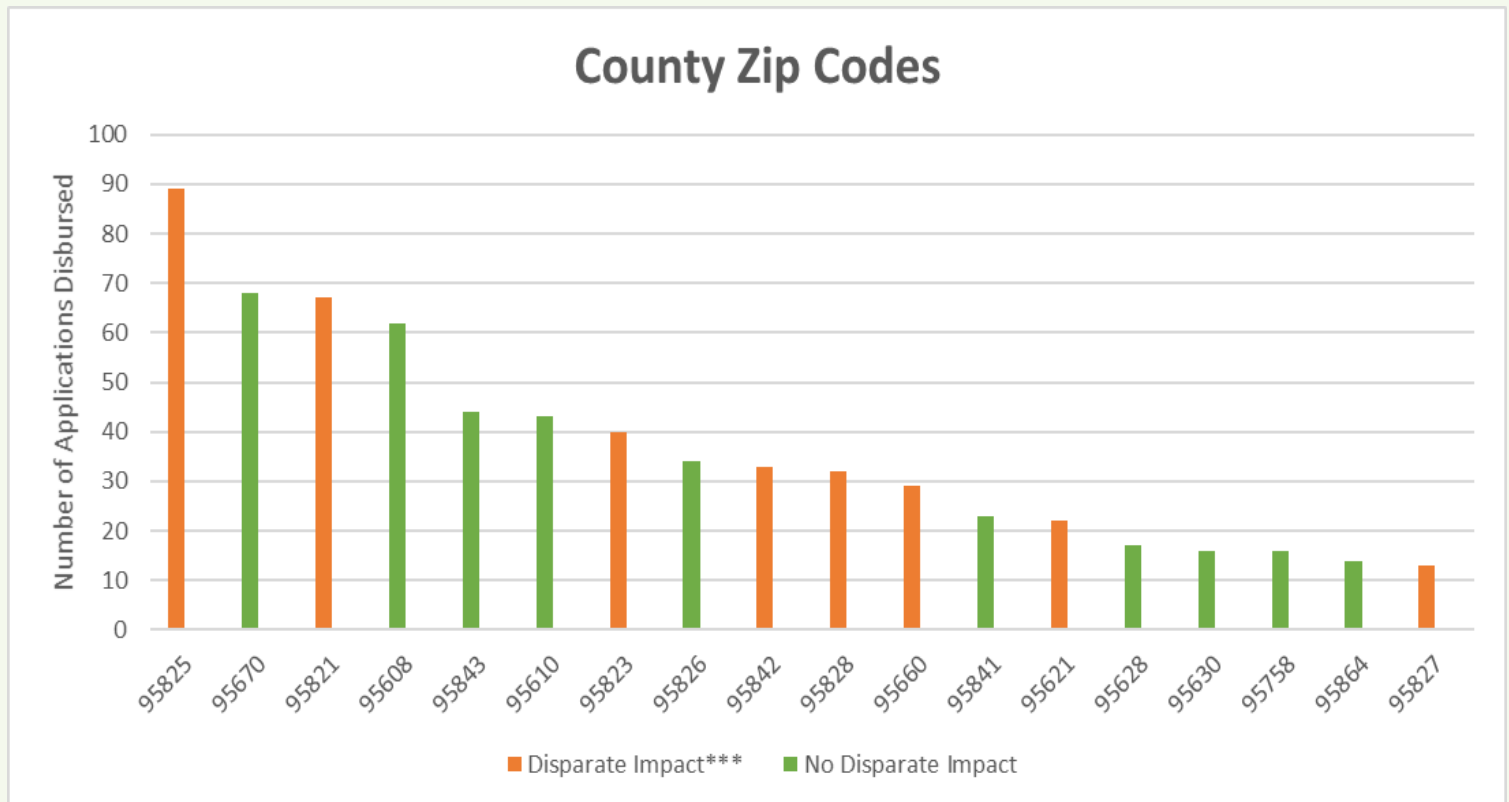
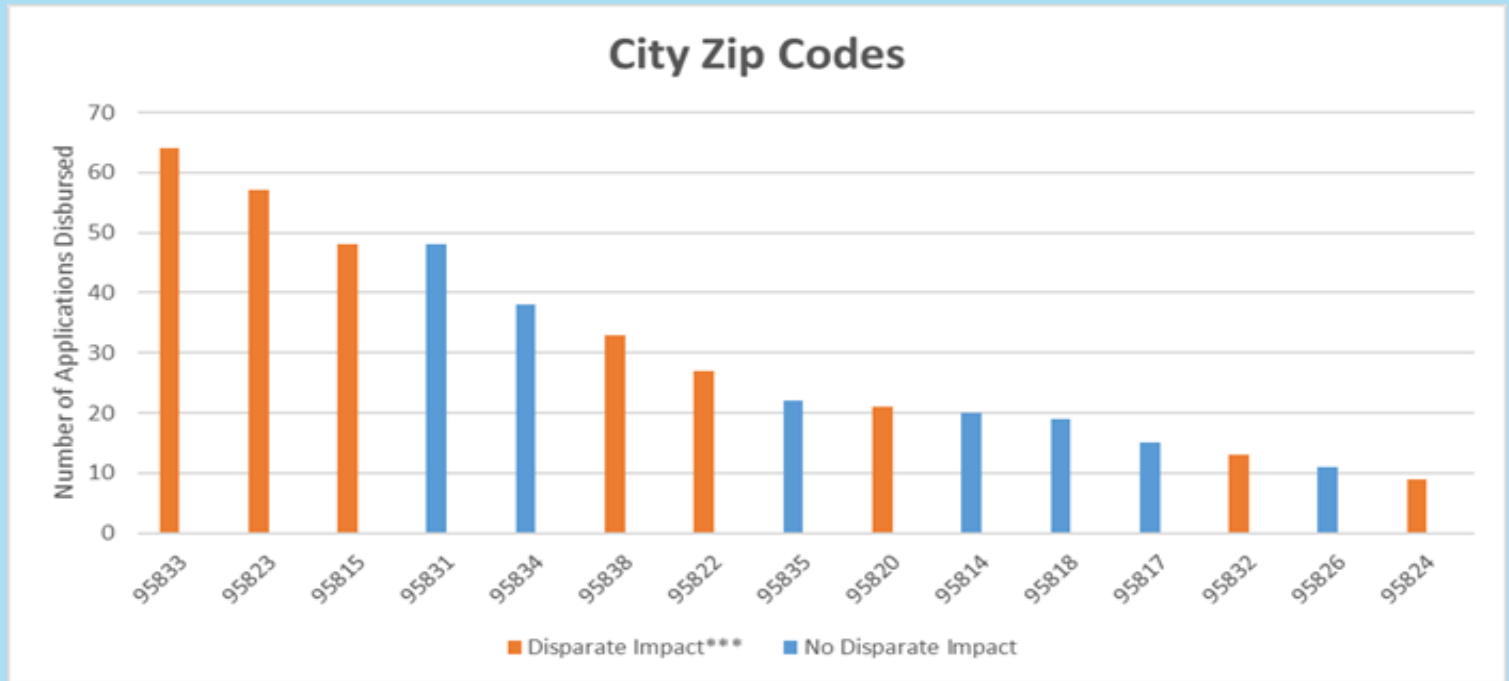


April Disbursements By Household Size
