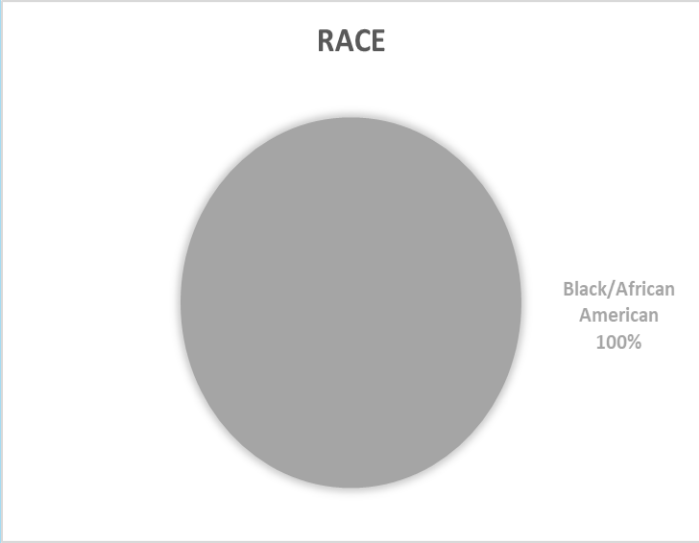

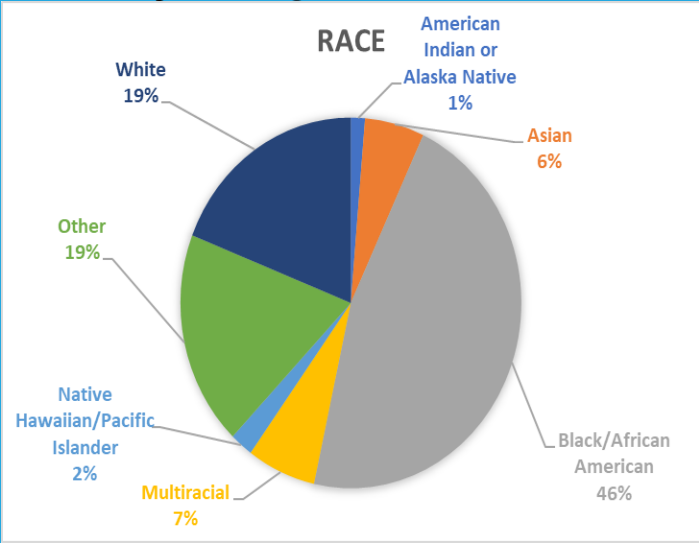
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

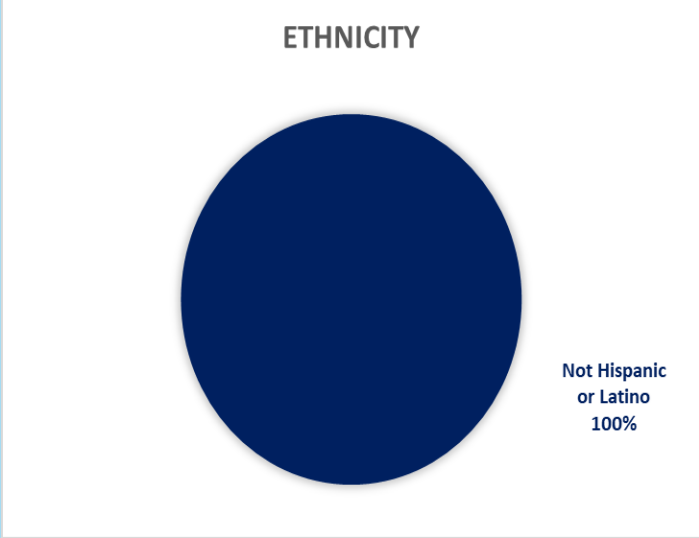

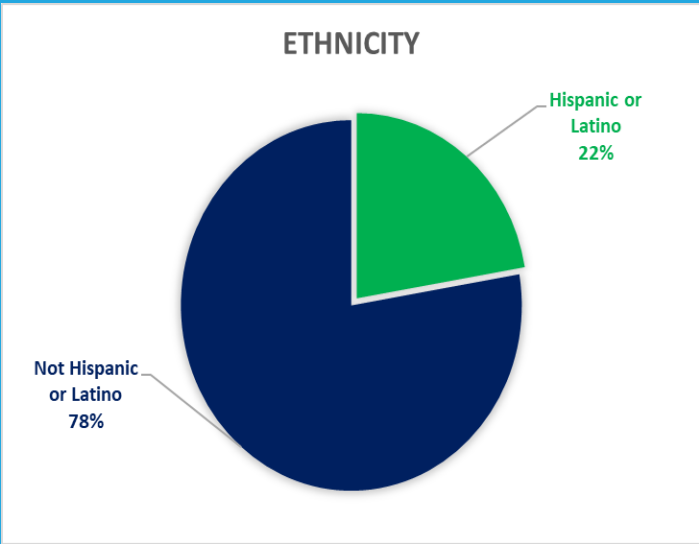

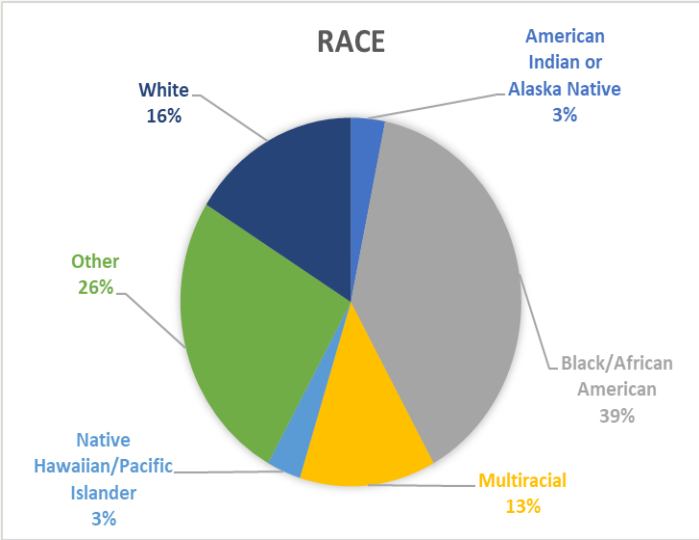

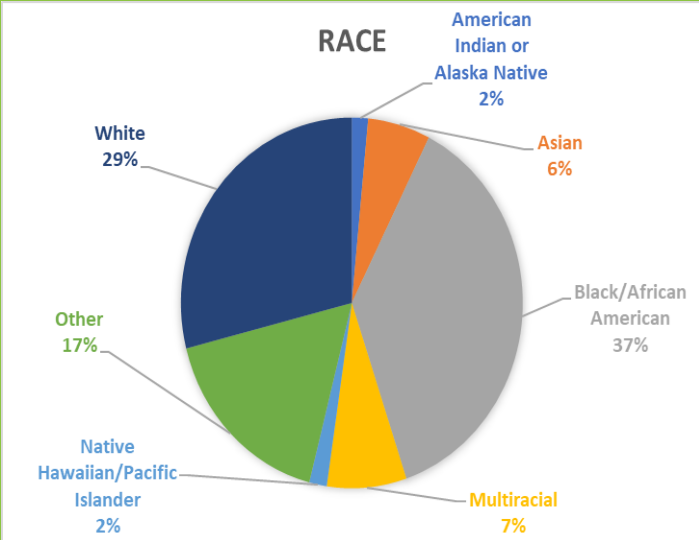


County November



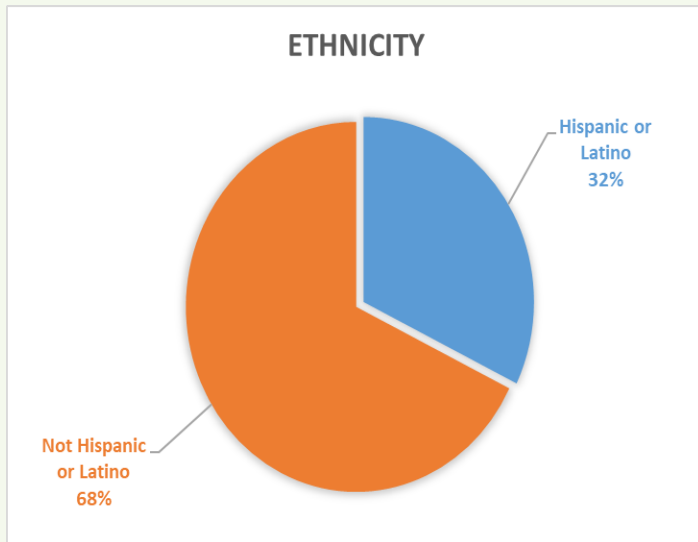

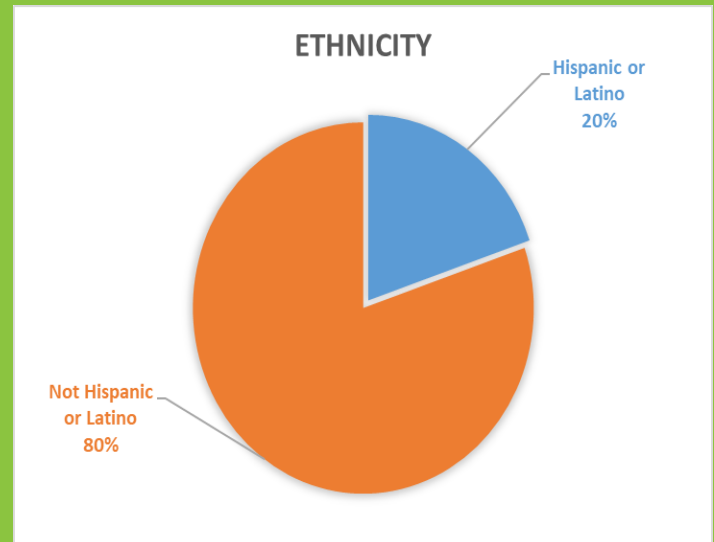

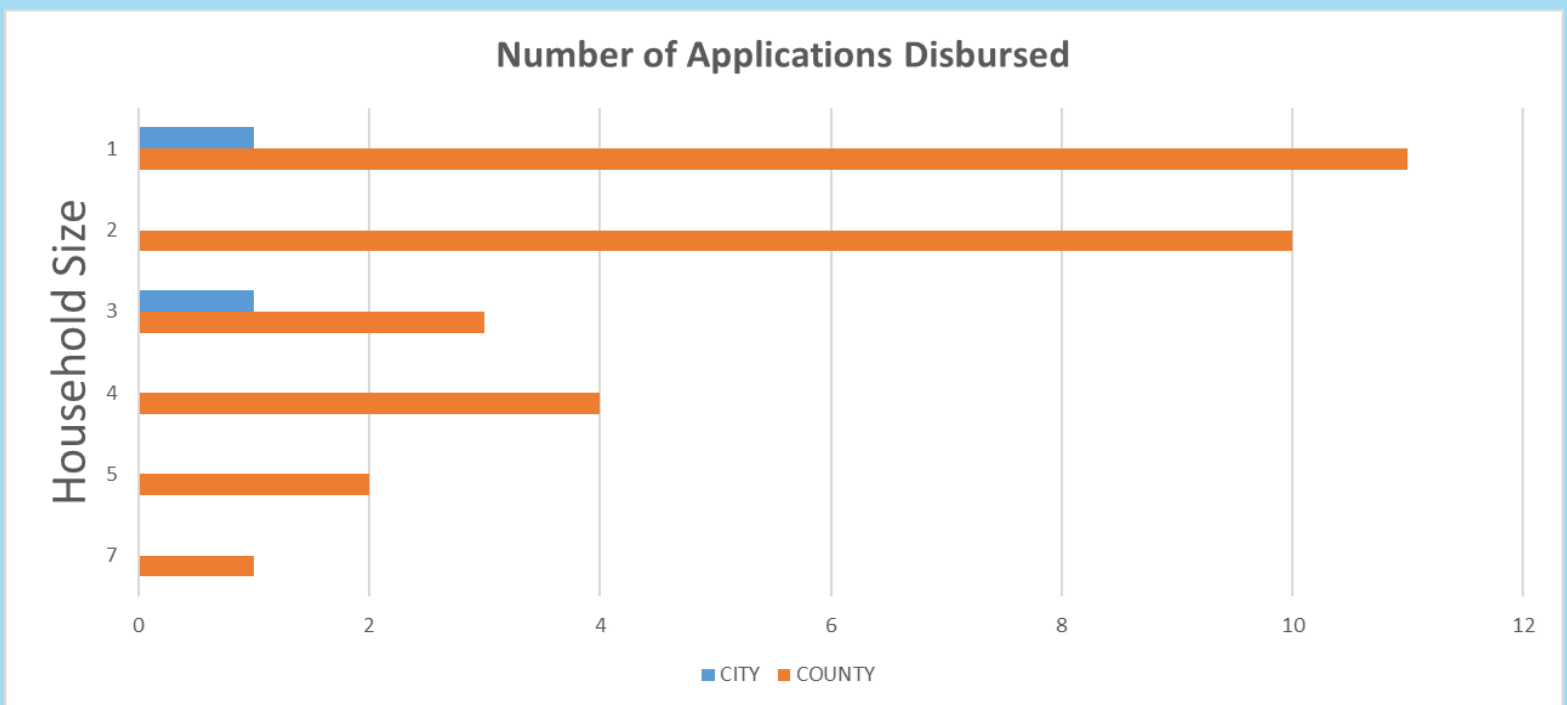

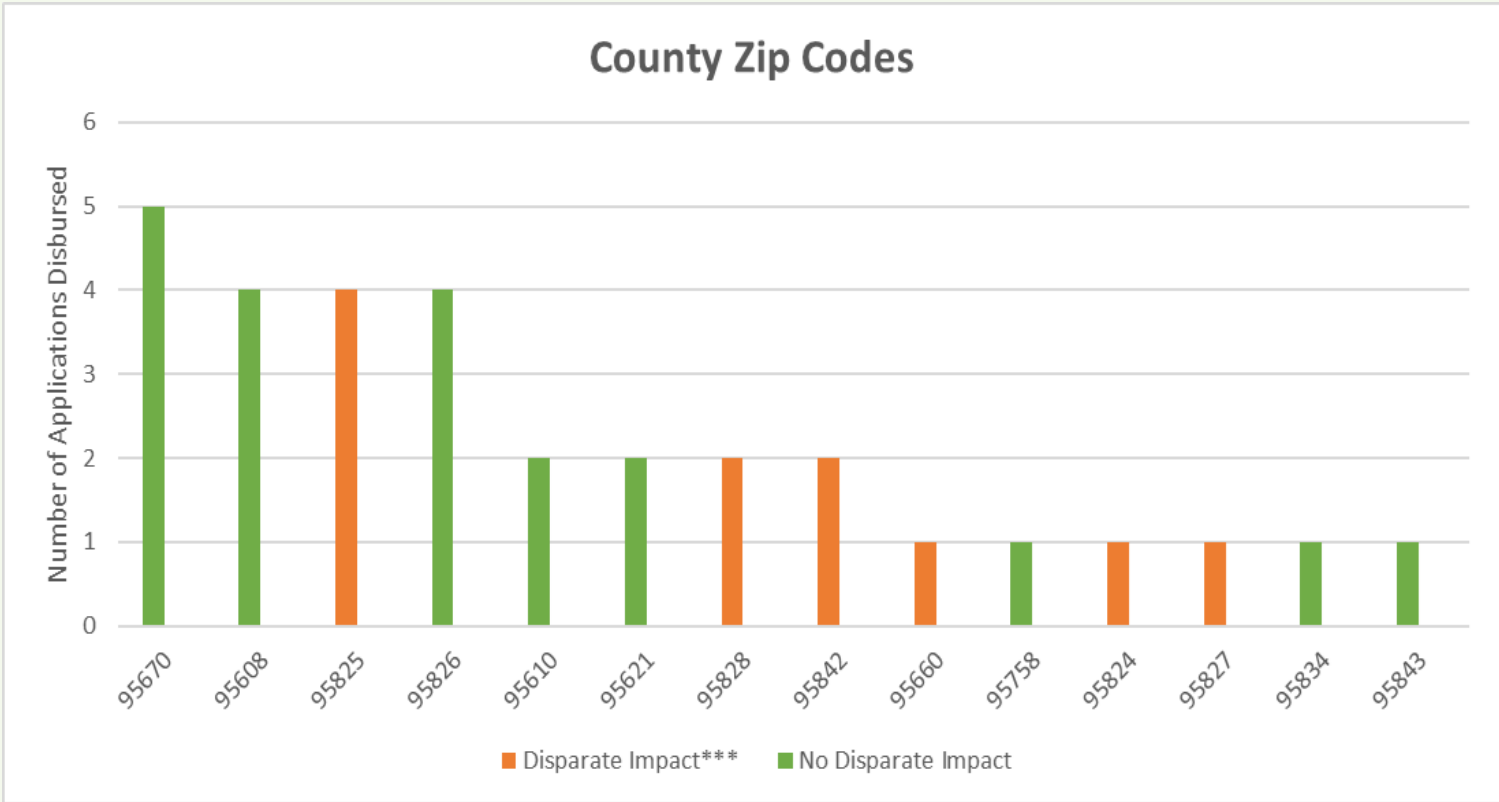
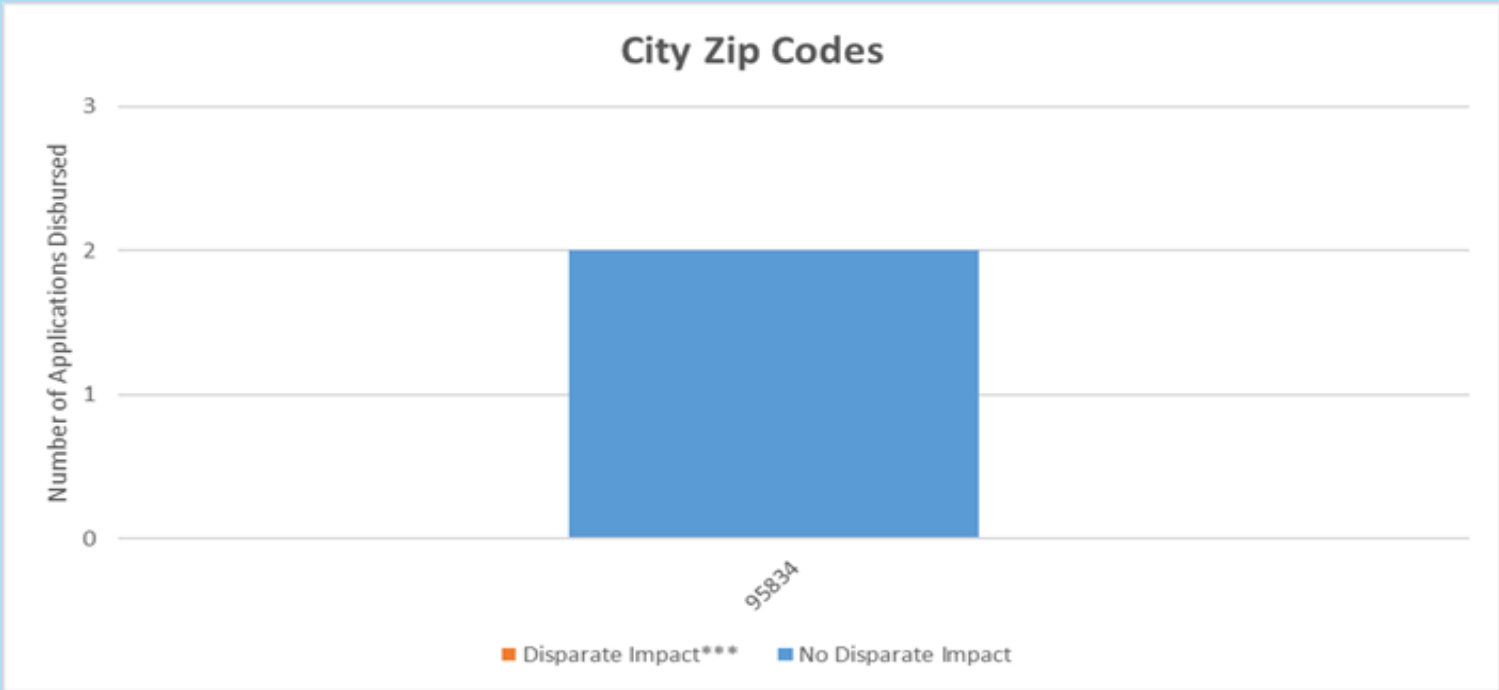


## November Disbursements By Household Size
