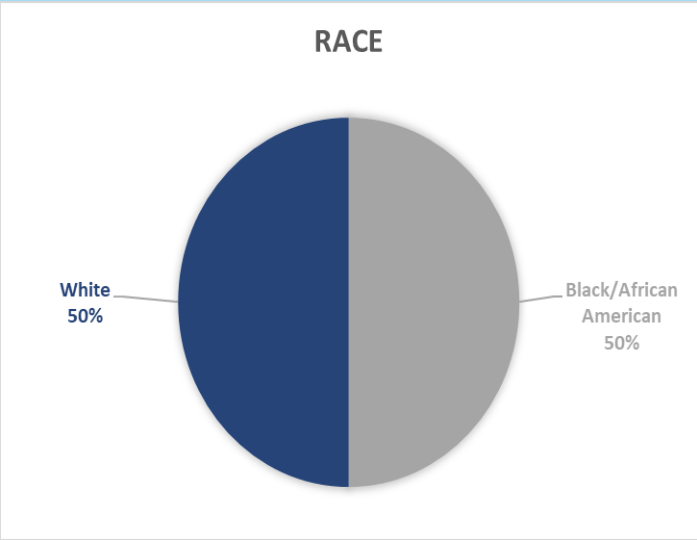

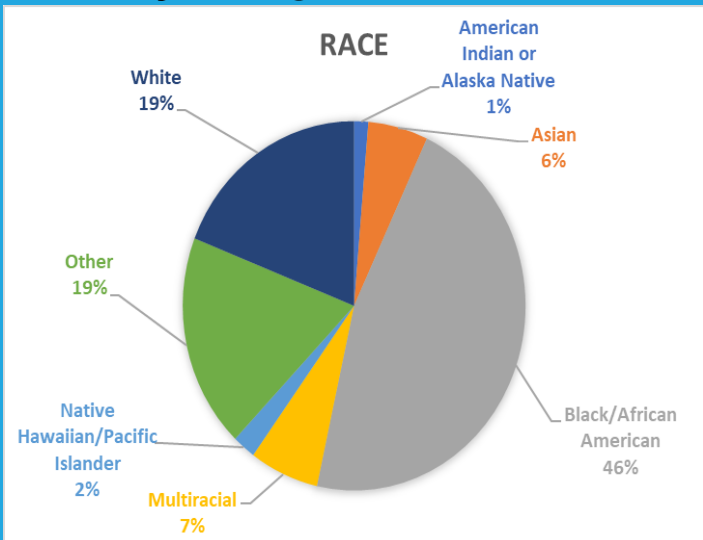
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

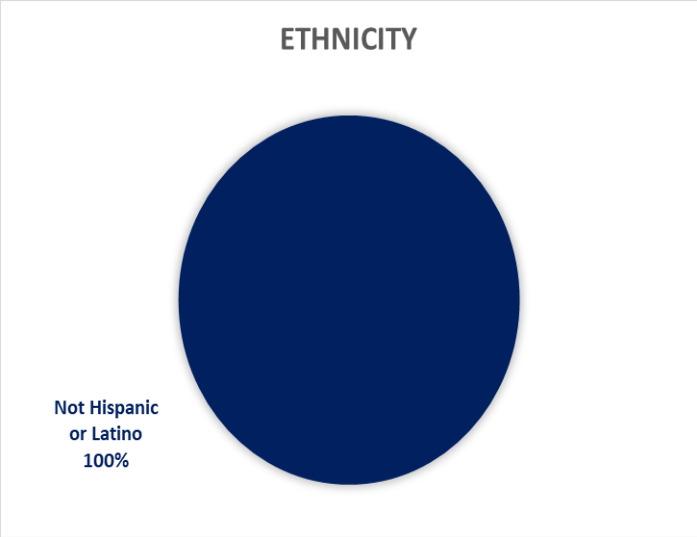

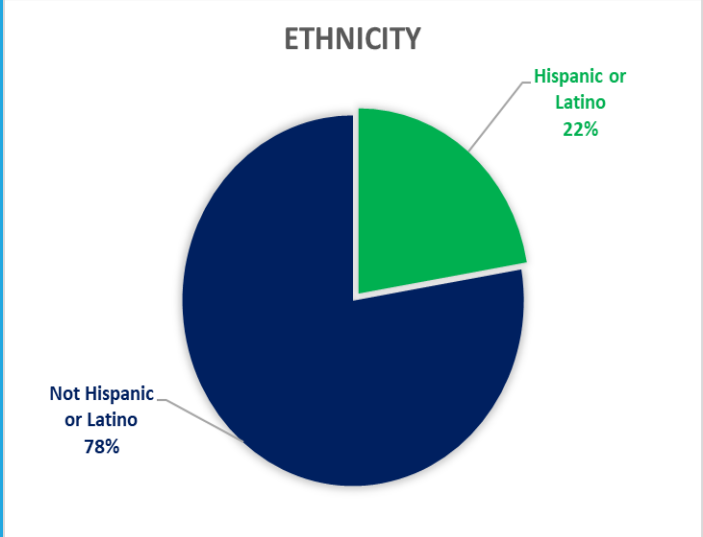

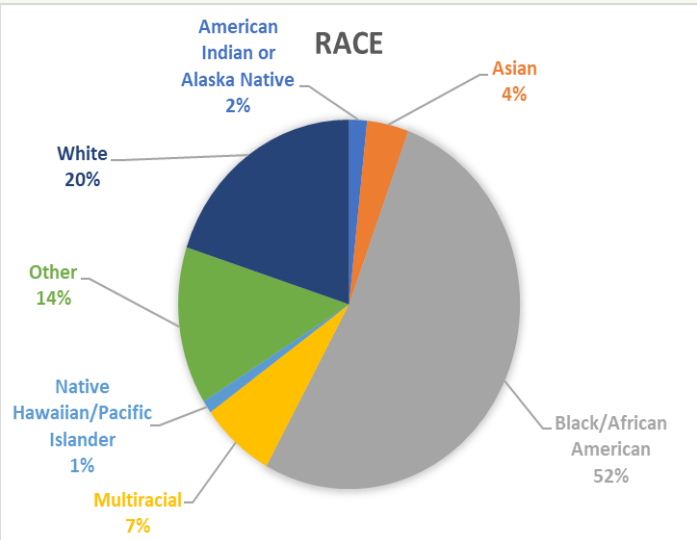

City Program to Date

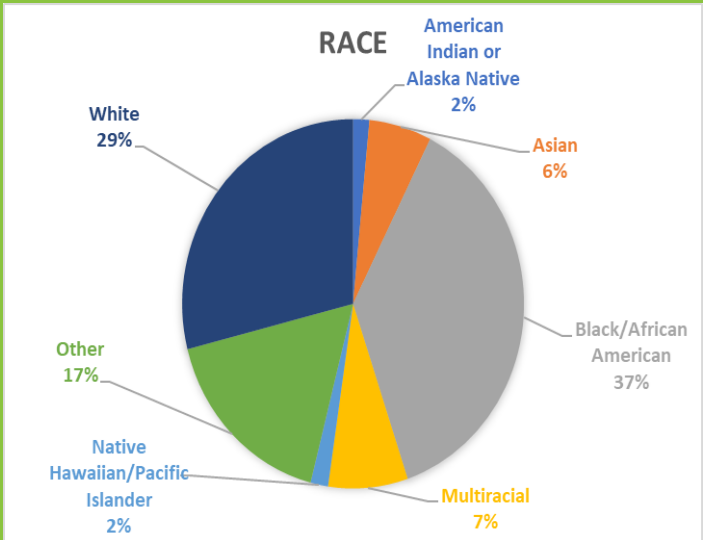


County October



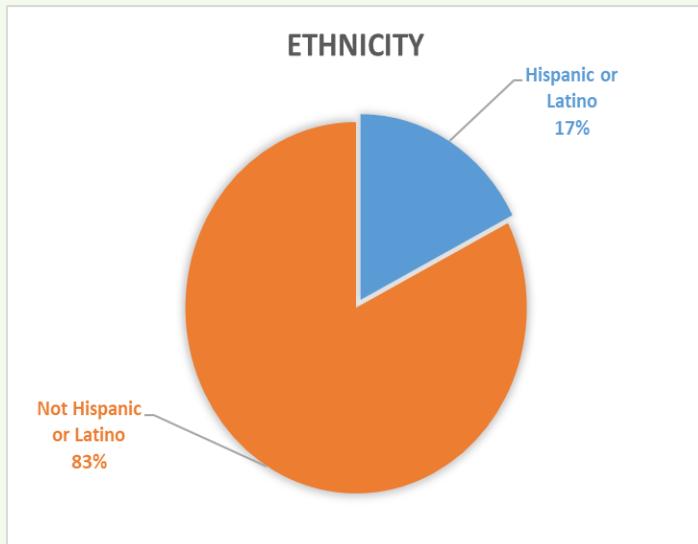

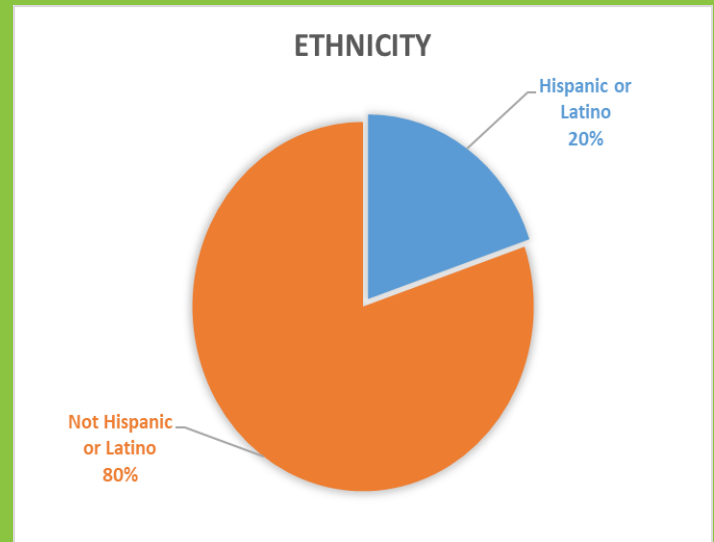

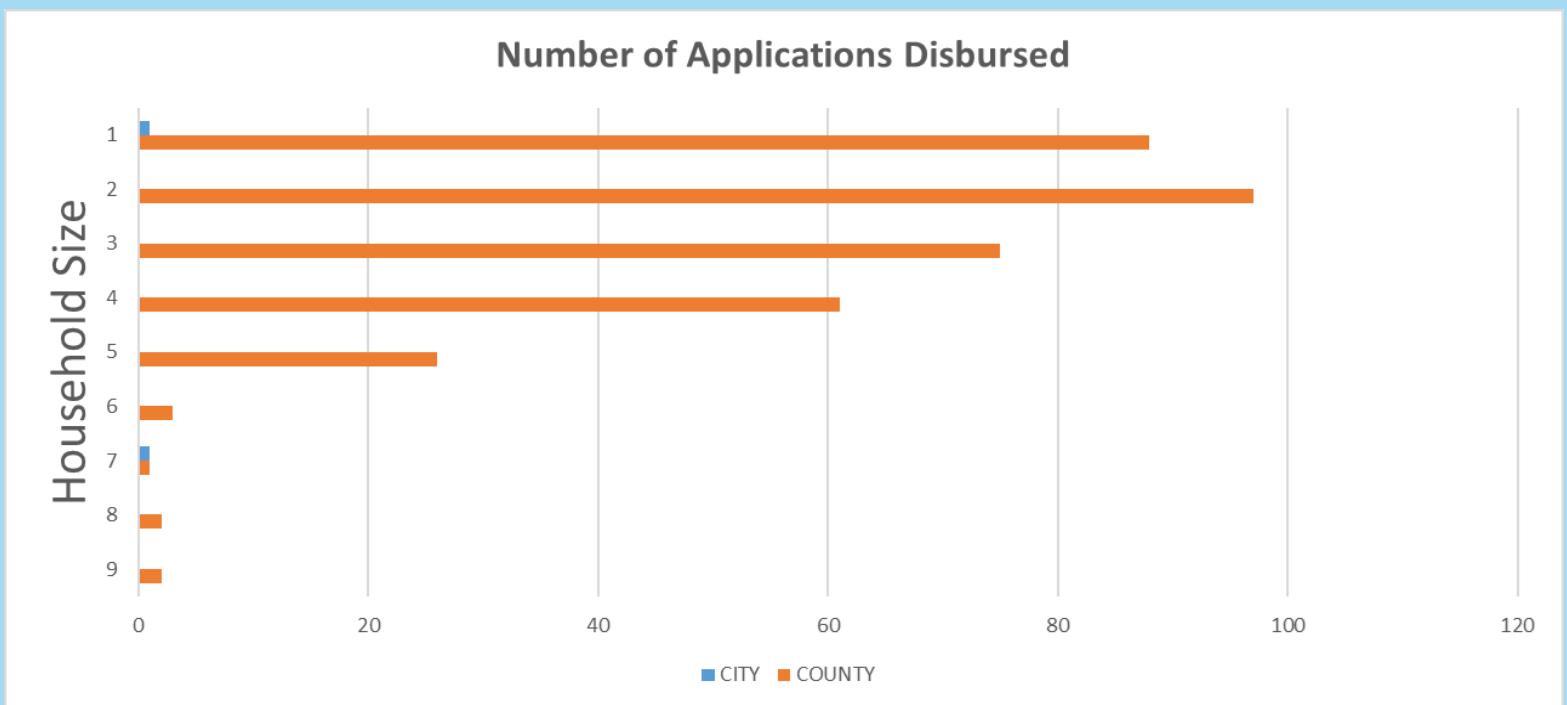

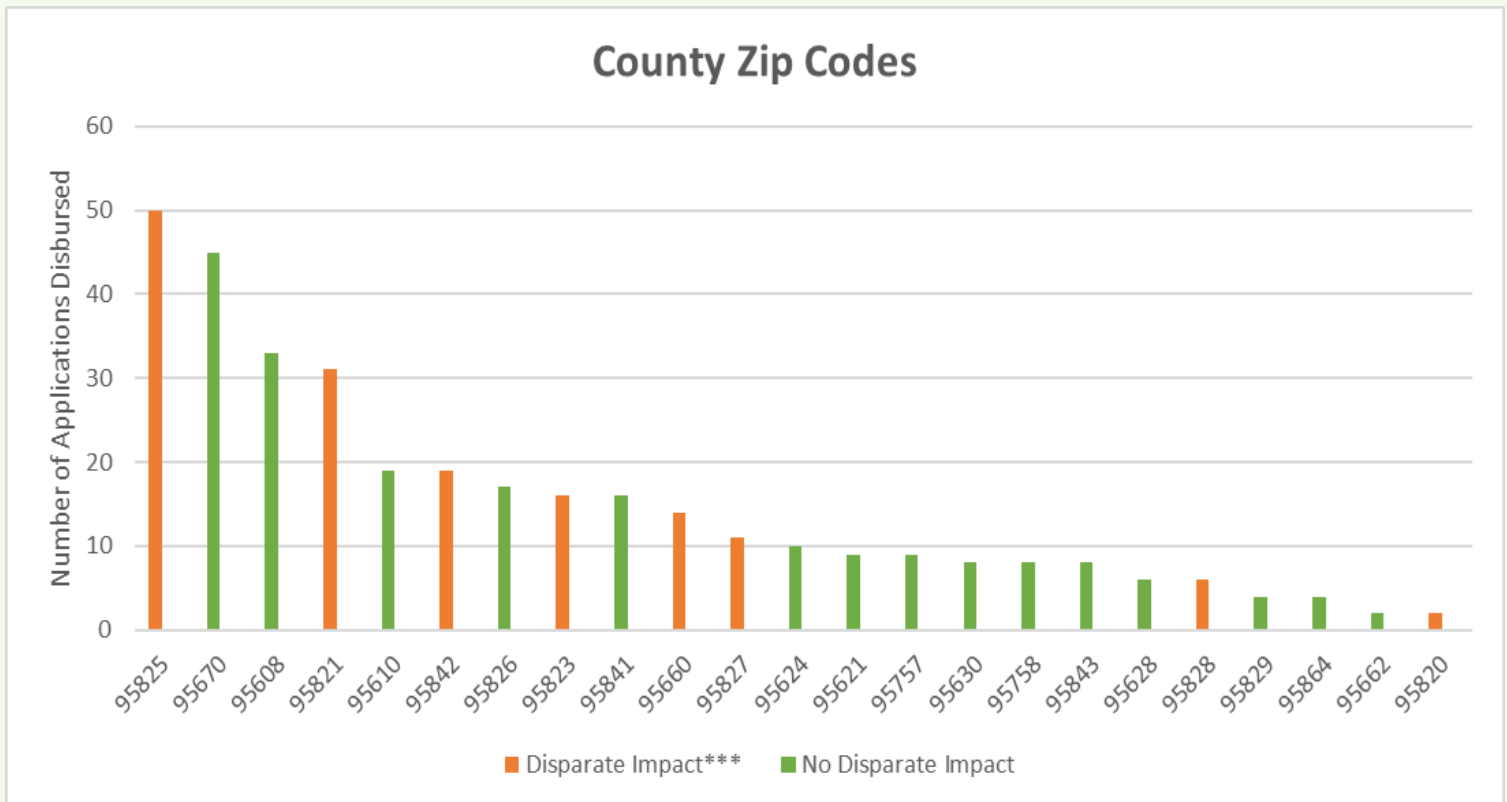
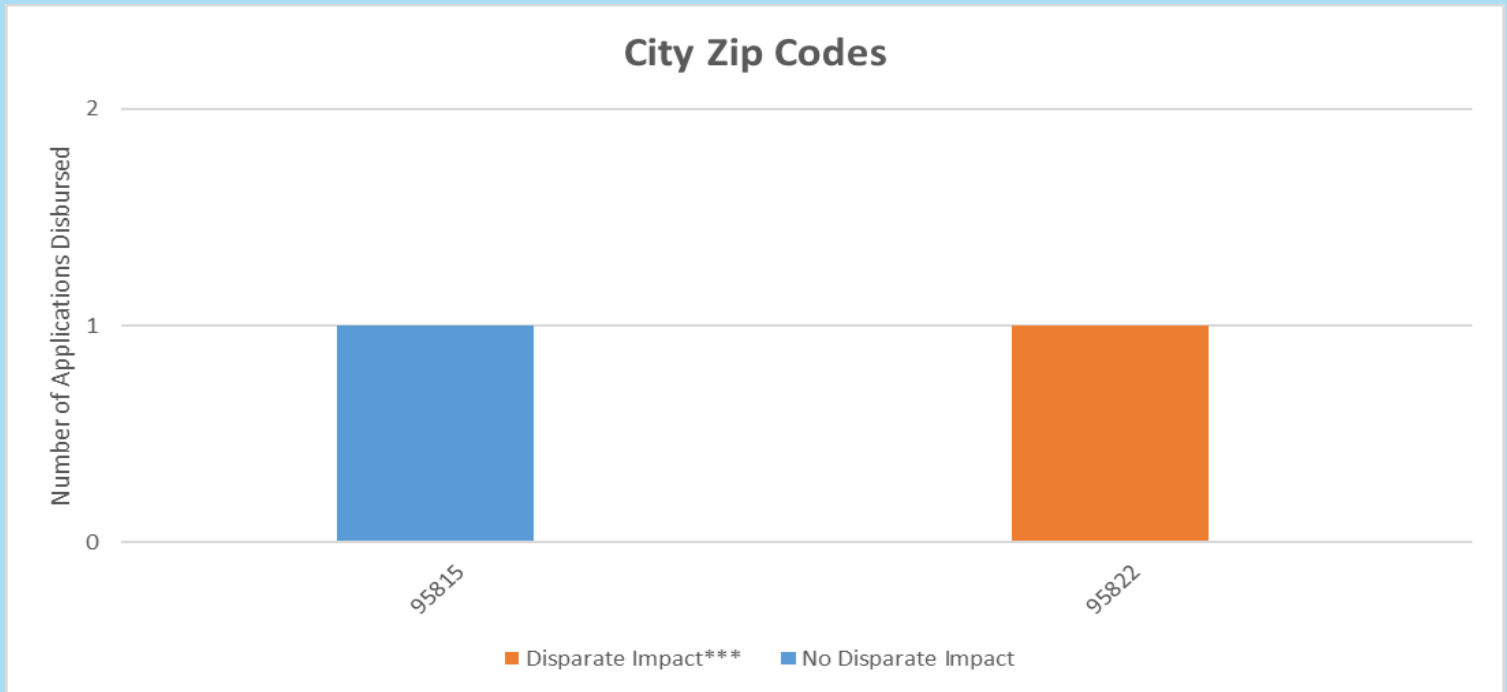


October Disbursements By Household Size
