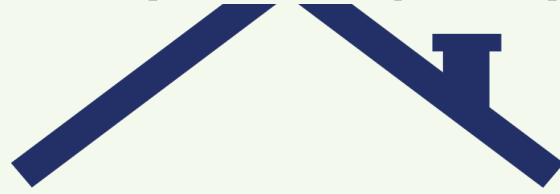

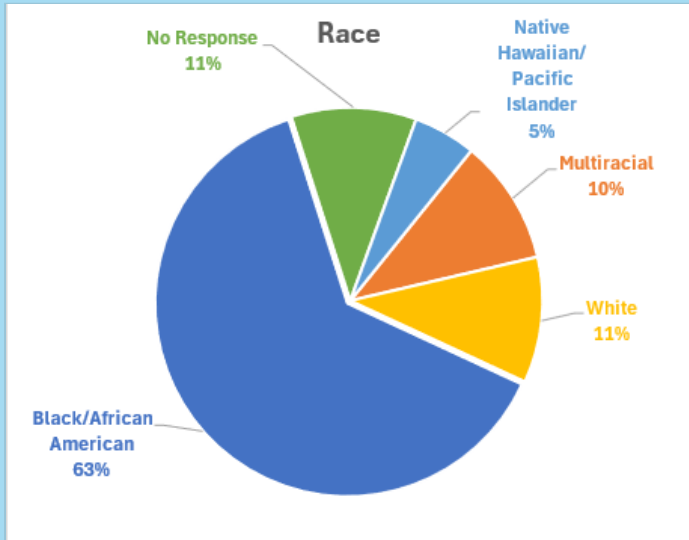

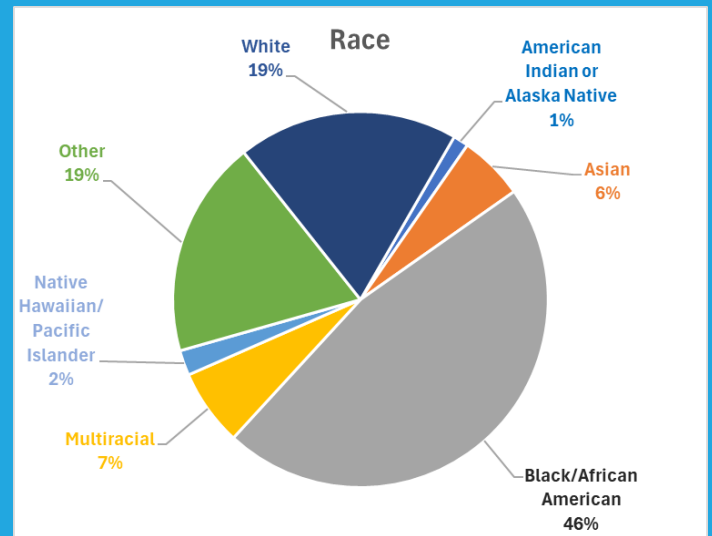
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

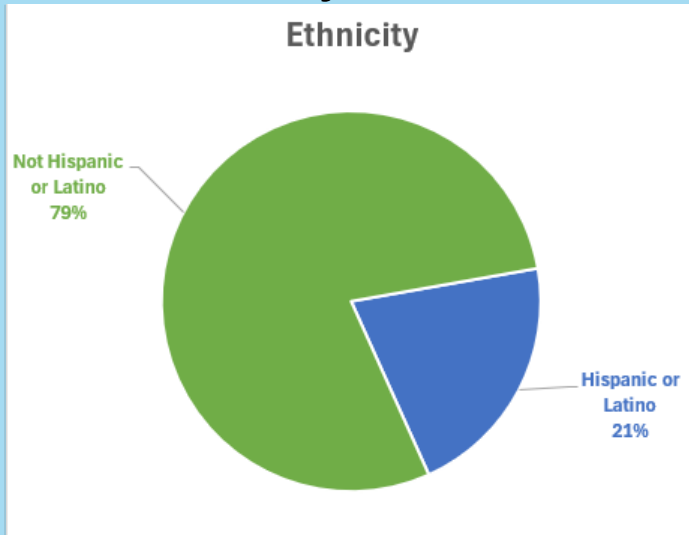

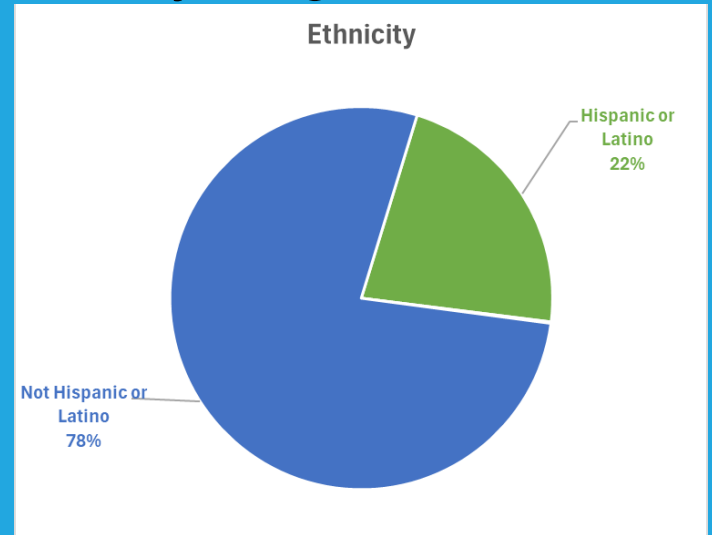

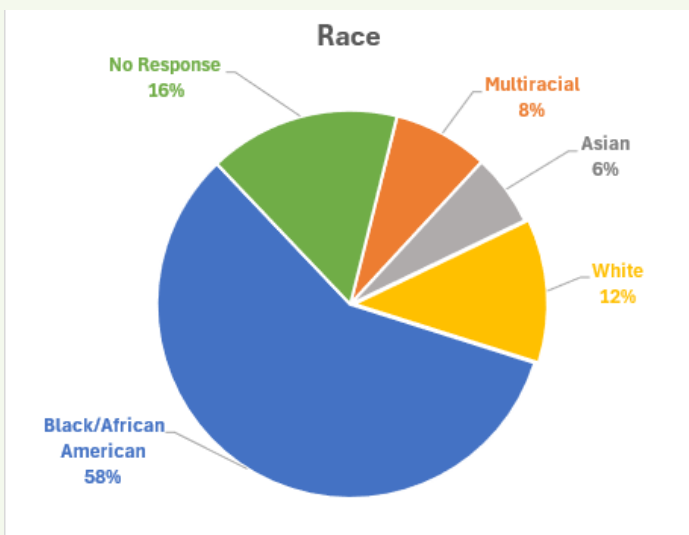

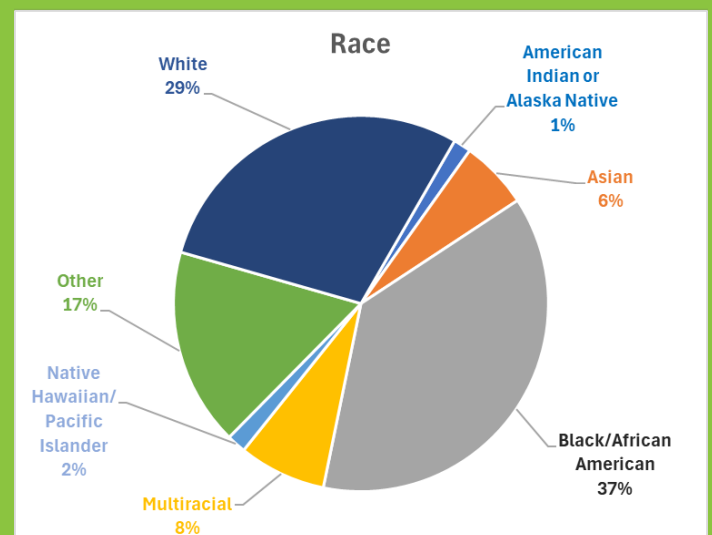


County Q3



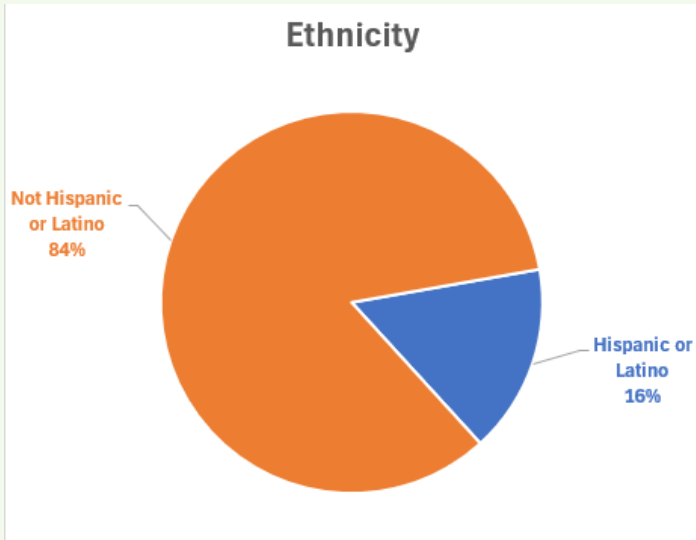

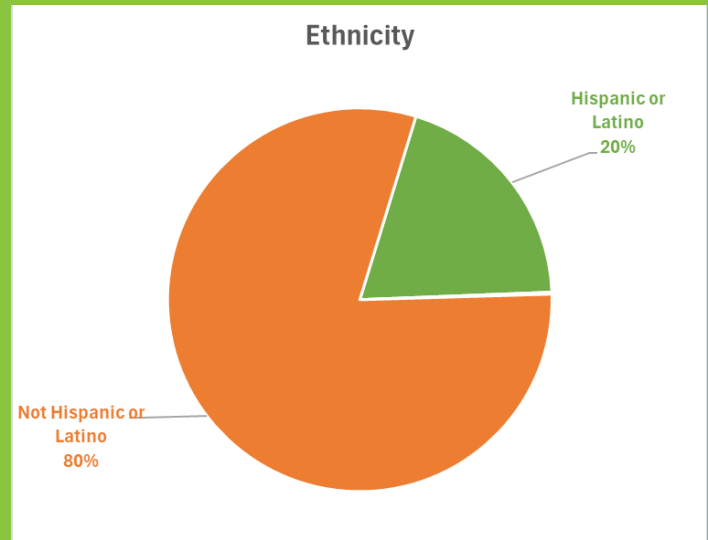

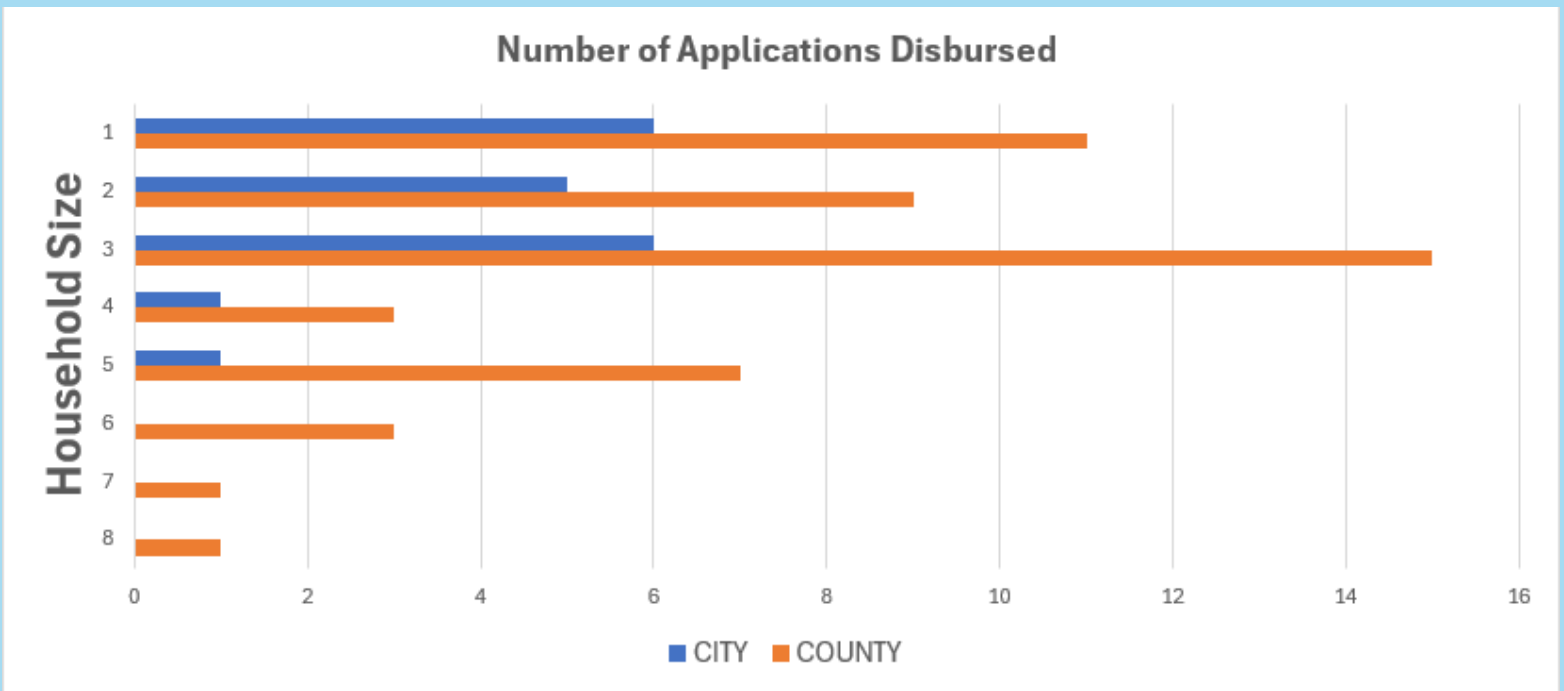

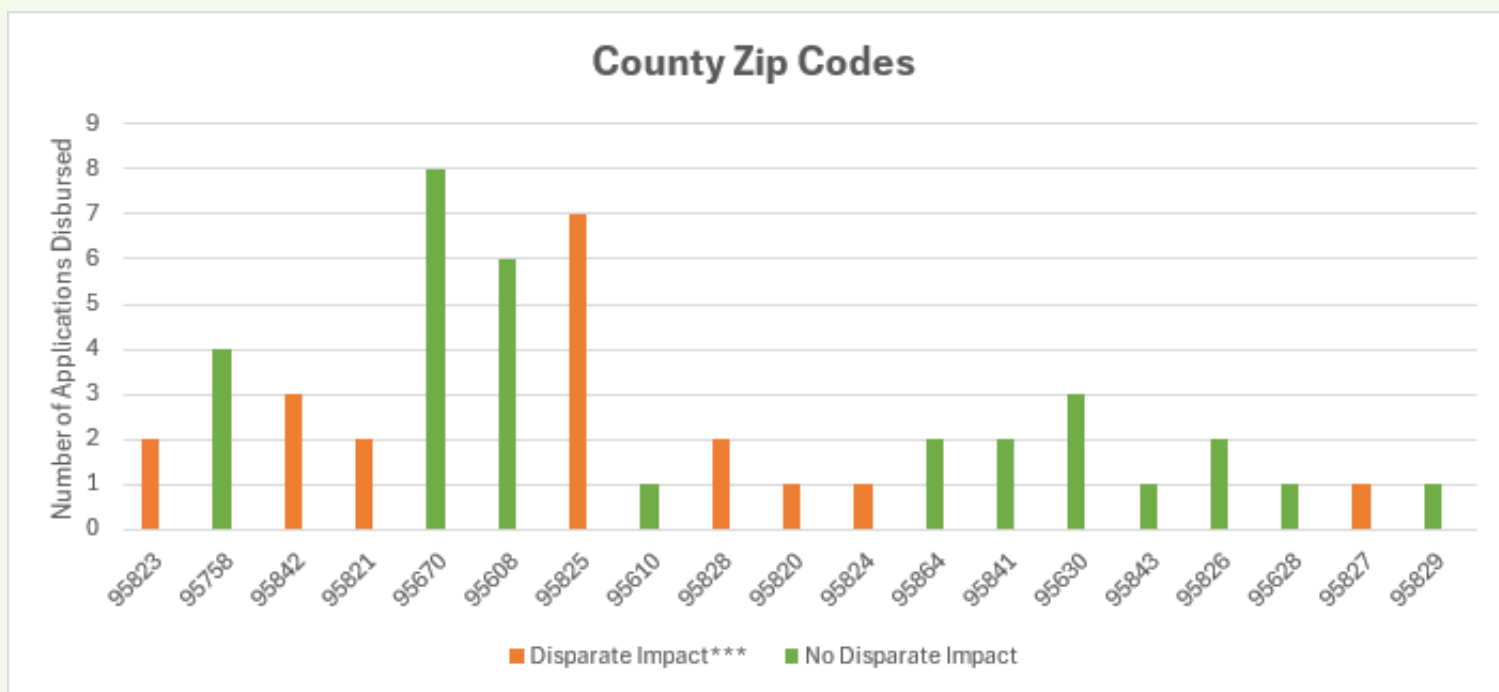
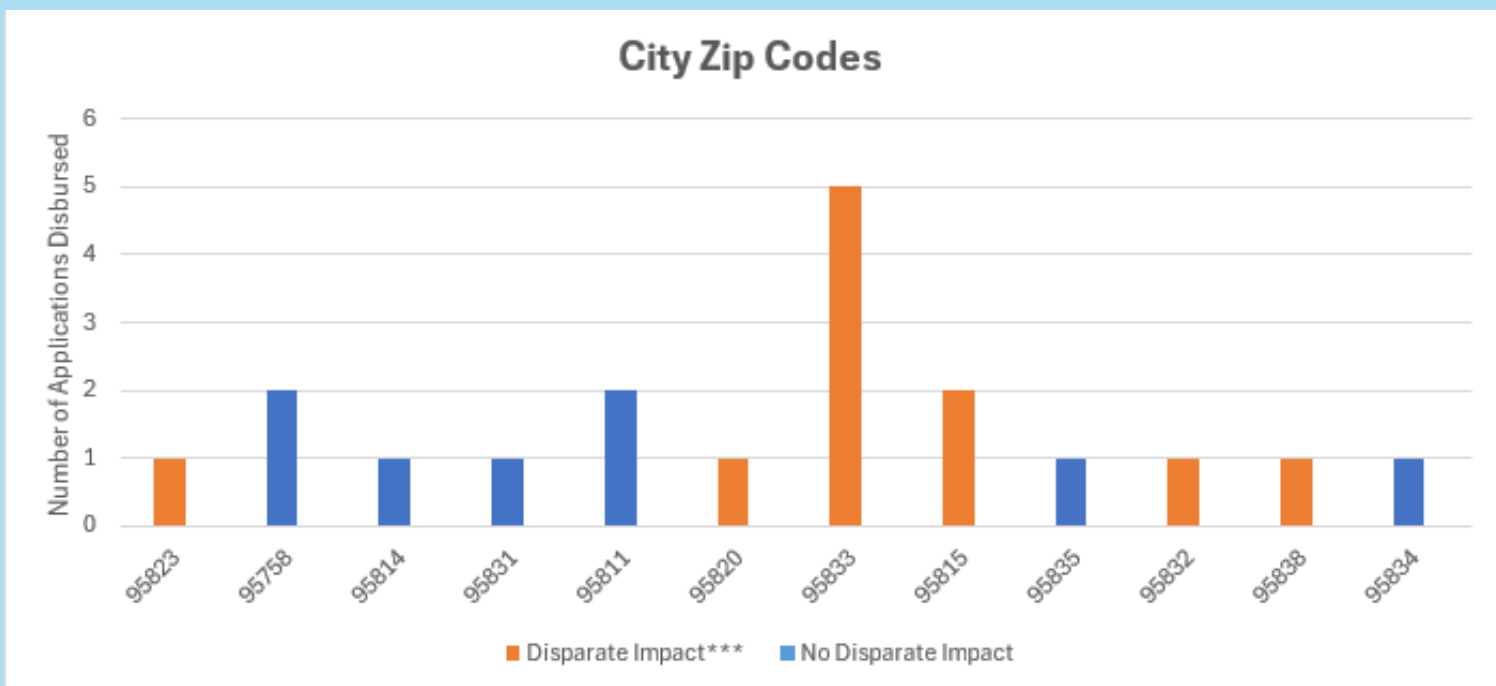


Q3 Disbursements By Household Size
