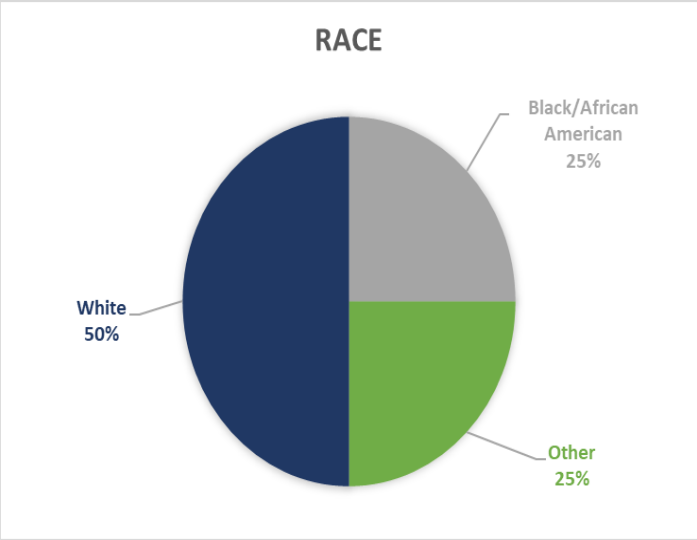

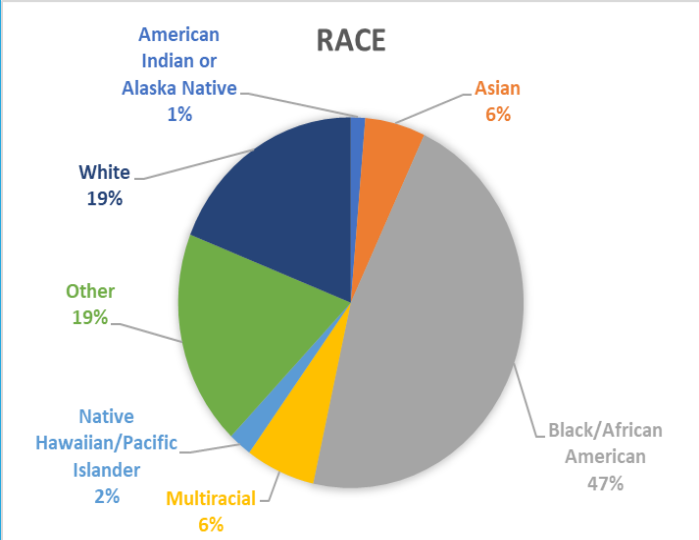
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

City October



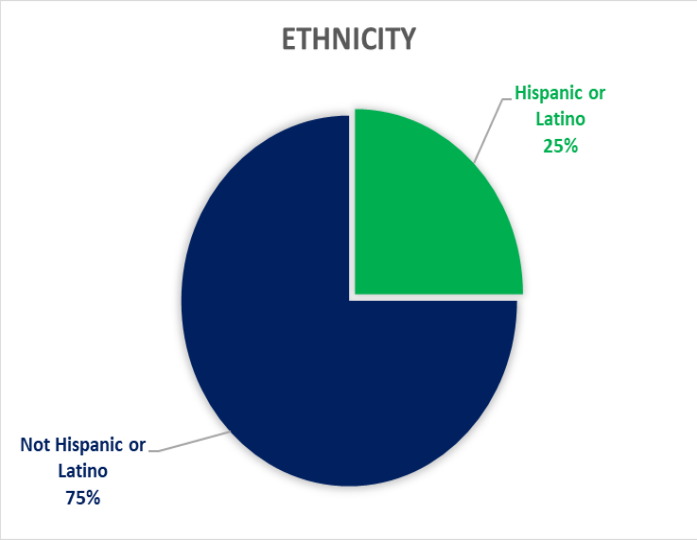

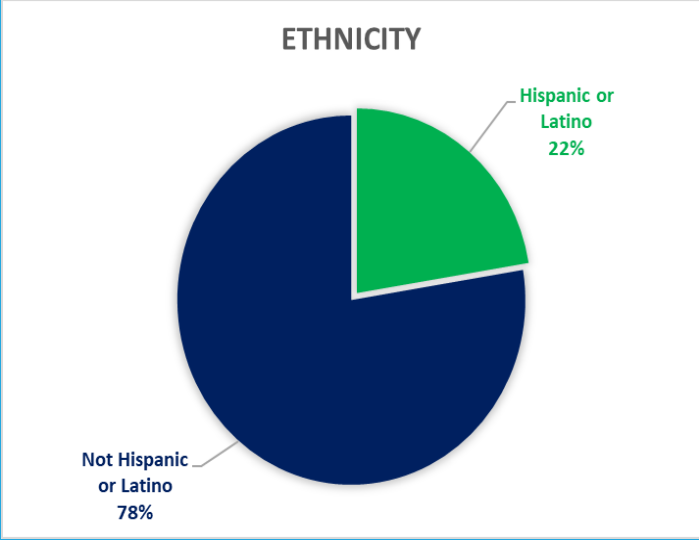

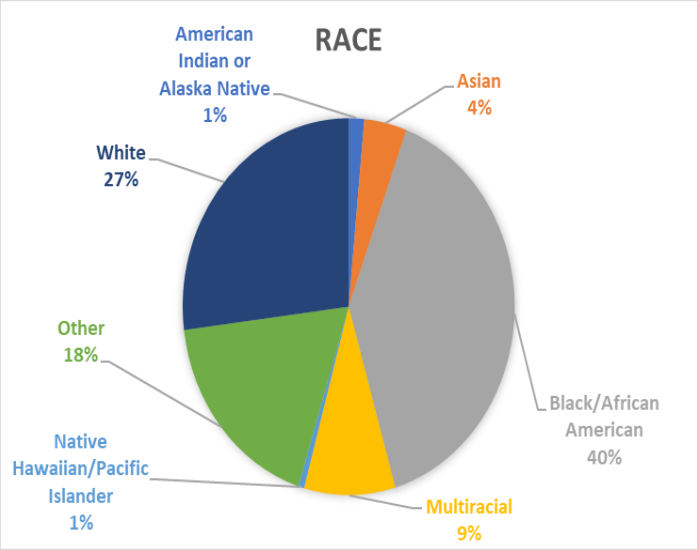

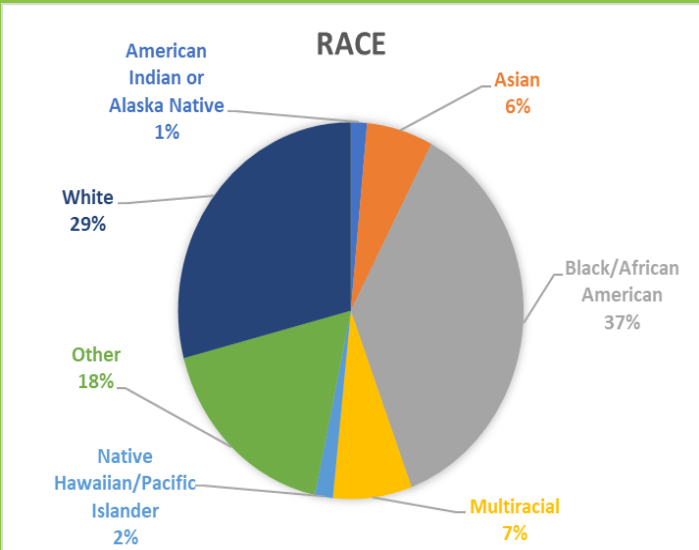


County October



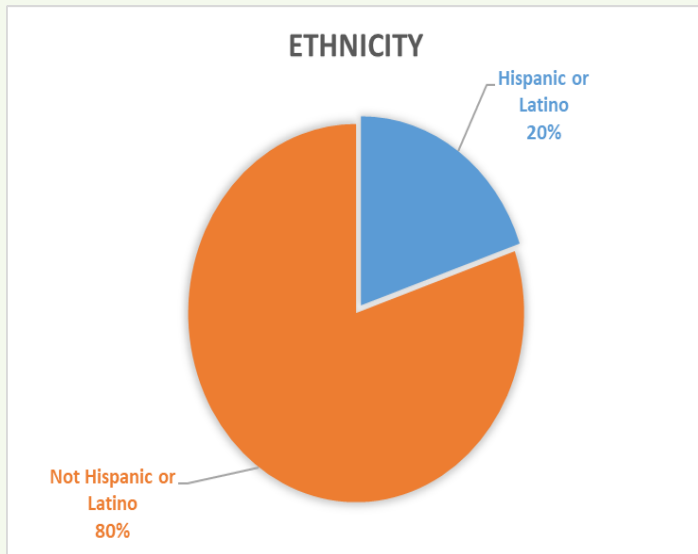

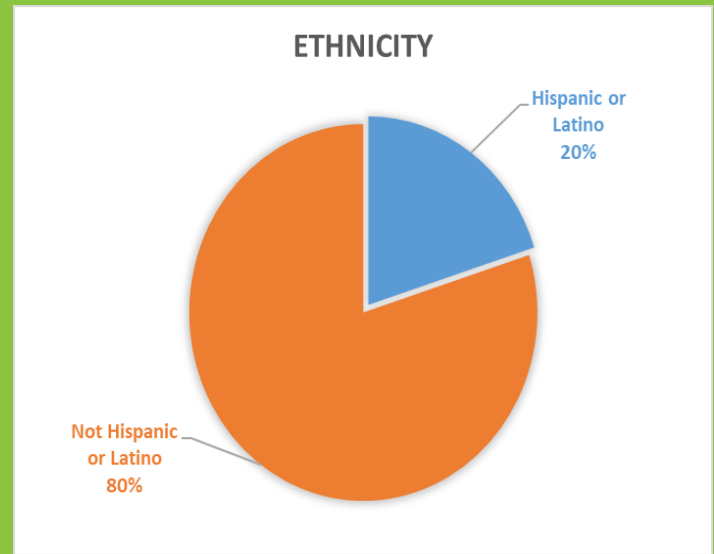

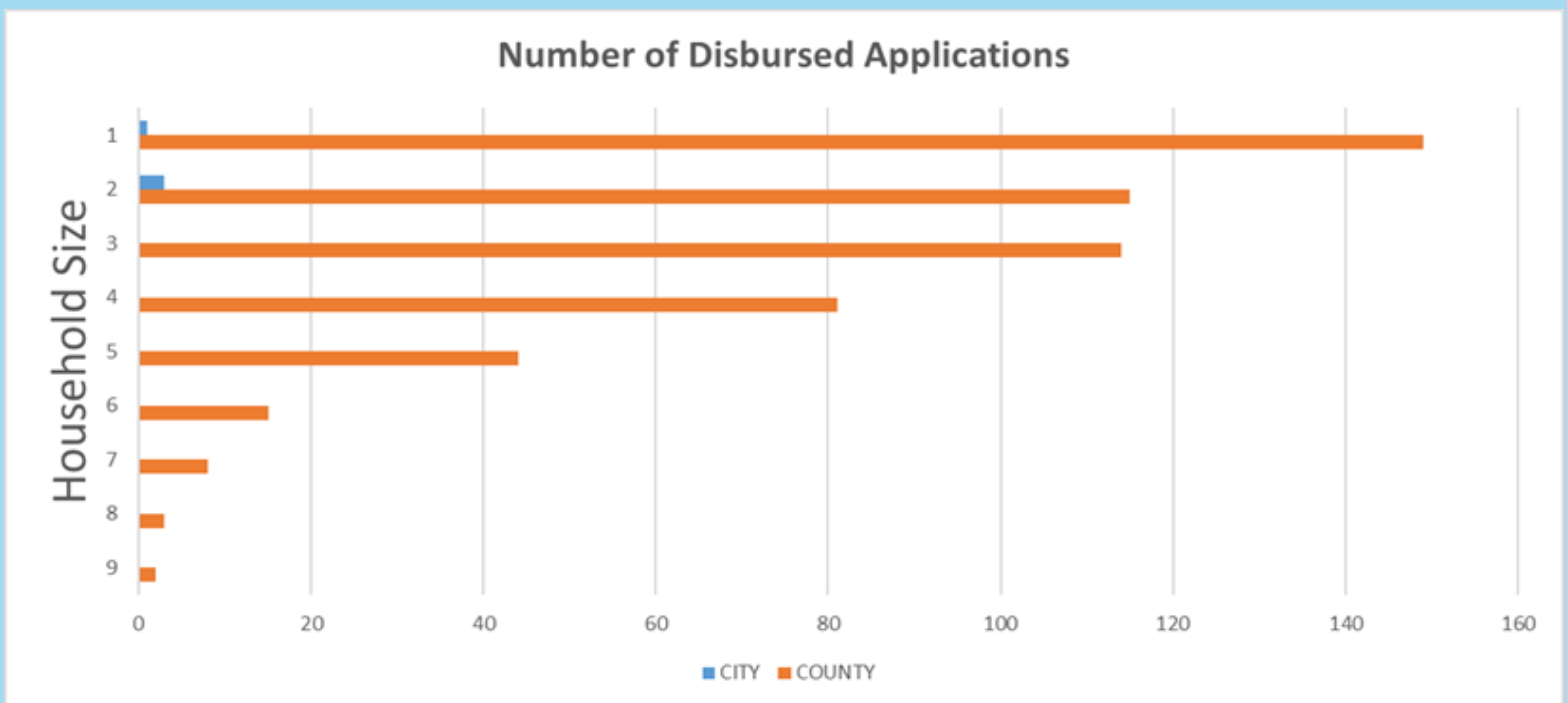

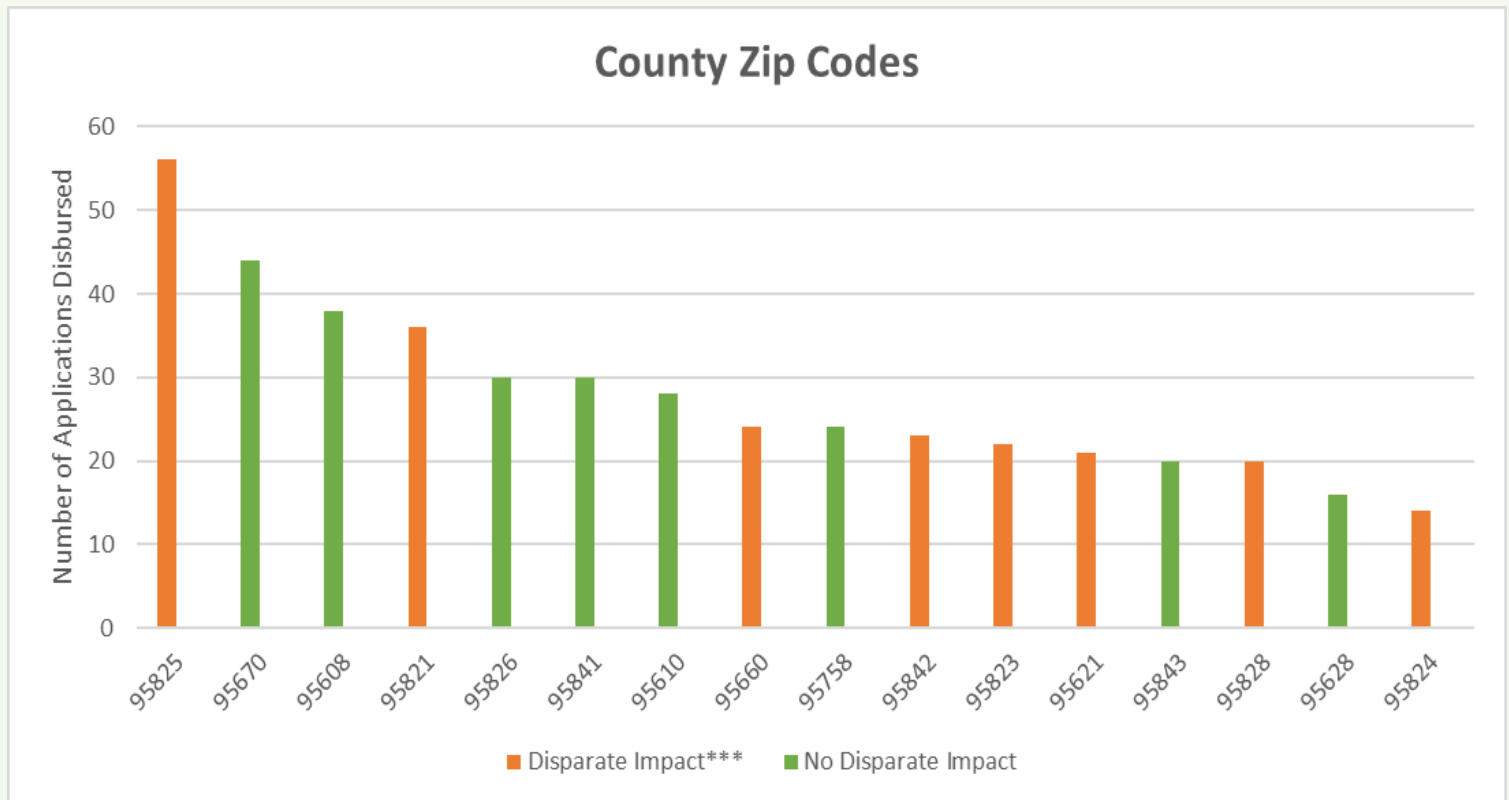
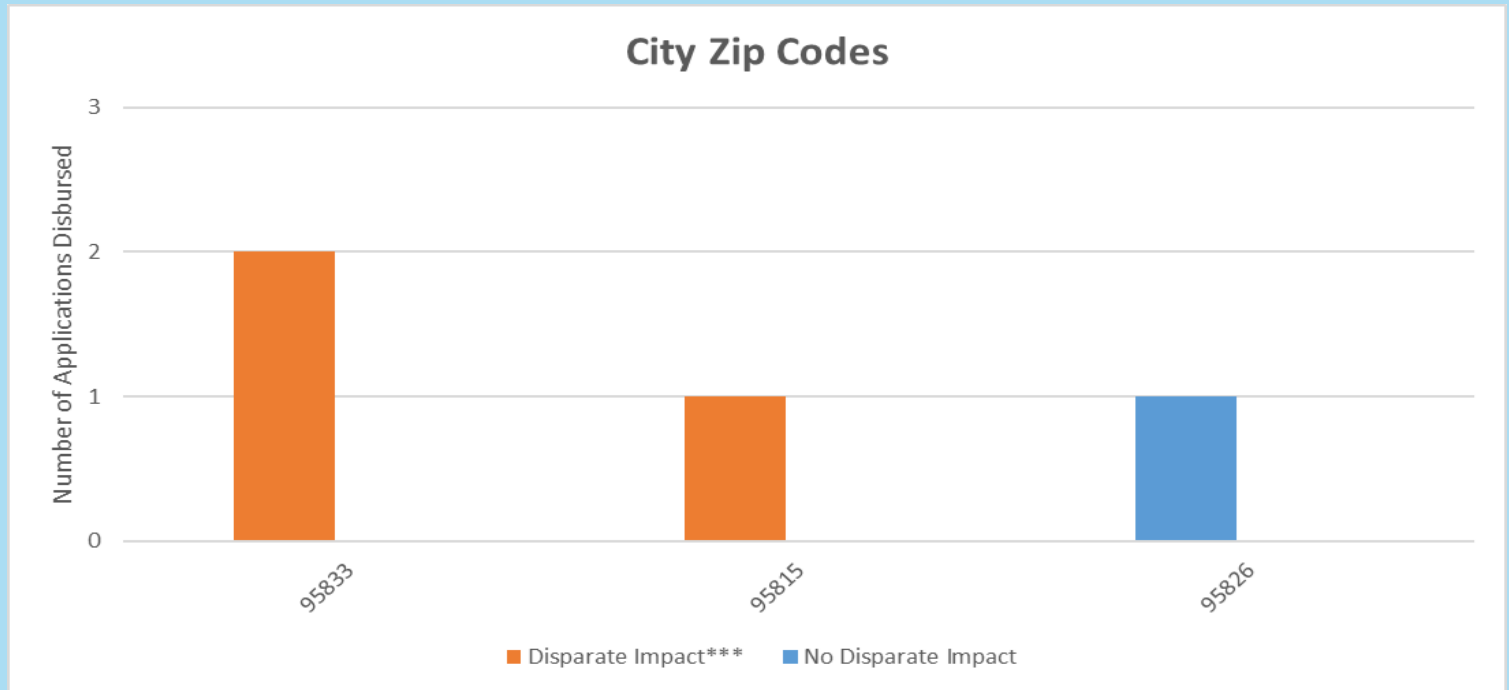


October Disbursements By Household Size
