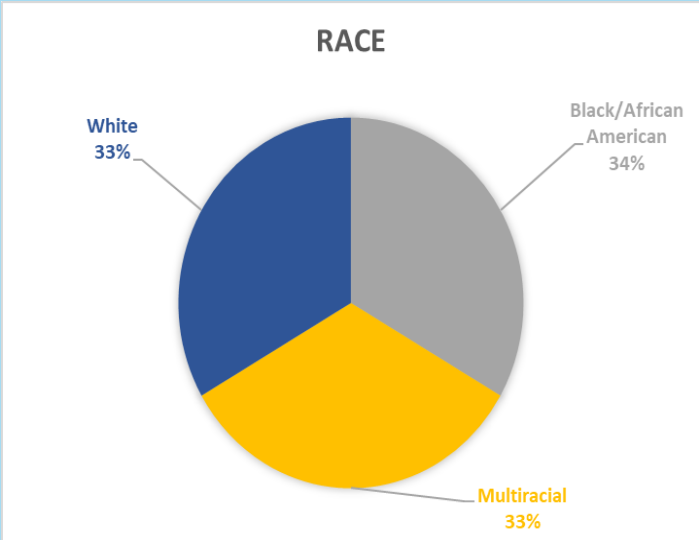

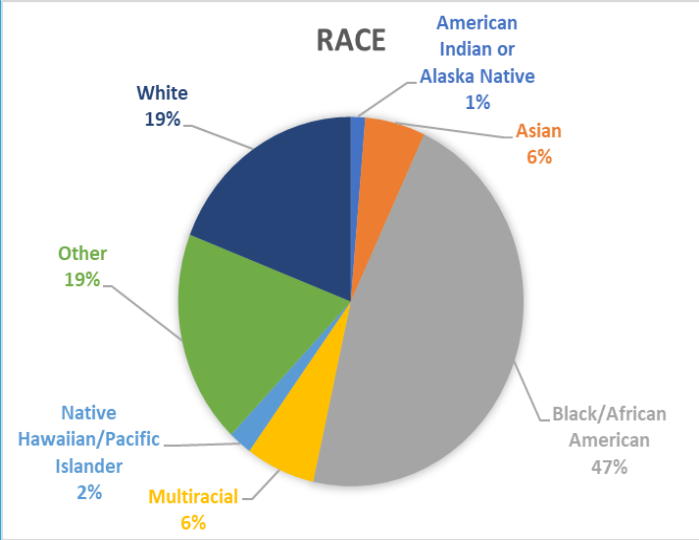
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

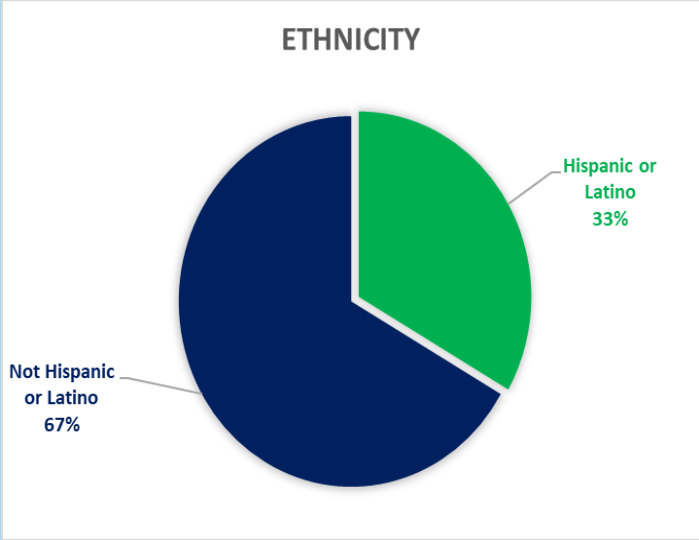

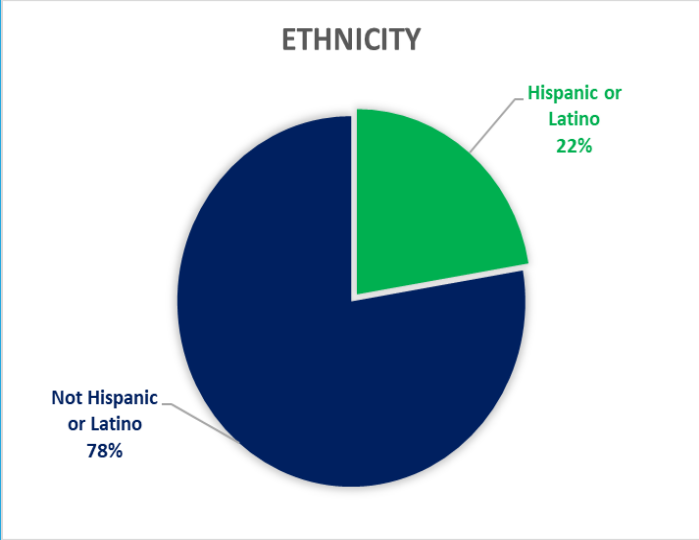

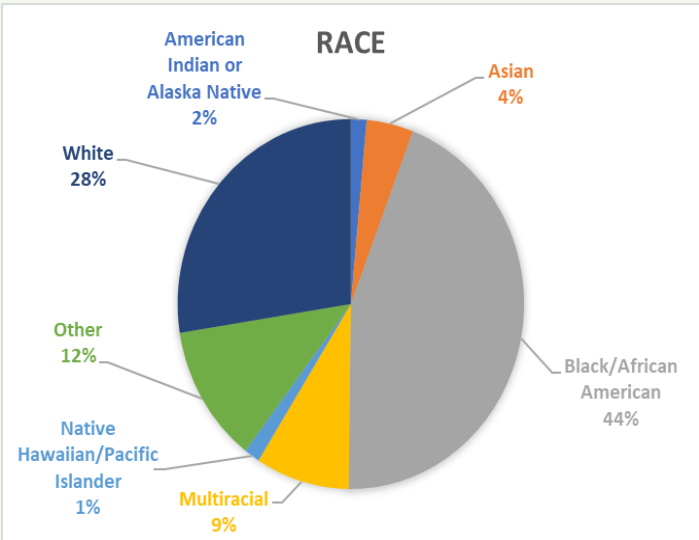

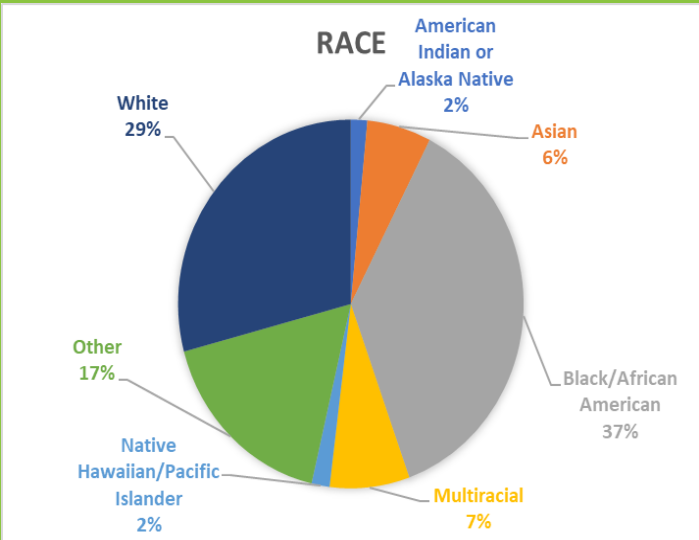


County May



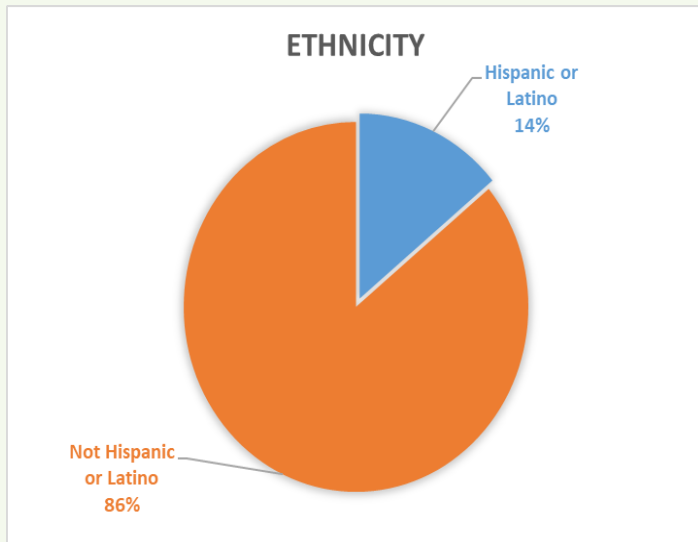

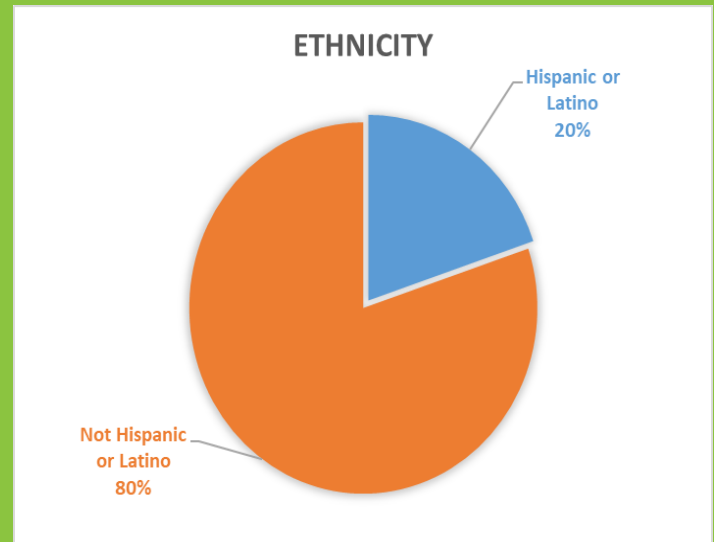

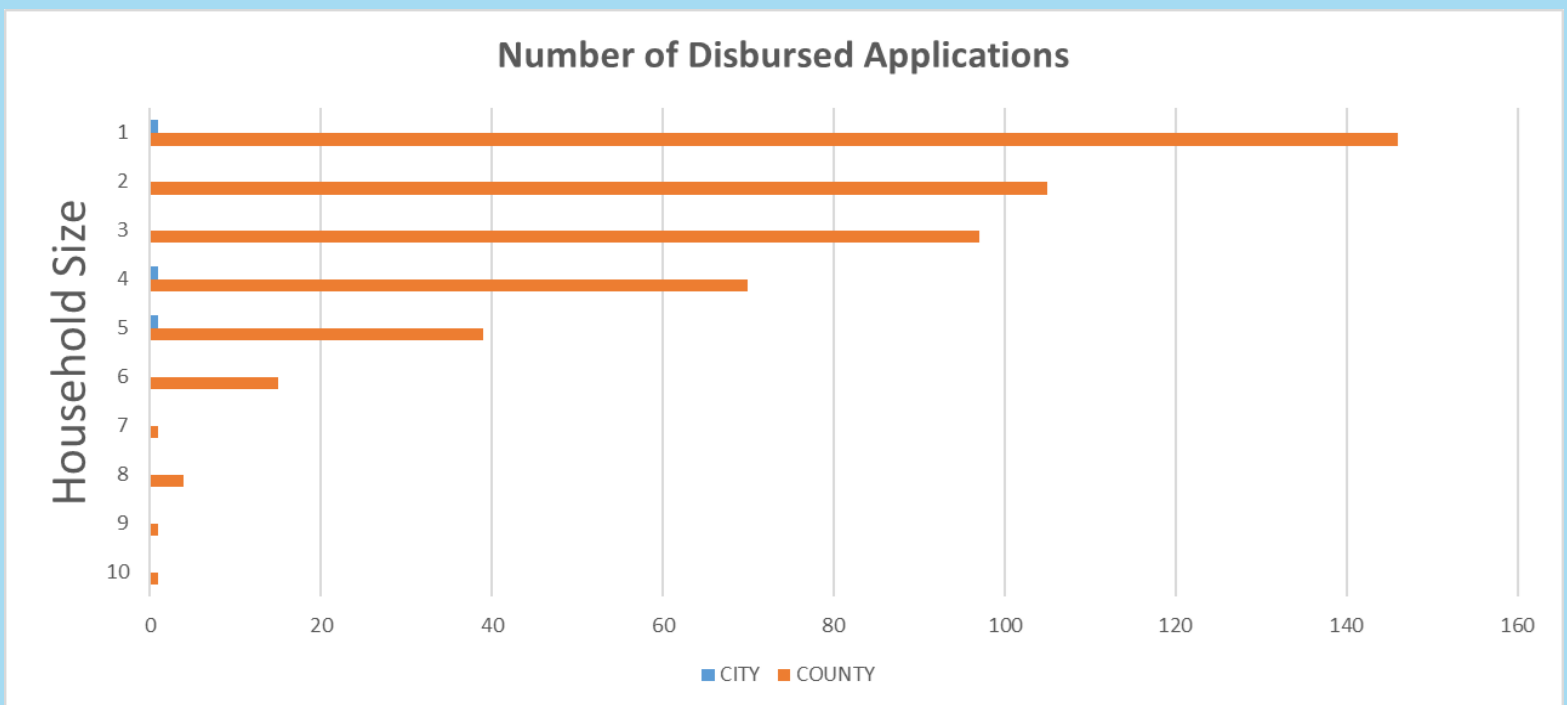

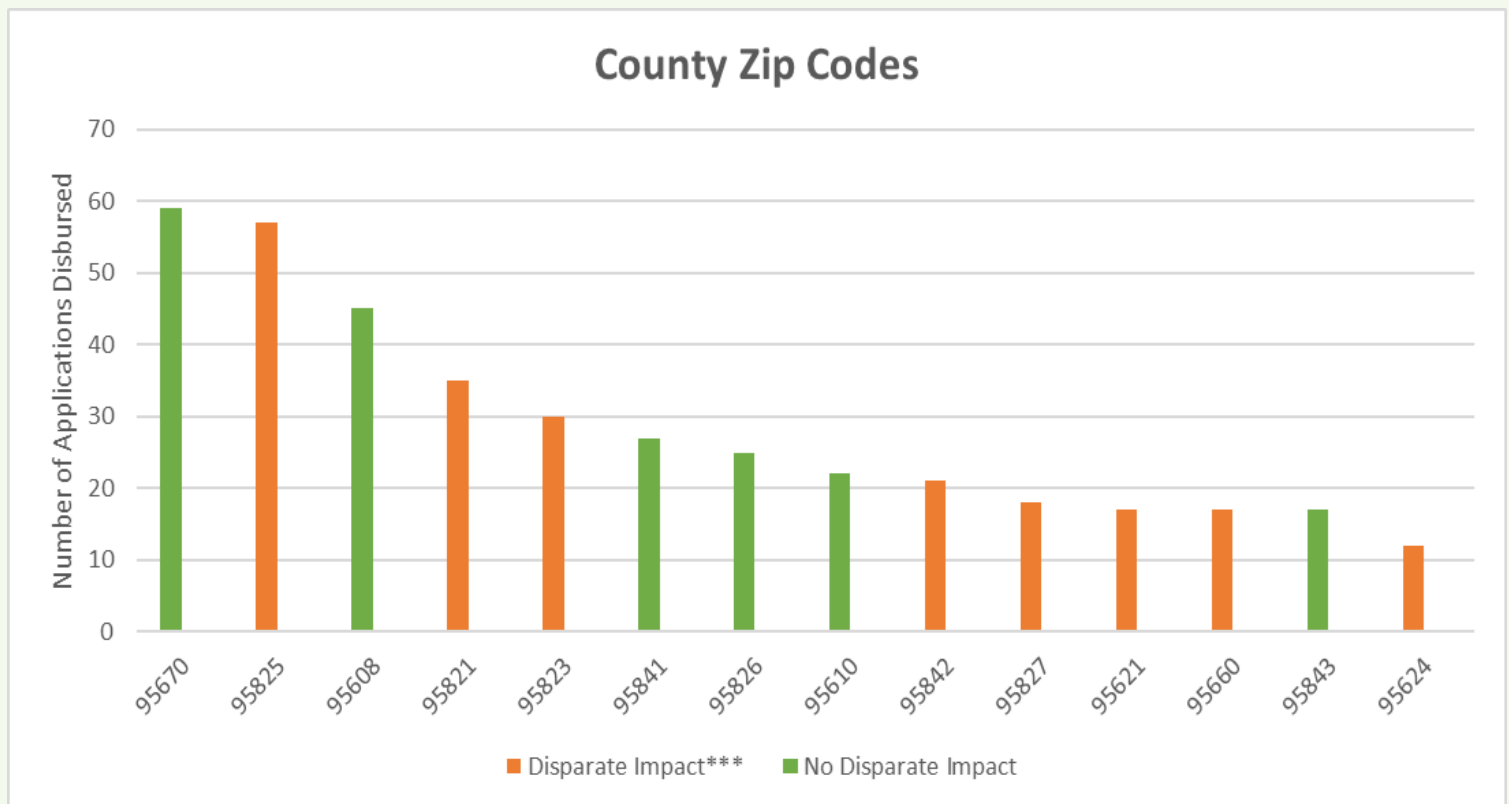
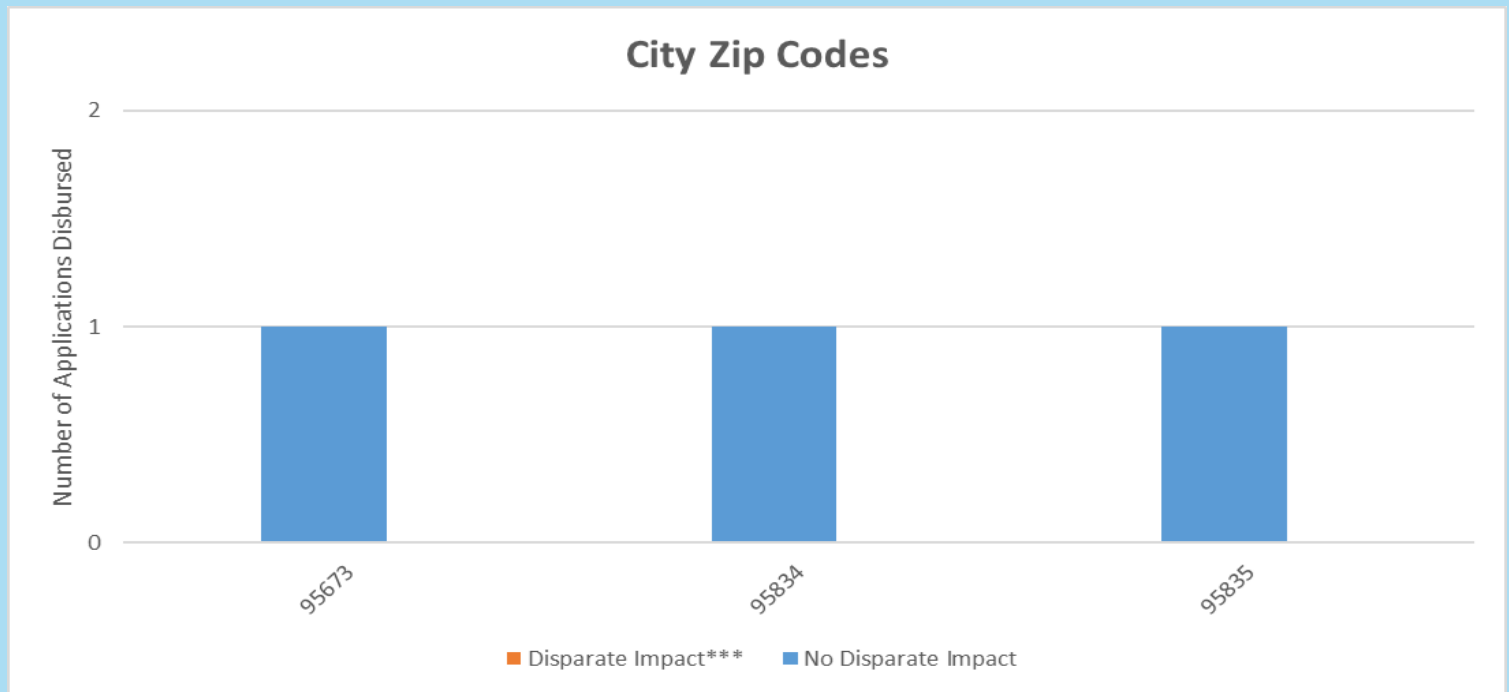


May Disbursements By Household Size
