**SACRAMENTO COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY PROJECT BASED VOUCHER  
ELDERLY HOUSING WAITING LIST OPENS JUNE 24, 2025, AT 7AM**  
*The wait list will remain open until a total of 1,000 applications are received.*

**Sacramento, CA** – The Housing Authority of the County of Sacramento will open the Project Based Voucher Elderly Housing Waiting List on Tuesday, June 24, 2025, at 7am. The waiting list will remain open until 1,000 applications have been received.

Project Based Voucher Elderly Housing units are all one bedroom units mostly in high rise buildings located in downtown Sacramento. The properties have a site requirement of a minimum of 50 years of age or older.

Pre-applications will be accepted online at [sacwaitlist.com](http://sacwaitlist.com) using any device with internet access (email address required). There is no charge to apply.

The application can be completed using iPhone, Android and iPad mobile devices.

Wait list preferences are given to families who are homeless or rent burdened, have a family member who is a veteran, have a family member who is disabled, and who live or work in Sacramento County.

A confirmation receipt is issued immediately after the application is submitted.

The Housing Authority of the County of Sacramento's housing programs serve very low income families and individuals. Eligible families will receive rental assistance as funds are available. Criminal background checks are conducted on all adults applying for housing.

**SHRA** ([www.shra.org](http://www.shra.org)) is a Joint Powers Authority created by the City and County of Sacramento to represent both jurisdictions for affordable housing and community redevelopment needs. SHRA has a FY 2025 budget of \$327.1 million and 315 employees. The Agency owns and/ manages approximately 3,300 units of affordable housing and is one of the largest landlords in Sacramento. SHRA also administers approximately 13,500 rent assistance vouchers per month.
