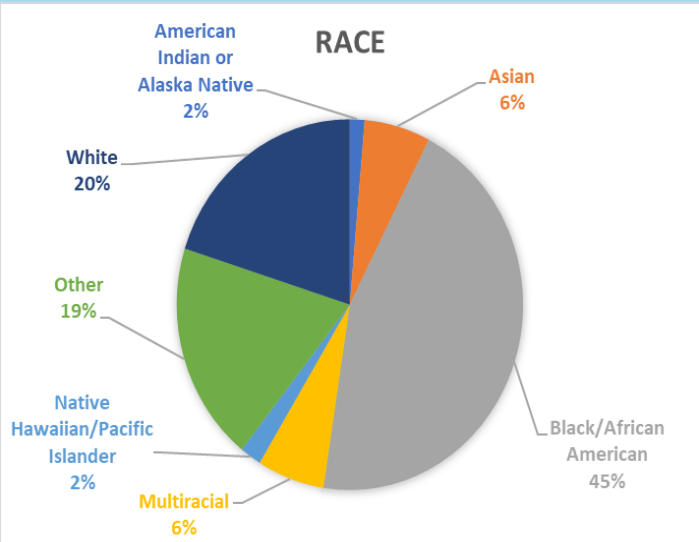

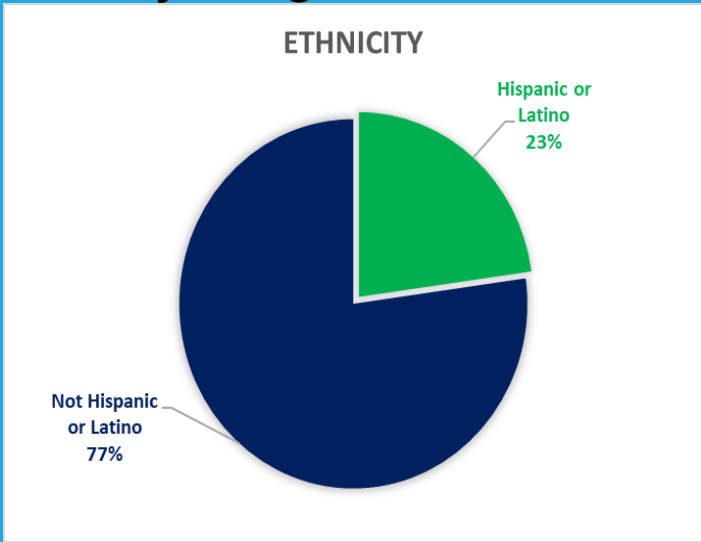
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

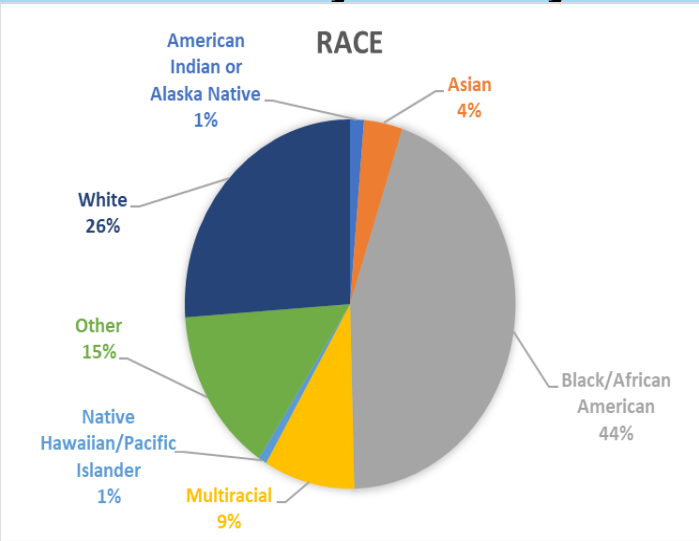

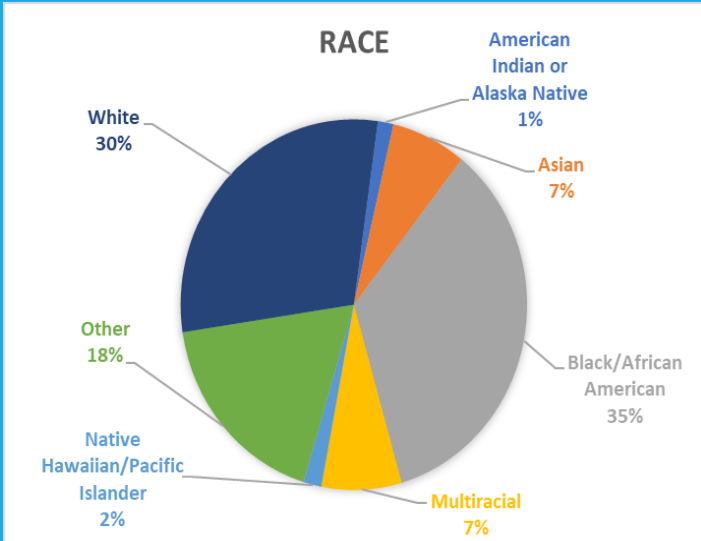

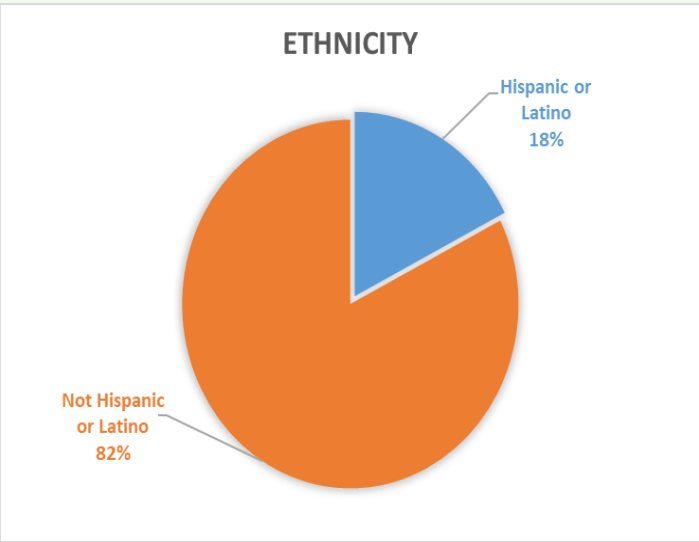
County January



County Program to Date

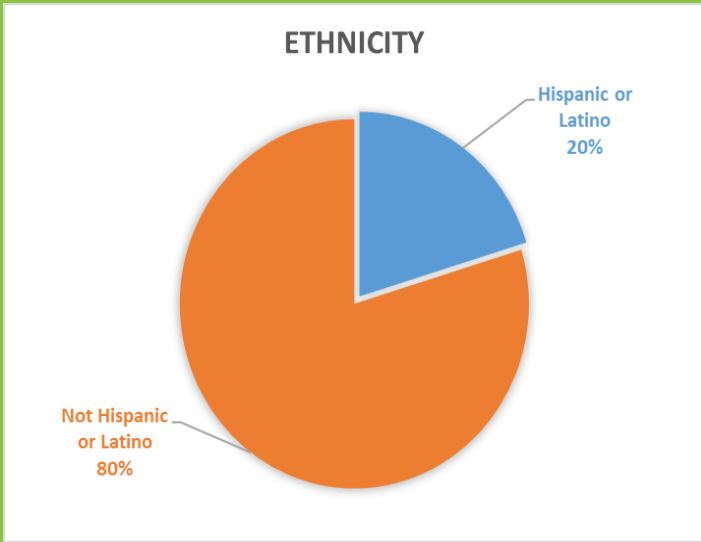

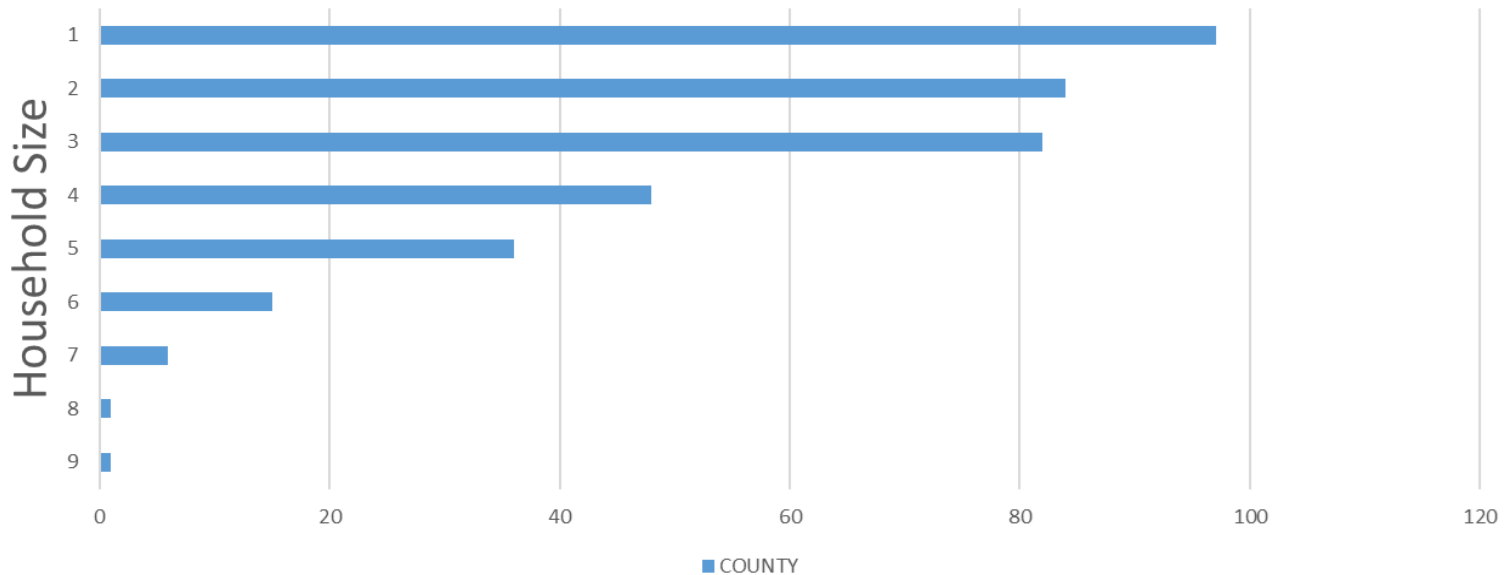


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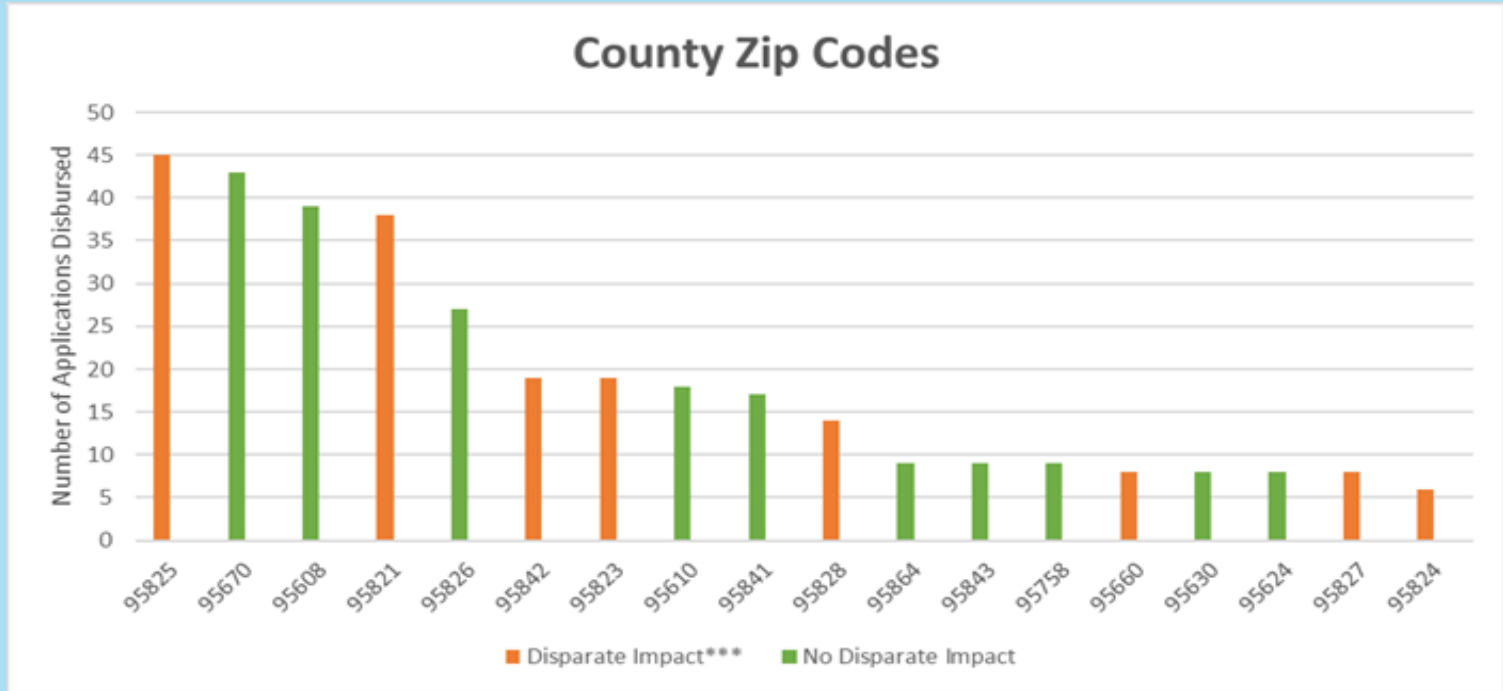
January Disbursements By Household Size
