## PERMANENT LOCAL HOUSING ALLOCATION ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2022

The Permanent Local Housing Allocation (PLHA) provides funding to local governments in California for housing-related projects and programs that assist in addressing the unmet housing needs of their local communities. Revenue is generated through recording fees on real estate transactions and will, therefore, vary from year to year depending upon activity. At least 20 percent of PLHA funds must be expended for Affordable Owner-Occupied Workforce Housing, and the program prioritizes investments that increase the supply of housing to households that are at or below 60 percent of the Area Median Income (AMI), adjusted for household size.
